MUHAMMAD AMIN KHAN KUNDI, MEMBER: - Counsel for the
appellant present. Mr. Ziaullah, Deputy District Attorney for the respondents
present. Arguments heard and record perused.

2. Brief facts of the case as per present service appeal are that the appellant
was appointed as Primary School Teacher (BPS-7) vide order dated 27.03.2012.

His appointment order was withdrawn vide order dated 12.04.2012 by the competent authority on the allegation that the appellant having Skill Development Counsel^{diploma in} which has not been considered by the District Selection Committee for his appointment for the category of PST. The appellant filed departmental appeal on 21.05.2012 which was not decided hence, the present service appeal on 07.02.2013.

3. Respondents were summoned who contested the appeal by filing written reply/comments.

4. Learned counsel for the appellant contended that the appellant was appointed as Primary School Teacher (BPS-7) vide order dated 27.03.2012. It was further contended that the appellant joined his duty and was performing his duty regularly. It was further contended that the appellant was fully qualified and he was appointed after observing of all the codal formalities. It was further contended that neither any show-cause notice was issued to the appellant nor proper inquiry was conducted before passing the impugned order therefore, impugned order dated 12.04.2012 regarding withdrawal of appointment order of the appellant is illegal and liable to be set-aside and prayed for acceptance of appeal.


5. On the other hand, learned Deputy District Attorney for the respondents opposed the contention of learned counsel for the appellant and contended that the appellant was appointed as Primary School Teacher (BPS-7) but his appointment order was withdrawn vide order dated 12.04.2012 on the complaint of one Muhammad Riaz Khan as the appellant had Skill Development Diploma which was not a required qualification. It was further contended that the departmental appeal was filed on 21.05.2012 which was not decided and the appellant filed the present service appeal on 07.02.2013. It was further contended that the appellant was required to file service appeal after waiting of 90 days for decision of the departmental appeal but the appellant has filed the


service appeal after a delay of more than eight months therefore, the service appeal of the appellant is badly time barred and prayed for dismissal of appeal.

6. Perusal of the record reveals that the appointment order of the appellant was withdrawn by the competent authority on 12.04.2012, the appellant has filed departmental appeal on 21.05.2012 which was not decided within the stipulated period of 90 days therefore, the appellant was required to file service appeal within one month after statutory period of 90 days but the appellant filed the present service appeal on 07.02.2013 after a delay of more than eight months therefore, the present service appeal is badly time barred. As such, without touching the merit of the case the present service appeal is dismissed being time barred. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.

On acceptance of the instant appeal the impugned order/notification by the respondents may be declared as null and void and the appellant may be permitted to continue with his services as a matter of right.

Respectfully Sheweth: -

The appellant submits as under: -

1. That the appellant was appointed as a PST in PBS-07 in Masi Gul KILLEY under order No. 3805/G Dated: 27/03/2012 in BPS-07 and was posted in the Government Primary School, Masi Gul KILLEY Tehsil Thakht Bhai District Mardan. **(Copy of Appointment letter is attached herewith as annexure-A)**
2. That soon after the appointment the appellant immediately joined his duty and started his duty/teaching classes in the Government Primary School, Masi Gul KILLEY Tehsil Thakht Bhai District Mardan. **The photo copy of the attendance register is attached as annexure-B.**
3. That unexpectedly less than a month the respondent No. 3 through an impugned notification/order dated 12/04/2012 ordered the removal from the services of the appellant. **The photo copy of the impugned order is attached as annexure-B**
4. That the appellant passed his Secondary School Certificate examination in the year 1998 from the Board of intermediate & secondary education ^{Peshawar} ~~Mardan~~ and completed his Master in political Science from University of Peshawar in 2007, Similarly has passed and completed his PTC course as part of the Skill Development Counsel Diploma from a registered and reputable institution in Lahore. **(Copy of the certificates and Master Degree are attached as annexure-C,D & E)**
5. That as per advertisement/notification published in "DAILY AJJ" and "DAILY MASHRIQ" which were wishing/asking for the appointment of

suitable, dedicated, energetic, hard workers candidates against the vacant vacancies of PST within the parameter of District Mardan.

6. That by finding the opportunity the appellant applied for the same post of PST in PBS-07 as a dedicated and eligible candidate with much higher qualification than what was required. After going through the tough procedure of the departmental selection committee the appellant was appointed against the vacant post in the Government Primary School, Masi Gul KILLEY Tehsil Thakht Bhai District Mardan.
7. That through endst: No. 4542-46 Dated: 12/04/2012 respondent No. 3 issued a notification due to which services of the appellant was held in abeyance through an illegal, whimsical and illogical order which is against the facts and circumstances of the case and hence ineffective on the rights of the appellant.
8. That the appellant subsequently filed a departmental appeal after gaining the knowledge, for redressal of his grievance before the competent authority which is not appreciated till date.

(Copy of departmental appeal as annexure-f)

Hence, this appeal on the following along with others: -

GROUND:

- A. That the appellant is a qualified / eligible for the PST as per the advertisement and also on the basis of criteria evaluated by the government in this behalf through various notifications after

attaining the qualification required from the date of his first appointment.

- B. That the Finance Department has already accepted the post of the appellant and located a specific budget from the date of his initial appointment, but discriminately not ready to allow him and release the same which is arbitrary and against the rules of natural justice as well as service structure.
- C. The appellant was appointed through a proper way following and adopting legal procedures by a competent authority in such a situation and conditions fully availed; the services of appellant cannot be terminated through an illegal and whimsical order.
- D. That the competent authority having itself appointed civil servant after the appellant fulfilled all the requirements including successfully passing the entry test in such a situation the authority could not be allowed to take benefit of its lapses in order to terminate the services of civil servant merely because it had itself committed mistake by not thoroughly scrutinize the credentials of the appellant at the time of appointment.
- E. That the respondent No.2 has rejected the departmental appeal of the appellant without any lawful authority.
- F. That terminating services of the appellant is against the law and whimsical in nature which should be declared as null and void.

G. That the impugned order is void arbitrary and is in utter disregard of the rules and regulations already enforced in the subject matter.

PRAYER

It is, therefore, humbly submitted that by accepting the instant appeal impugned notification by the respondents may be declared as null and void and the appellant may be permitted to continue with his services as a matter of right. Any other relief deems proper, may also be granted to the appellant.

8. His appeal has no weight hence was filed. Departmental appeal was rejected on the complaint of deserving candidate named Mr, Riaz Khan S/o Waheed Ullah of the said Union Council according to rules and law. That the appellant has SDC Diploma, which is not a required qualification.


Ground

- A. Incorrect, the appellant was not eligible for the post of PST.
- B. No such notification has been received in this office from finance department.
- C. Incorrect Appellant was terminated according to rules and law.
- D. Incorrect, The competent authority thoroughly scrutinizes the credentials of the appellant and did the needful according to law and justice.
- E. Incorrect, Departmental appeal was rejected according to law.
- F. Incorrect termination is just according to law.
- G. Incorrect, the order is based on rules & Law.

Prayers

It is therefore, humbly prayed that in the light of above facts, the appeal may please be rejected with cost, any other relief deems proper may also be granted to the respondents.



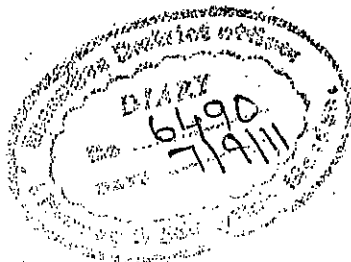


