1. Learned counsel for the appellant present. Mr. Asad Ali Khan, Assistant Advocate General present. Nobody is present on behalf of the respondents.

2. Despite clear written direction on the previous date, for production of record, the order of the Tribunal is not yet complied with. The Tribunal avoids to the maximum extent to take coercive measures but it is compelled and constrained by the attitude of the respondents or their so-called representatives, who are neither duly authorized nor well conversant officers of Grade-17 and are putting appearance without record. Because of such irresponsible attitude and taking least interest in production of documents/records before the Tribunal for proper decision of the cases and for the disinterest of the concerned departments in pursuing the Court matters/protecting the interest of the Government, lead the Tribunal to resort to coercive measures. Therefore, the Tribunal will be constrained to attach the salaries of the respondents for non-compliance of the court orders, if they fail to produce the record, directed to be produced vide order dated 14.06.2023, for which last chance is given. To come up for production of record on 23.01.2024 before D.B. P.P given to the parties. Copy of this order sheet be taken by the learned Assistant Advocate General to the Chief Secretary for his information as none of the Court proceedings/directions are brought in the notice of the high-ups and only last coercive step is placed

before them.
