1. Learned counsel for the appellant present and heard.

2. The learned counsel for the appellant submits that respondents No. 1,2 and 7 to 40 were arrayed as respondents as an abandoned precaution whereas, because the appellant was voicing for indication of his rights, therefore, at present there was no need to implead the above respondents He requested for deletion of their names for the time being. Names respondents No. 1,2 and 7 to 40 are deleted from the panel of respondents. Office is directed to make necessary entry in the relevant register as well as memo of appeal.

3. While treating the writ petition as service appeal, the Hon'ble Peshawar High Court found that the comments have already been submitted and the case was ripe, therefore, it is admitted to full hearing. For the purpose of procuring service, notices be issued to the other side. The appellant is directed to deposit security fee within ten days. Respondents be summoned through TCS/LCS, the expenses of which be deposited by the appellant within three days. To come up for written reply/comments on 27.11.2023 before S.B at camp court Abbottabad. P.P given to the parties.
