MUHAMMAD AAMIR NAZIR. MEMBER.-Muhammad Ismail son of Bakia Jan, SET (Technical) Government Middle School Official Colony, Karak through the instant appeal under Section 4 o the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974 has impugned notification

dated 28.11.2011 vide which the appellant was upgraded with immediate effect instead of upgrading him w.e.f. 1.10.2007 as per provincial government notification for upgradation of SETs.

- 2. Briefly stated the facts giving rise to the present appeal are that the the appellant is serving as SET since long in the respondent department. That the Finance Department issued a notification for upgradation of SETs from BPS-16 to BPS-17 w.e.f. 1.10.2007 for all those teachers who had 10 years service. That like other SETs, the appellant was also eligible but due to non availability of seniority list of the appellant, the case of the appellant was kept pending till 13.7.2011 and lateron vide impugned notification dated 28.11.2011, the post of the appellant was upgraded to BPS-17 with immediate effect instead of 1.10.2007. That being aggrieved from the impugned notification, the appellant filed departmental appeal but of no avail, hence the instant appeal.
  - 3. After institution of the instant appeal, it was admitted to regular hearing and the respondents were summoned by the Tribunal. The respondents contested the appeal and submitted their written reply. We have heard the arguments of the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.
  - as per Finance Department notification dated 1.10.2007, the appellant who had qualifying service of 10 years was entitled for upgradation from BPS-16 to BPS-17 w.e.f. 1.10.2007 yet the respondent department malafidely kept the case of the appellant pending for about three years and finally issued the impugned notification on 28.11.2011 vide which the appellant was upgraded to BPS-17 with immediate effect instead of upgrading him w.e.f. 1.10.2007 as per Finance Department notification; that this act of the respondents is based on

malafide and without any legal justification, therefore, by accepting the instant appeal, the respondents be directed to upgrade the post of the appellant from the date of notification of Finance Department i.e. 1.10.2007.

- that as per Provincial Government Notification dated 1.10.2007 the SETs having atleast 10 years service were entitled for upgradation from BPS-16 to BPS-17, however, the upgradation was to be made through Departmental Promotion Committee; that since the DPC of the appellant was held in the year 2011, therefore, the appellant was rightly upgraded to BPS-17 w.e.f. 28.11.2011 instead of 1.10.2007. The instant appeal filed by the appellant is without any justification is liable to be dismissed.
- 6. Perusal of the case file reveals that admittedly, the appellant is serving as SET regular since the year 1995. It is also evident from the record that the then Chief Minister approved the summary on demand of the employees of Education Department whereby certain financial benefits were extended to the employees of Education Department inter-alia the posts of SET teachers were upgraded from BPS-16 to BPS-17 w.e.f. 1.10.2007. Hence, in line with the approved summary, the Finance Department issued a notification dated 1.10.2007 and upgraded the post of SET teachers with requisite experience from BPS-16 to BPS-17 with immediate effect. The Regularization Wing of Finance Department issued a Notification dated 26.1.2008 wherein inter-alia competent authority allowed upgradation to the incumbents of the posts of SET BPS-16 with alteast 10 years service, to BPS-17. The above referred Notifications clearly indicates that SETs having got the requisite qualification were entitled to be upgraded from BPS-16 to BPS-17 w.e.f. 1.10.2007. Though the Departmental Promotion Committee had taken time to process the cases of

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the incumbents of the posts in order to check whether they fulfill the criteria laid down in the notification for upgradation as per their service record, but it does not mean that the DPC could change the contents of notification with respect to its effectiveness. It is not the job of DPC or the authority concerned to fix the date for upgradation prospectively when the notification has itself prescribed a specific date i.e. 1.10.2007 for upgradation of the post of appellant.

- 8. In the light of the above observations, we accept the appeal in hand by extending the upgradation to the appellant w.e.f. 1.10.2007 i.e. the date vide which the notification become effective. No order as to costs. File be consigned to the record.
- 9. This judgment will also disposed of connected service appeals No. 492/2012 Ihsanur Rahman, No. 493/2012 Muhammad Qasim Khan, No. 494/2012 Habibur Rahman, and No. 495/2012 Hasham Khan versus Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa through Secretary Elementary & Secondary Education Department, Peshawar and others, in the same manner.

The Govt: launched a policy vide Notification No:FD(FR)10-22 /2007, dated 26-01-2008 where in the SETs were allowed one step upgradation from BPS-16 to BPS-17 (Personal) with immediate effect on completion of ten years regular service subject to the condition of inclusion their names in the seniority list of SET cadre vide Notification No:SOR-I /(E&AD)/3-1/82(Edu)/Vol:V) dated 05-05-2008 at S.No:V (Annexure-A) and all the SETs who were already included in the seniority list awarded upgradation from BPS-16 to BPS-17 (Personal) through DPC. The names of the following SETs were not found included in the seniority list of SET and thus they were not included in the first phase of working paper prepared for award of upgradation. They have never been applied for seniority list with effect from the date of their appointments till the introduction of the upgradation policy i.e 26-01-2008. The first upgradation Notification was issued vide No:SO(PE)2-6/DPC /Upgradation/ SETs /BS-16 to BS-17 dated 27-09-2008 consisting on 2333 Male SETs, 446 Female SETs and 25 Technical/Commerce SETs. After issuance the 1st upgradation Notification of SET (referred to the above) they lodged appeals for award of seniority. Their appointment orders were in a single shape and were not in general notification and thus could not be entered in the seniority list already prepared / issued with others SETs. Their orders being single one were first inquired / verified from the relevant record and when found satisfactory then the department included them in the seniority list and then their upgradation cases from BPS-16 to BPS-17 (Personal) were accordingly placed before the DPC. Their cases were finalize just before the conducting of DPC i.e 15-08-2011 and upgradation order was issued vide Notification No:SO(PE)/2-6 /DPC /Meeting /2011 dated 28.11.2011 (Annexure-B). They were awarded upgradation with effect from 28.11.2011 i.e with immediate effect in the light of Govt: Rules/Policy (Annexure-A) where in clearly instructed that upgradation may be allowed with immediate effect and not with retrospective effect. The SETs concerned approached to Hon able Court of Service Tribunal Peshawar for award upgradation with retrospective effect and the decision was made in their favour by allowing them upgradation BPS-16 to BPS-17 (Personal) w.e.f 01-10-2007 instead of 28-11-2011 (Annexure-C:-)


