Service Appeal under Section 4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974, against the acts and omission of the respondents by not allowing technical allowance to B.Tech Degree holder against which the appellant filed departmental appeal vide dated 23.05.2023 which is not yet responded despite the lapse of 90 days of statutory period.

Prayer in appeal

On acceptance of this appeal the appellant may kindly be allow the benefit of Technical allowance in reference to the notification dated 19.10.2018, has been allowed to the counterpart colleagues of the appellant of the same department while performing the same duties with the sam job description and nomenclature i.e. SDO's/Assistant engineers, In light of the Higher Education Commission's decisions approval/orders of the Ministry of Education, water & power Declaration of PEC and decisions

of different courts of law, the discriminatory treatment meted out to the appellant in reference to the technical allowance, and denying the same is illegal unlawful and unlawful authority and violative upon the rights of the appellant, furthermore the respondents may kindly be directed to allow the Technical allowance to the appellant or any other relief which may not specifically asked for may also be awarded in favor of the appellant

Respectfully submitted,

1. That the appellant is B.Tech (Hon's) Degree holder serving the C&W Department as SDO/Asst Engineer with great zeal and devotion.
2. That the Cabinet approved technical allowance @1.5 time of the initial basic pay to all Engineers working in provincial Government Department with effect from 1st july,2018, irrespective of condition of registration with Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC). *(Copy of the cabinet decision is attached as annexure A)*
3. That the same was notified vide FD (SO SR-II)8-7/2018-2019 dated 19-10-2018 issued by the finance department Khyber Pakhtunkhwa whereby, Technical allowance has been allowed to Engineers holding Engineering qualification from the accredited engineering program of Higher Education Institution (HEI)/Universities duly recognized by Higher Education (HEC) and registered with Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) serving against the sanction posts in C&W ,irrigation ,PHE, & local Government Departments of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa with effect from 1st Number,2018. *(Copy of the notification is attached as annexure B).*
4. That the technical allowance was not extended to the B.Tech degree holders, which is illegal unlawful and without lawful authority and is based on clear discrimination.
5. That the appellant being aggrieved from the acts and omission of the respondents by now allowing the technical allowance to the B.Tech degree holders, filed his departmental appeal vide dated 23.05.2023 which is not yet responded even after the

laps of statutory period of 90 days. *(Copy of the departmental appeal is attached as annexure C)*

6. That the appellant prays for the acceptance of her appeal inter alia on the following grounds:

GROUND OF SERVICE APPEAL

- A. That the Appellant has not been treated in accordance with law and rules hence his rights secured and guaranteed under the law are badly violated.
- B. That the Higher education Commission vide decision taken in 39th meeting of equivalency Committee of erstwhile University Grant Commission (UGC) held on 12-02-1998, declared B-Tech (Hon's) degree as compatible and at Par to BE/BSC engineering for the propose of employment Grades, Pay, Promotion and other benefits. *(Copy of the equivalency is attached as annexure D)*
- C. That the Ministry of Education, Government of Pakistan vide its letter dated 26-10-1973 issued under the signatures of Mr. Abdul Hafeez Pirzada, the then Honorable Minister for education and Provincial coordination has also ordered to treat B-Tech (Hon's) Degree at Par with BE/BSc engineering Degree and again the Ministry of Education, Government of Pakistan, pursuant to the judgment of the Honorable Supreme Court of Pakistan announced on 05-06-1995, declared B-Tech (Hon's) degree at Par with BE/BSc Engineering Degree vide office memorandum dated 17-04-1996 *(Copy of the letter dated 26.10.1973 & office memorandum dated 17.04.1996 are attached as annexure E & F).*
- D. That the Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) vide its letter dated 30-04-1981 addressed to Secretary General Sui Gas, Sub Engineers Association has approved B-Tech (Hon's) as equivalent to BSc Engineering, which a diploma holder can pass after 4 years of passing the final examination of diploma, The Council has also equated AMIE examination considered to BSc engineering, these facilities have been provided to those who wants to improve their qualification to become equivalent for registration as professional engineers with the council. *(Copy of the letter dated 30.04.1981 is attached as annexure G).*

- E. That the Sind High Court, Hyderabad has allowed B-Tech (Hon's) BS-17 employees of GENCO and PCPCO, for grant of Rs, 10000/- special engineering allowance and consider eligible for promotion in accordance with Law as under as other engineers B.E & BSc engineers are entitle. *(Copy of the judgment is attached as annexure H).*
- F. That the Federal Public Service Tribunal Islamabad, in its judgment dated 08-05-2018 has allowed Jr. engineers BS-17, having B-Tech (Hon's) degree, a special allowance of Rs 10000/- in light of the Lahore High Court in WP No 19044/2009, where in it was held that WAPDA being statutory organization is vested with authority to prescribe rule, terms and condition as it may deem fit, However, the authority can't treat the similar paced persons with different yard stick, so far as Pay and allowances are concerned and while working in a similar environment under similar supervisor control can't be discriminated with sanctioning special allowance. they would be regulated under the principal of equal pay, equal work as enunciated and embodied in the judgment of Honorable Lahore High Court. *(Copy of the FST judgment is attached as annexure I).*
- G. That in light of judgment of Honorable Supreme Court of Pakistan in Suo Moto Review Petition No 52 of 1993. The Establishment Division Islamabad has withdrawn the condition of registration of engineers with Pakistan engineering Council vide Letter No 9/3/89-R-5 dated April, 1st, 1996.
- H. That not extending the benefits of Cabinet Decision regarding Technical Allowance to the petitioners and inaction of the respondents in this regard is against the norms of justice, equity equality, discriminatory and principles of fair play. Therefore such discriminatory treatment of the respondents towards the petitioners is not sustainable in the eyes of law.
- I. That the petitioners are also engineers and working in the Govt; department of C& and as such are fully entitled to the Technical Allowance in light of cabinet Decision in which there was no classification of the kind of engineers at all.
- J. That the inaction and discriminatory treatment of the respondents is against the spirit of Articles - 2A, 4, 9, 25 & 38 of the Constitution. Therefore, refusal and not extending the benefit of Cabinet Decision to the appellant, is liable to be struck down.

- K. That the acts and omissions of the respondents amounts to making groups on the basis of irrational classifications and is violation of principles of intelligible differentia.
- L. That under Article 25 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973, all citizen are equal before law, and that no discrimination is permitted in the similarly placed citizens, thus the discrimination meted out to the appellatant by not allowing technical allowance, illegal, highly discriminatory and not sustainable
- M. That the state is bound to ensure the elimination of all forms of exploitation and the gradual fulfillment of the fundamental principles. It is also the duties of the state to remove disparity in the income and earning of individuals under Article 37 & 38 of the Constitution.
- N. That the Appellant seeks permission of this Honourable Tribunal to rely on additional grounds at the time of hearing of the appeal.

It is, therefore, humbly prayed that On acceptance of this appeal the appellatant may kindly be allow the benefit of Technical allowance in reference to the notification dated 19.10.2018, has been allowed to the counterpart colleagues of the appellatant of the same department while performing the same duties with the same job description and nomenclature i.e. SDO's/Assistant engineers, In light of the Higher Education Commission's decisions approval/orders of the Ministry of Education, water & power Declaration of PEC and decisions of different courts of law, the discriminatory treatment meted out to the appellatant in reference to the technical allowance, and denying the same is illegal unlawful and unlawful authority and violative upon the rights of the appellatant, furthermore the respondents may kindly be directed to allow the Technical allowance to the appellatant or any other relief which may not specifically asked for may also be awarded in favor of the appellatant

2. In order to implement decision of the Provincial Cabinet, I am therefore tires led to request to kindly issue notification regarding Technical Allowance to the Government Engineers.

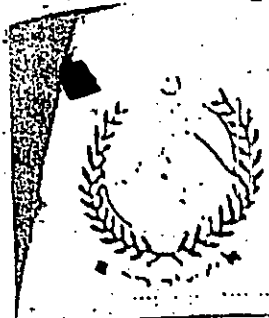

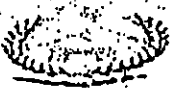
6. SUBJECT: APPEAL FOR GRANT OF TECHNICAL ALLOWANCE TO SDO.s / A.E.s WORKING IN C&W DEPARTMENT IN BS-17, POSSESSING B.TECH (HONS) DEGREE.

Honorable Sir,

I, would like to draw your esteemed attention towards the minutes issued by the KP Administration Department, where in, at agenda item No 7 of these minutes, it states that, "The Secretary Irrigation department briefed the Cabinet regarding the agenda item "Demand of KP Government Engineers Association" that the item was discussed in previous cabinet meeting held on 17.05.2018 and that the Cabinet agreed to reconsider its decision in the following matter;

- i. The Cabinet approved Technical Allowance @1.5 times of the initial basic pay scale to all Engineers working in the provincial government departments, w.e.f, 1st July 2018. (Annex -A).

Sir, at the time of approval of the Technical Allowance, there were no conditions attached for registration with any Council / Body / Association. However, when a notification to the effect was issued by the finance department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, vide FD (SO-SR-II)8-7/2018-2019, dated 19-10-2018; the Technical Allowance had been shown as allowed only to Engineers holding Engineering Qualification from accredited engineering programs of Higher Education Institutions, Universities duly recognized by HEC, and who are registered with PEC and serving against the sanctioned posts in C&W Irrigation, PHE, & Local Government Departments of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa with effect from 1st November, 2018. (Annex -B).

Sir, the said notification is based on mala fide intentions, injustice and is in violation of Article 3 and 25 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan on the following grounds;


- i. That the Higher Education Commission, vide decision taken in its 39th meeting of Equivalency Committee of erstwhile University Grant Commission (UGC), held on 12-02-1998, declared B-Tech (Hcn's) degree as compatible and at Par to B.E/B.Sc Engineering for the propose of Employment, Grades, Pay, Promotion and other benefits. (Annex-C).

With reference to your application dated May 21, 2007 on the subject, the decision regarding equivalence of B.Tech (Hons) degree was taken in its 39th meeting of Equivalence Committee of erstwhile UGC held on 12.2.1998 had declared B.Tech (Hons) degree as compatible and at par to BE/B.Sc Engineering for purpose of employment. The decision of the Committee is reproduced below for your information:

"The degree of B.Tech (Hons) is not similar to B.E/B.Sc Engineering degree. Both the degrees of B.E/B.Sc Engineering and B.Tech (Hons) be considered as two distinct disciplines of knowledge in the field of Engineering and Technology and should run parallel to each other. My dear Governor,

As you may be aware the polytechnic Diploma Holders had been agitating for a long time for provision of facilities for higher education. In order to resolve this issue in consultation with the Provincial Governments and various Associations of the Polytechnic Diploma Holder, I convened a meeting on the 26th October, 1973 of the Chairman/Directors of Technical Education in the Provinces, Principals of Polytechnics, representatives of Engineering Universities/Colleges and representatives of various Associations of the Polytechnic Diploma Holders. It was decided that steps should be taken to introduce the degree programmes for the polytechnic diploma holders without further delay.

2. As envisaged in the new Education Policy, the following programme was adopted. There will be two degree courses for diploma holders: (I) B. Tech. (Pass) and (II) B. Tech. (Honours).

3. Admission to the B. Tech. (Pass) course shall be subject to the candidates fulfilling the following minimum requirements:—

(I) Three years diploma from a Polytechnic Institute in first division.

(II) Two years industrial training/experience. Candidates without industrial experience shall be required to undergo one year supervised/guided practical training in industry to be arranged by the institution concerned.

(III) Performance in the admission test.

4. B. Tech. (Pass) course will consist of a years programme of studies at the institution. The degree of B. Tech. (Pass) shall be treated at par with a Bachelors degree in Science.

5. Candidates having successfully completed B. Tech. (Pass) degree courses will be eligible for admission to a two years B. Tech. (Honours) course. The first year of this course will comprise supervised/guided industrial training during which the students shall be assigned specific projects relevant to their fields of study. The second year will consist of intensive study at the institution. B. Tech. (Honours) degree shall be treated at par with B.Sc. (Engineering)/B.E. Degree.

It was also decided that so long as necessary facilities do not exist in Baluchistan and N.W.F.P. and other backward areas, Federal Government will arrange placement of students from these areas in other provinces.

You are requested to kindly direct the relevant authorities of your provinces to implement these decisions urgently.

The Council has explained several times that the level of education of Diploma holders is equivalent to F. Sc. and even in Armed Forces they are considered as F. Sc. for the purpose of selection in PMA Long Courses. In this connection a copy of AGs Br. letter No. AGs Br(PA Qto)/GHQ Rawalpindi No. 4316/1807/PA-3(a) dated 7.1.81 is enclosed herewith.

The Manual of Studies of Polytechnic Institutes defines that product of these Polytechnic Institutes are Technicians who are capable to understand the intention of Engineers and explain the same to workers.

The same Manual authorises Diploma Holders to take admission in the First Year of B. Sc. Engg for which a quota is reserved in all the Engg Universities/Colleges.

The Council has approved B. Tech (Hons) as equivalent to B. Sc. Engg which a Diploma Holder can pass after 4 years of passing the final examination in diploma. The Council has also equated AMIE Examination equivalent to B. Sc. Engg. These facilities have been provided to those who want to improve their qualifications to become equivalent to B. Sc. Engg. You are advised to improve your qualifications if you wish to be registered as a Professional Engineer with the Council.

JUDGMENT

MUHAMMAD SHAFI SIDDIQUI J. - The petitioners through the instant petitions have sought following reliefs:-

- a) consider the petitioner having (B.Tech) (Hons) at par with the Graduate Engineers having B.E/B.Sc. degrees.
- b) direct the respondents to grant Rs.10,000/- Special Engineering Allowance from the date it was allowed to graduate Engineers and restrain them from depriving the petitioners by taking the plea of Graduate Engineers / Registration with Pakistan Engineering Council.
- c) direct the respondents to consider the petitioners for promotion as Senior Engineer BPS-18 and restrain them from depriving the petitioner by taking the plea of Graduate Engineers / Registration with Pakistan Engineering Council and grant them promotion by maintaining inter se seniority.
- d) declare there shall be no discrimination between Graduate Engineers and promoted Junior Engineers with regard to any perks and privileges guaranteed under terms and conditions of service.
- e) award any other relief as deemed just and proper in the circumstances of the case.

2. These two petitions involve a common question as to keeping the petitioners at par with Graduate Engineers i.e. B.E / B.Sc. who have been



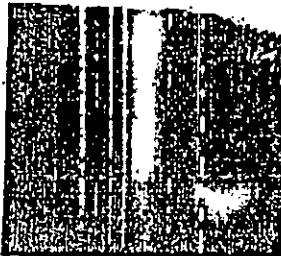
employed by GUNCO and PEPCO a generating and distributing Company of electricity. These questions apparently were discussed at length by Division Bench of this Court in C.P No.D-1578 of 2010 and C.P No.D-204 of 2008, whereby the B-Tech (Hons) were treated at par with Graduate Engineers and were also held entitled to Special Allowance of Rs.10,000/-. In addition to this allowance, they were also treated at par with Graduate Engineers insofar as their promotion is concerned. The Hon'ble Supreme Court while dealing with the identical issue observed that the provisions of Pakistan Engineering Council are applicable only to the Professional Engineers and Consulting Engineers, who are in practice and not to the persons working in Government Department, Autonomous Bodies, Local Authorities and Private Firms or Companies, therefore, the demand of such degree in civil, mechanical or Agricultural Engineering registered with Pakistan Engineering Council by the respondents and not considering B-Tech (Hons) degree holders whose degree are declared compatible at par with B.E / B.Sc. Engineering degree holders i.e. for the allowances and promotion, was not justified, hence, for all intent purposes, this degree of B-Tech (Hons) was kept at par with B.E and B.Sc. Engineering degrees.

3. The question involved in these petitions is also identical, however, Mr. Muhammad Arshad S. Paktan, learned counsel for respondents submits that these petition have virtually become infructuous as the petitioners have been allowed up-gradation and from now onward they are to be considered at par with Graduate Engineers for their promotion and all such rules shall be made applicable as that to Graduate Engineers.

4. In view of above, these petitions are allowed on the terms as incorporated in C.P No.D-1578 of 2010, C.P No.D-204 of 2008 and C.P No.D-1858 of 2012. In case, the petitioners were already working in Grade-17 in 2009, they are entitled for this allowance since 2009 and are also considered eligible for promotion in accordance with law as other Engineers B.E and B.Sc. are entitled.

The petitions are allowed in the above terms

JUDGMENT

RAJA HASAN ABBAS, MEMBER:- The issue at hand is whether the appellants are entitled to Special Engineering / WAPDA Allowance @ Rs.10,000/- per month, allowed vide O.M dated 30.08.2008 to the graduate Engineers in BS-17 and above serving in all Engineering Cadres of WAPDA. The appellants who are Junior Engineers, holding degree of B.Tech. (Hons) and working at Warsak Power Station have been denied this Allowance. Their appeal before the Member Power, WAPDA was turned down vide order dated 11.01.2017, hence these appeals.

2. Crux of the averments of the appellants is that the Special Allowance has not only been allowed to the graduate engineers, it has also been granted to the graduate / post graduate officers working in administration, finance, accounts, Geologists and Scientists working in WAPDA. Disallowing the same to the appellants, holding the B. Tech.(Hons) Degree, is patent discrimination and violation of Article 25 of the Constitution. The appellants have referred to the precedents wherein such allowance has been allowed to their colleagues in Power Supply Companies, such as MEPCO, LESCO, PEPCO, IESCO / NTDC. Reliance has also been placed on various judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan, Sindh High Court and Lahore High Court.

3. The respondents have opposed the contentions through submission of para-wise comments. Prime reasons for declining the request of the appellants in their view are:-

- i. *They are not graduate engineers and have not been registered with the Pakistan Engineering Council.*
- ii. *The precedents of Electric Supply Companies are not binding because WAPDA is a statutory body and has powers under its own Act to hire employees on such terms and conditions as deemed appropriate.*
- iii. *Special WAPDA allowance is cadre and qualification specific and has been sanctioned to attract and retain the best of talent in the organization.*
- iv. *FST, vide judgment dated 13.04.2010, in appeal No. 109-122(R)CS-2009, dismissed the appeal of non-graduate engineers (Diploma holders) who were not granted the special allowance.*

4. Having carefully examined the arguments of the parties, we are of the view that the stance of the respondents lacks substance and is devoid of merit. It is discriminatory in nature.

5. Main objection of the respondents in denying the Special Allowance to the appellants is that they are neither graduate Engineer nor registered with Pakistan Engineering Council.

6. The B. Tech. (Honours) degree and ancillary matters have a long history. It will be useful to briefly recapitulate the entire issue. It was first highlighted when Mr. Abdul Hafeez Pirzada, the then Minister of Education, sent a D.O letter dated 26.10.1973 addressed to Governors of all the Provinces, reproduced below for facility of reference:-

" As you may be aware the Polytechnic Diploma Holders had been agitating for a long time for provision of facilities for higher education.

2. As envisaged in the new Education Policy, the following programme was adopted. There will be two degree courses for diploma holder: (i) B. Tech. (Pass) and (ii) B. Tech. (Honours).

3. Admission to the B. Tech. (Pass) course shall be subject to the candidates fulfilling the following minimum requirements:-

(i). Three years diploma from a Polytechnic Institute in first division.

(ii). Two years industrial training / experience. Candidates without industrial experience shall be required to undergo one year supervised / guided practical training in industry to be arranged by the institution concerned.

(iii). Performance in the admission test.

4. B. Tech. (Pass) course will consist of a year's programme of studies at the institution. The degree of B. Tech. (Pass) shall be treated at par with the Bachelors degree in Science.

7. The Higher Education Commission addressed a letter No 8-61/HEC/A&A/2013 dated 09.01.2013 to the Section Officer, (Univ), Higher Education Department Government of the Punjab, Lahore, on the following subject:-

"Confirmation of Status of Degree Programme i.e. B. Tech. (Honours) degree at par with B.Sc. (Engg)/BE degrees."

"With reference to your letter No.S.O(Univ) 10-2/12 dated December 22, 2012 on the subject, it is to inform that decision regarding equivalence of B. Tech (Hons) degree was taken in its 39th meeting of Equivalence Committee of erstwhile UGC held on 12.02.1998 had declared B. Tech (Hons) degree as compatible and at par to BE/B.Sc Engineering for purpose of employment. The decision of the Committee is reproduced below for your information and is applicable in your case as well.

"The degree of B. Tech. (Hons) is not similar to B.E/B.Sc Engineering Degree. Both the degrees of B.E/B.Sc Engineering and B.Tech (Hons) be considered as two distinct disciplines of knowledge in the field of Engineering and Technology and should run parallel to each other. However, B. Tech. (Hons) may be treated at par and compatible with B.E/B.Sc Engineering degree holders as far as grades, pay and promotions and other benefits are concerned. The Committee further noted that it was up to the employer to determine the type of qualification required for a particular job."

It is further stated that admission in a university for further education and determination of suitability in relation to job requirement rests with the concerned university / employing agency is and this Commission has no role in such issues.

8. It would also be appropriate to refer to the O.M. of Ministry of Water and Power No.CDN-11-2/7/95-1, dated 14.03.1996. Para-2 of the O.M. reads as

"2. The Supreme Court of Pakistan has given a judgment in *Suo Moto* review petition No.52 of 1993 that the provisions of the Pakistan Engineering Council Act are applicable only to professional Engineers and consulting engineers who are in practice and not to the persons working in the Government departments, autonomous bodies, local authorities and private firms and companies. Likewise, the court held that the Pakistan Engineering Council is vested with the functions to regulate the persons qualified to practice as professional engineers and consultant engineers and not persons who are employed in Government or Semi Government organizations. If the Government employees as professional engineer as defined in the Act for performing professional engineering work as envisaged by the Act in clause (k) of section 2, the provisions of the act would be attracted and otherwise."

9. It is also relevant to mention Office Order of Federal Public Service Commission No.F.4-80/2002-R dated 10.12.2002 which reads as under:-

"In the light of the Ministry of Water & Power O.M No.CDN-11-2/7/95-1, dated 14.03.1996 and also in the light of the advice of the UGC (now Higher Education Commission) declaring the B. Tech(Hons) degree at par with B.E. / B.Sc. Engineering degree, it has been decided by the Commission that the candidates possessing the qualification of B. Tech (Hons) will be eligible for the post where prescribed qualification is B.E. / B.Sc. Engineering.

2. The condition of registration of engineers with Pakistan Engineering Council, which was imposed by the Establishment Division vide their letter No.16/02/80-R.S, dated 14.12.1986 has been withdrawn vide their letter No.9/3/89-R.S dated 01.04.1996. Therefore, the condition of registration with Pakistan Engineering Council where the required qualification is B.E. / B.Sc. Engineering should not be mentioned in the advertisement.

10. It is thus obvious that the Government at the highest level and relevant administrative authorities have no hesitation in holding B.Tech. (Hons) degree at par and compatible with B.E./B.Sc. engineering degree holders as far as
