

SECTION 4 OF THE **APPEAL UNDER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE** KHYBER ACT, 1974 <u>AGAINST</u> TRIBUNAL 1498 **DATED DEMOTION ORDER** NO BY THE **PASSED** 2-12-2014 DISTRICT_POLICE OFFICER, NOWSHERA NO. WHEREBY (RESPONDENT WAS AWARDED MAJOR APPELLANT PENALTY OF REDUCTION IN RANK FROM THE POST OF HEAD CONSTABLE (B-7) TO THE POST OF CONSTABLE (B-5) AND ALSO AGAINST THE ORDER NO. 8545-46 DATED 29-12-2014 PASSED BY THE RESPONDENT NO.2 WHEREBY THE DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL OF THE APPELLANT WAS "FILED" WITHOUT **COGENT REASONS.**

PRAYER IN APPEAL

By accepting this appeal, the demotion order No. 1498 dated 2-12-2014 and rejection order No. 8545-46 dated 29-12-2014 passed by the respondents No. 2 & 3 may very graciously be set aside and the appellant may kindly be restored as Head Constable alongwith all back wages and consequential benefits.

RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH

Short facts giving rise to the present appeal are as under:-

- 1. That the appellant joined the service of Police Department as Constable (B-5) on 1-12-1988. He was then promoted as Head Constable (B-7) on 10-5-2010 as a special case, on account of his dedication, devotion and outstanding performance. The appellant was also awarded 19 "Commendation Certificates" regarding his exceptional performance. He had 26 years unblemished service record to his credit. (Copies of Promotion order and commendation certificates are appended as Annex-A & B).
- 2. That the appellant was performing his duty with great zeal, zest and devotion. But strangely, he was awarded major penalty of "reduction in rank" from the post of Head Constable (B-7) to the post of Constable (B-5) by an order dated 2-12-2014 passed by the District Police Officer, Nowshera (respondent No.3) (Copy of reversion order is appended as Annex-C).
- 3. That no charge sheet along with statement of allegations was served on the appellant to explain his position regarding allegations if any levelled against him on the basis of which the impugned order was passed. Similarly, no fair and impartial inquiry was conducted nor any show cause notice was given to him before awarding the major penalty of demotion as Constable (B-5).
- 4. That the appellant was also not provided any opportunity of personal hearing before passing the impugned order being the requirement of law.
- 5. That the appellant felt aggrieved by the said order, filed a departmental appeal with the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Mardan Region-I, Mardan, (respondent No.2) on 3-12-2014 within the statutory period of law, praying therein for setting aside the impugned order. The comments of the respondent No.3 were requisitioned and thereafter, the appeal was filed without any cogent reasons vide order dated 29-12-2014 (Copy of departmental appeal, comments and rejection order are appended as Annex-D, E & F).

6. That the appellant now files this appeal before this Hon'ble Tribunal inter-alia on the following grounds within the statutory period of law.

GROUNDS OF APPEAL

- A. That respondents have not treated appellant in accordance with law, rules and policy on the subject and acted in violation of Article 4 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973. Therefore, impugned order is not sustainable in the eye of law.
- B. That the respondent No.3 was under statutory obligation to have served a charge sheet alongwith statement of allegations on the appellant so as to enable him to explain his position in respect of allegation if any levelled against him. But he failed to do so and as such blatantly violated the law/rules. Therefore, the impugned order is not sustainable under the law.
- C. That no fair and impartial "Inquiry Committee" was constituted in order to scrutinize the case of promotion in respect of appellant and other employees in its true perspective and in accordance with law. Moreover, the appellant was neither associated in the aforesaid so-called inquiry nor any witness was examined in his presence. Similarly, he was also not provided any chance of cross-examination. Therefore, the impugned order is against the spirit of administration of justice.
- **D.** That the appellant was not served with a show cause notice about the action of the authority in respect of awarding major penalty, being the mandatory requirement of law/rules. Therefore, the impugned is not tenable under the law.
- E. That the appellant was not provided any opportunity of personal hearing before imposition of major penalty of "reduction in rank" as Constable (B-5), in order to explain his view points in respect of the disputed issue. Thus, the appellant has been condemned / penalized without being heard, contrary to the basic principle of Natural Justice known as "Audi Alteram Partem". Reliance in this respect can be placed on the judgment of august Supreme Court of Pakistan reported in PLD-2008-SC-412 (a). The relevant citation is as under:-

(a) Administration of justice---

---Natural justice, principles of---Opportunity of hearing---Scope---Order adverse to interest of a person cannot be passed without providing him an opportunity of hearing---Departure from such rule may render such order illegal.

It is pertinent to mention here that the right of personal hearing is also proved from Holy Quran "that when Almighty Allah directed the Angels to bow down before Adam (P.B.U.H). All obeyed except Iblis (Satan) who was then provided an opportunity to

explain as to why he should not be expelled from the place of mercy. He after improper justification, was expelled from Heaven for ever (vide Surah Al-Baqarah Chapter No.2 Verse No. 34 Al-Quran). Thus, the Competent Authority has acted in derogation of law by not giving any opportunity of personal hearing to the appellant before passing the impugned order. Therefore, the said order is liable to be set aside on this count alone.

- F. That the appellant was granted the aforesaid promotion by the Provincial Police Officer, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (respondent No.1). But the impugned order of his reversion in rank was passed by the District Police Officer, Nowshera (respondent No.3). Thus, the latter being lower authority in rank was not competent to set aside the order passed by his senior officer. Therefore, the impugned order is not warranted under the law.
- G. That the respondent No.2 was legally bound to have decided the departmental appeal of the appellant after application of mind with "cogent reasons", being the requirement of law. But he failed to do so and disposed of the said appeal by simply saying "Filed" as apparent from the order dated 29-12-2014. Thus, this type of decision would not fulfill the requirement of law laid down by august Supreme Court of Pakistan in case reported in 2011-SCMR-1. The relevant citation is reproduced herein for facility of reference:-

(b) General Clauses Act (X of 1897)---

----S. 24-A---Speaking order-Public functionaries are bound to decide cases of their subordinates after application of mind with cogent reasons within reasonable time.

Therefore, the impugned order is bad in law.

- H. That the appellant was promoted as Head Constable (B-7) in accordance with law and this order has also been acted upon. Moreover, the appellant had worked against the said post for a period of 4 years and as such it had taken legal effect and created vested rights in his favour. Thus, the said order cannot be declared as illegal and the **Principle of Locus Poenitentiae** is attracted in the matter. Therefore, the impugned order is against the legal norms of justice.
- I. That one Sher Bahadar was also granted similar promotion as Assistant Sub-Inspector on the basis of his outstanding performance (Copy Annex-G). But he was retained in the same capacity while the appellant was reverted in rank as Constable (B-5). Thus, the appellant has been discriminated and treated unfairly qua the above similarly placed employee. This is a disparity and anomaly and is also violation of Article 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 which has unequivocally laid down that all citizens placed in similar circumstances are entitled to equal treatment and protection of law. The Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan through various judgments has maintained that equal

treatment is the fundamental right of every citizen. Reliance can be placed on 2007-SCMR-410(d). The relevant citation is as under:-

2007-SCMR-410(d) (D) CONSTITUTION OF PAKISTAN (1973)---

---Art. 25---Equal protection of law---Principles---Concept of equal protection of law envisages that a person or class of persons should not be denied the rights, which are enjoyed by other persons in the same situation.

Hence, impugned order is not tenable under the law.

- J. That the Competent Authority has passed the impugned order in mechanical manner and the same is perfunctory as well as non-speaking and also against the basic principle of administration of justice. Therefore, the impugned order has no sanctity under the law.
- **K.** That the impugned order is based on conjectures and surmises. Hence, the same is against the legal norms of justice.
- L. That the impugned order is suffering from legal infirmities and as such the same is not tenable under the law.
- M. That the appellant would like to seek the permission of this Hon'ble Tribunal to advance some more grounds at the time of arguments.

In view of the above narrated facts and grounds, it is, therefore, humbly prayed that the impugned order No. 1498 dated 2-12-2014 and rejection order No. 8545-46 dated 29-12-2014 passed by the respondents No. 2 & 3 may very graciously be set aside and the appellant may kindly be restored as Head Constable alongwith all back wages and consequential benefits.

Any other relief deemed proper and just in the circumstances of the case, may also be granted.



With profound respect and humble submission, I beg to submit that I have been reverted from the rank of Head Constable (BPS- 07) to the rank of Constable (BPS- 05) vide DPO Nowshera Office order No. 1498/EC dated 02/12/2014 (copy attached for ready reference) against which I am going to submit the present Appeal for your kind consideration on the grounds/justification as mentioned as under:-

- 1. I was enlisted as Constable on 01-12-1988.
- 2. I have passed my Recruit Course at PTS, Hangu during the year 1989.
- 3. I have passed my A-I Examination in the year 1996 and my name was brought on promotion list A-I w.e.f 03-02-1996.
- 4. I have passed my B-I Examination in the year 1998 and my name was brought on promotion list B-I in the same year.
- 5. My date of birth is 20-03-1970.
- 6. Due to my misfortune I rendered overage and could not be selected for Lower School Course.
- 7. I had long service and was deserving for promotion List C-II, but my name was not considered, however, later on, due to an extra ordinary performance, i.e, subdued an accused red handed after commission of crime in the premises of Distt: Courts, Nowshera, vide case FIR No. 983 dated 15-12-2006 u/s 302/13AO/7-ATA PS Nowshera Cantt, vide OB No. 104 dated 01-02-2007 (copy enclosed).
- 8. Similarly, in different occasions in my long service I was awarded commendation certificates by high-ups/Session Courts, Nowshera (copies attached for ready reference). I have used my energy/skills in the discharge of my duties and saved a human life who attempted suicide/ drowning from the Attock Bridge, extra-ordinary performance in Musalihatti Committee Distt: Nowshera, I was promoted as Head Constable on the direction of the then IGP/ Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar against the sanctioned quota of C-II HCs vide OB No. 495 dated 13-05-2010 (copy enclosed).

- 13. I was also granted shoulder promotion as ASI on Acting Charge basis by the officers, due to my continuous outstanding performance.

Therefore, it is humbly requested that my Appeal may kindly be considered and the order relating to my Reversion issued vide OB No. 1498 dated 02-12-2014 may kindly be withdrawn so that justice is extended.

Respectfully Sheweth: -

PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS

- 1. That the appellant has got no cause of action.
- 2. That the appeal is badly time-barred.
- 3. That the appeal is bad in law.
- 4. That the appellant is estopped from moving the instant appeal due to his own conduct.
- 5. That the appeal is not maintainable in its present form.
- 6. That the appellant has not come to the Honourable Tribunal with clean hands:

On Facts

- 1. Para to the extent of enlistment in Police Department and his subsequent promotion as C-II Constable pertains to record, needs no comments, while rest of the para is not related. Needs no comments.
- 2. Para to the extent of performance of the appellant is not related, hence, no comments, while rest of the para is incorrect because the appellant has not been awarded any penalty of reduction in rank rather, those Constables were promoted as C-II Head Constables who are senior to the present appellant regarding their placement on C-II list as per standing order vide No. 06/2014. (Copy annexed).
- 3. Para incorrect. As discussed above neither the appellant was penalized nor any punishment has been awarded, hence, the plea taken by the appellant is totally false, baseless and devoid of its legal footing, therefore, liable to be set at naught.
- 4. Para already explained. Hence, no comments.
- 5. Para to the extent of feeling aggrieved and subsequent filing of department appeal is not related, needs no comments, while rest of the para is incorrect

because the reasons/grounds mentioned in the rejection order are cogent, plausible and confidence inspiring, hence, stance of the appellant is not appeal-able to a prudent mind.

6. Not related. Needs no comments.

On grounds

- A. Para incorrect. The appellant is treated in accordance with law, rules and policy because the respondents have no grudge against the appellant.
- B. Para incorrect. The stance/objection raised by the appellant regarding serving of charge sheet and statement of allegation on him is not plausible because he has not been awarded any penalty.
- C. Para incorrect. As explained earlier neither the appellant was awarded any punishment nor penalized what to speak of providing him the right of self defense, hence, the plea taken by the appellant is not tenable in the eyes of law. Moreover, a proper departmental committee was constituted wherein the case of all C-II head Constables was considered, whereafter, those C-II Head Constables were promoted who stood senior and have out standing performance.
- D. Para incorrect. As the appellant has not been awarded any punishment, therefore, there was no need of serving show cause notice upon the appellant, hence, plea of the appellant is not sustainable in the eyes of law.
- E. Para already explained. Needs no comments.
- F. Para incorrect. The Provincial Police Officer, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar had issued directions for suitable award. Hence, the stance of appellant regarding the C-II Head Constable promotion by the Provincial Police Officer, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar is false and baseless rather, his order of promotion to the rank of C-II, Head Constable was passed by the then District Police Officer, Nowshera.
- G. Para incorrect. The Departmental appeal of the appellant was filed by respondent No. 2 after taking into consideration cogent, confidence inspiring and plausible reasons, therefore, plea taken by the appellant is not tenable in the eyes of law.
- H. Para already explained. Hence, no comments.
- Para regarding discrimination against the appellant is false and baseless, because the respondents have no grudge against the present appellant, therefore, stance of the appellant being devoid of its legal footing is not sustainable in the eyes of law.
- J. Para incorrect. The order passed by the competent authority is neither mechanical nor perfunctory rather after considering the entire cogent reasons, a speaking order was passed.

- Para incorrect. The order passed by the competent authority is in accordance K. with the norms of natural justice.
- L. Para already explained. Needs no comments.
- That the respondents also seek permission of this Honourable Tribunal to M. advance additional grounds at the time of arguments.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that keeping in view the above submissions, appeal of the appellant may very graciously be dismissed with cost.

STANDING ORDER NO. 6/2014

Promotion of Constables as C-II Head Constables

This Standing Order is issued under Article 10(3) of Police Order 2002 in pursuance of the Police Policy Board decision taken in its 11th meeting held on 21st August 2014.

- 2. Aim:- This Standing Order aims to streamline and standardize the criteria and procedure of placement of Constables on promotion List C-II and their subsequent promotion as C-II Head Constables.
- 3. Placement on C-II List:- Those Constables who have crossed the age limit prescribed for A-1/B-1 Exams without qualifying the same may be considered for placement on promotion List C-II.
- 4. A Selection Board at the District level, constituted by CCPO or RPO, as the case may be, and consisting of the DPO concerned (SSP Operations in case of District Peshawar) and two other officers not less than the rank of SP, may consider Constables for placement on C-II list as per the following criteria:
 - a. Outstanding performance;
 - o. Good general∉reputation.
- 5. **Procedure:-** Seniority of Constables placed on List C-II shall be determined from the date of entry into the promotion List C-II.
- 6. The Selection Board constituted under section 4 above may recommend to CCPO or RPO, as the case may be, Constables placed on C-II List for promotion as Head Constables in accordance with the following criteria:
 - a. Seniority-cum-outstanding performance;
 - b. Good general reputation.
- 7. After approval of CCPO or RPO, as the case may be, the DPO (SSP Operations in case of Peshawar) shall promote such Constables as C-II Head Constables.
- 8. Promotion of Constables as C-II Head Constables on reaching superannuation:- A large number of Constables retire without being promoted as Head Constables. Such Constables deserve to be promoted as C-II Head Constables, before their superannuation, in recognition of their long-standing services for the Police department.
- 8.1 The criteria and procedure given in section 3 to 7 above shall not apply to the promotion of Constables promoted as C-II Head Constables on superannuation. Instead

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ng ad eir such constables shall be promoted, in line with the IGP Policy Guidelines No. 04/2013 dated 5° December 2013, according to the following procedure:

- a) The District Head of Police or the Head of a Police Unit, as the case may be, shall place the name of a Constable on promotion List C-II on the first day of the last six months before the date of his superannuation.
- b) Once the name of a constable has been placed on promotion List C-II under section 8.1 (a), the District Head of Police or the Head of a Police Unit, as the case may be, shall promote the Constable as Head Constable (C-II) on the first day of the last three months before the date of his superannuation.
- c). This procedure shall not apply to constables going on LPR.
- d) The District Head of Police or the Head of Police Unit, as the case may be, shall maintain a list of all Constables well before their superannuation.
- 9. Only upto 10% of the vacancies of Head Constables in a District or Unit, as the case may be, shall be filled through promotion from List C-II. In any case, such promotions shall not exceed 10% of the total vacancies of Head Constables in a District or Unit.
- 10. Power to remove difficulties:- If any difficulty arises in giving effect to this order, the Provincial Police Officer may by notification make such provisions as deemed appropriate.
- 11. Amendment:- All previous Standing Orders on the subject, to the extent of the provisions of this order, shall stand amended.
