The case was adjourned to 01.09.2023 on which date too learned counsel for the appellant was not in attendance and the case was adjourned to 10.10.2023. Even today learned counsel for the appellant was not available despite repeated calls till rising of the court. It appears that he is not interested in pursuing the case.
