APPEAL U/S OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL, 1974, AGAINST THE IMPUGNED WITHDRAWAL AND TRANSFER ORDERS DATED 03-03-2023 AND 30-03-2023 PASSED BY RESPONDENTS NO. 1 AND 2, WHEREBY THEY FIRSTLY WITHDRAW THE POSTING/TRANSFER ORDER APPEALLANT AND IN SECOND IMPUGNED SUBSEQUENT ORDER -THEY TRANSFERRED/POSTED RESPONDENT NO.5 AS SDEO (FEMALE) ON THE POST OF APPELLANT.

Respectfully Sheweth:

The facts giving rise/leading to the filling of instant appeal are as follows:

- 1. That the appellant belongs to Chouga Tehsil Puran,
 District Shangla. (Copy of the CNIC is attached as
 annexure "A").
- 2. That the appellant is having long and unblemished service record in the "Education Department" as was posted as SST-G, GGHS Puran Shangla.
- 3. That the appellant was transferred from the said post and was posted as Sub Divisional Education Officer (Female) Circle Puran Shangla against a leave vacancy vide the order No. 7845-49/A-17/Transfer/Shangla dated: 16-01-2023 duly issued by the respondent No.2. (Copy of the order is attached as annexure "B").
- 4. That the appellant was adjusted as SDEO(F) Puran Shangla and it was pertinent to mention that previously she has remained posted on the said post for four and half years.

- 5. That on the emergence of Care- Taker government, the transfer order already issued was cancelled in a arbitrary manner vide the impugned order No. 5480-84/A-17/Transfer/Shangla dated: 3-3-2023 by the same respondent No.2. (Copy of the impugned order dated: 3-3-2023 is attached as annexure "C").
- 6. That again respondent No.2 issued yet another order dated: 30 March 2023 vide the impugned notification No.

 SO(MC)

 E&SED/416/2022/Posting/Transfer/MC posted respondent No.5 as SDEO (F) Puran. He was transferred from the post of SST (G) GMS, Balu Puran. (Copy of the impugned order/notification is attached as annexure "D").
- 7. That the appellant submitted departmental appeal/representation dated 3-4-2023 to the concerned authorities but till date neither it has been decided nor any intimation has been made to the petitioner. (Copy of the appeal/representation is attached as annexure "E").

- 8. That prior to approaching this Honorable Court, she has approached the Honorable Peshawar High Court Swat Bench, wherein she has been directed to approach the appropriate forum. (Copy of the Order/Judgement of the Honorable High Court dated 26-04-2023 is attached herewith as annexure-F)
- Peshawar High Court, submits departmental appeal before the Director Elementary and Secondary Education for the redressal of his genuine grievances but of no avail. (Copy of the departmental appeal submitted to Director Elementary and Secondary Education, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa is attached herewith as annexure-G)
- 10. That feeling seriously aggrieved from the above arbitrary and illegal orders of the respondents, the appellant, having no other adequate efficacious remedy available at the moment, the appellant approaches this Honorable Court, inter-alia on the following grounds:



GROUNDS:

- A. That both the impugned orders dated: 3-3-2023 and dated 30-03-2023 are against the law, rules, and procedure of the subject matter.
- B. That the transfer, posting order of the appellant as made by the previous government and the care-taker government was not competent to cancel those orders or to transfer and appoint any person instead of the appellant.
- C. That the appellant has previously served for four and half years for the post of SDEO (F) Puran, Shangla having already the requisite qualification and experience for the said post. Moreover, the appellant has already performed her duties to the complete satisfaction of her superior, colleagues and subordinate staff.
- D. That the post in question is purely a female post dealing with the female staff, teachers and students.

 Now to cancel the transfer/posting of the appellant (Female Officer) and to appoint instead a male officer is neither lawful nor a reasonable proportional.

- E. That the orders impugned herein are violative of the fundamental rights of the appellant as well as the impugned orders amount to discrimination against the female civil servants.
- F. That the treatment meted out to the appellant is highly discriminatory and in clear violation of the orders of the Election Commission of Pakistan as mandated under Articles 218 (3), 220 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan read with section 4, 5, 8 (c) and 220 of the Election Act, 2017.
- G. That any other ground/document would be raised during the course of the arguments with the prior permission of this Honorable Court.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of this appeal, the impugned orders dated: 3-3-2023 and 30-3-2023 may kindly be declared as illegal, unlawful, and she may kindly be allowed to resumed her duties as SDEO (F) Circle Puran Shangla.



Any other remedy which is not specifically asked for and this Hon'ble Court deems fit in the circumstance of the case may also be granted to the appellant.





JUDGMENT

SHAHID KHAN, J.- Mst. Shahi Ghulfam, the petitioner, has filed the instant writ petition under Article 199 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973, with the following prayer:

"It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of this the impugned writ petition, orders dated 03.03.2023 and kindly be 30.03.2023 may declared as illegal, unlawful, unconstitutional and ineffective upon the rights of the petitioner and may kindly be set aside. Any other remedy which is not specifically asked for and this Hon'ble Court deems fit in the circumstance of the case may also be granted to the petitioner"







the petitioner has been confronted with the proposition that the petitioner being a civil servant, however, has sought the cancellation of her transfer order through the subject writ petition, it is hard fact that the relief sought pertains to the terms & conditions of her service. Law on subject speaks load & clear under Article 212 (2), Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973, the relief so sought has its origin in the terms & conditions of service. On this score alone, the Court is functus officio and hard to assume its jurisdiction under Article 199 of the Constatation, to redress the grievances of the petitioner and to allow a writ of mandamus in her favour.



- 3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length and the record gone through.
- proposition that the petitioner being an employee of the Education Department and does qualify to be a Civil Servant. The subject proposition has fairly been conceded by the learned counsel for the petitioner at the bar coupled with the fact that the same is floating on the surface of the record in view of the

documents so made part & parcel of the file/record and the appointment order of the petitioner speaks load & clear in this regard that she is a civil servant within the meaning of Section 2, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act, 1973. It is relevant to be noted that under Article 240, Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the terms & conditions of service of all the federal employees shall be regulated by an Act enacted by the Parliament, while the terms & conditions of services of all the employees of provincial government shall be regulated by an Act passed by the concerned Provincial Assembly. As per the aforesaid mandate of Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Provincial Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has enacted an Act i.e. "Civil Servants Act of 1973", where Chapter-II stipulates the terms & conditions of service of a civil servant, the said Chapter comprises from sections No. 3 to 22, whereof, section 10 deals with the "transfer" of a civil servant/government employee.

5. So, in view of the above constitutional and legal provisions, it is established on surface of the record that the petitioner is a civil servant and

her grievances agitated in the present petition coupled with at the bar pertains to one her terms & conditions of service.

6. Now, the next question shall be the selection of forum, competent enough to redress the grievance of a civil servant with respect to his/her terms & conditions of service, as in the case in hand. There shall be no way out but reference to sub-Article (2) of Article 212, Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan to address the grievance of an aggrieved person/civil servant.

<u> 212. Administrative Courts and</u> Tribunals

- (1) Notwithstanding anything hereinbefore contained, the appropriate Legislature may by Act provide for the establishment of one or more Administrative Courts or Tribunals to exercise exclusive jurisdiction in respect of:—
- (a) matters relating to the terms and conditions of persons who are or have been in the service of Pakistan, including disciplinary matters;
- (b) matters relating to claims arising from tortlous acts of Government, or any person in the service of Pakistan, or of any local or other authority empowered by law to levy any tax or cess and any servant of such authority acting in the discharge of his duties as such servant; or

- (c) matters relating to the acquisition, administration and disposal of any property which is deemed to be enemy property under any law.
- (2) Notwithstanding anything hereinbefore contained where any Administrative Court or Tribunal is established under clause (1), no other court shall grant an injunction, make order or entertain any proceedings in respect of any matter to which the jurisdiction of such Administrative Court or Tribunal extends and all proceedings in respect of any such matter which may be pending before such other before court immediately establishment of the Administrative Court or Tribunal; other than an appeal pending before the Supreme Court. shall abatė on such establishment;

Provided that the provisions of this clause shall not apply to an Administrative Court or Tribunal established under an Act of a Provincial Assembly unless, at the request of that Assembly made in the form of a resolution, Majlis-e-Shoora (Parliament) by law extends the provisions to such a Court or Tribunal."

specifically indicates that all the administrative Courts and Tribunals shall assume the jurisdiction in respect of the matters relating to the terms & conditions of the person(s) (who are or have been) in service of Pakistan or of Provincial Government

and sub-Article (2) of Article 212 Constitution of Pakistan specifically bars any other forum/Court to interfere with, in the matters relating to the terms & conditions of a civil servant. In the case of "Peer Muhammad v/s Government of Baluchistan through Chief Secretary & others" reported as 2007 SCMR 54, the Apex Court has held:

"the question of posting/transfer relates to terms and conditions of a Government servant and Service Tribunal would have exclusive jurisdiction to dilate upon and such matters and Constitutional jurisdiction cannot get such invoked to controversies resolved. We have also adverted to the question of mala fides which according to the learned Advocate could have been dilated upon in Constitutional jurisdiction which is not correct bécause - the provisions contained in Article 212 of The Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan ousts jurisdiction of all other Courts and orders of the departmental authority though without jurisdiction or mala fide can be challenged only before the Service Tribunal and jurisdiction of all Courts including High Court is specifically ousted. The plea of mala fide does not confer upon High Court jurisdiction to act in the matter in view of the Constitutional ouster as contained in Article 212 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan and learned Service Tribunal has full jurisdiction to interfere in such-like matters."





Similarly, in the case of "Kh. Abdul Wahid v. Chairman, WAPDA" reported as 1986 SCMR 1534 the Apex Court has held:

> "if the petitioners are able to show that the action against them was indeed actuated by mala fides, the Tribunal would not be debarred from taking note of this."

It is pertinent to highlight that under section 22 of the Civil Servants Act, 1973, the petitioner is required to approach the appropriate forum for appropriate remedy through a departmental appeal to the next higher an authority who has passed the impugned order, in the case in hand, it shall be the Director Elementary & Secondary Education, Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar, (respondent No. 2 herein) as the impugned order was passed by District Education Officer and then after the decision of the departmental authority or waiting for statutory period of 90 days, the petitioner could approach the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal for the redressal of her grievances by filing a service appeal.
