There are other pending matters on point of implementation of judgment in rhyme by the civil servants, who were not party to the litigation, which ended in favor of such petitioners and a judgment in rhyme was passed, the petitioners who had not litigated would resort to the procedure provided under Section-4 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Civil Servants Act, 1974 or they would simply make implementation application to get benefit of the judgment without observing the procedure provided under Section-4 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Civil Servants Act, 1974. The office is directed to club all such cases and fix on a single date. To come up for implementation report on 30.11.2023 before S.B at Camp Court, Abbottabad. P.P given to the parties.
