The respondents respectfully submit as under: -

#### PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS.

- 1. That the appellant has got no cause of action.
- 2. That the appeal is not maintainable under the law.
- 3. That the appeal is barred by law & limitation.
- 4. That the appellant has not been discriminated in any way.
- 5. That the appeal is bad due to mis-joinder and non-joinder of necessary parties.
- 6. That the appellant has approached the Honorable Tribunal with unclean hands.
- 7. That the appellant has got no cause of action and locus-standi to file the instant Appeal.
- 8. That the appellant has been stopped by his own conduct, as she had herself requested, thus cant challenge the impugned order after the acceptance of her request.

#### **BRIEF FACTS:**

- 8. Correct to the extent, that departmental appeal was submitted to W/RPO Bannu but was rejected being devoid of merit.
- 9. Pertain to record. However, the appeal is badly time barred.

- 11. Pertain to record. Further, show cause notice was duly served upon the appellant. (Copy is attached as annexure E)
- 12. Incorrect, all codal formalities were adopted during enquiry proceedings.
- 13. Incorrect, the departmental enquiry was conducted according to law/Rule/Policy.
- 14. Incorrect, proper show cause notice was issued in the parameter of law.
