Preliminary objections

i. That the appellant has got no locus standi to file this appeal.

- ii. That the appellant does not come to the court with clean hand.
- iii. That the appeal is not maintainable mis joinder and non-joinder for necessary parties.
- iv. That the appellant is estopped by own own conduct hence not able to file this petition.
- v. That appeal does not fall in jurisdiction of this tribunal under section 4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974, hence, not maintainable.
- vi. That the appeal is barred by law and limitation.

ON FACTS:

- Para 1 is incorrect. The appellant was appointed in Project Support Unit (PSU) Small Dams vide Ex- Chief Executive FDA office order No. Secy/FDA/3-235/Vol-VI/SD PSU/2019, dated 09/07/2019 under section 14(2) of FDA Standing Orders, 2011 as Site Supervisor, Project Pay Scale(PPS)-6 on urgency basis (Annex-A).
- 2) Para 2 pertains to record.
- Para 3 is correct; however, appellant was performing duties as Site supervisor Project Pay Scale(PPS)-6 as explained in Para 1 above.

- Para 4 need clarification. The sub committee recommended the regularization of 25 Nos. employees with condition that service promotion quota of service cadre would not be affected (Minutes of the Sub Committee attached as <u>Annex-B</u>).
- Para 5 is correct. It is clarified that as per condition "a" of the notification dated 07/07/2022 (Annex-C) and section 4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Regularization of service of employees of erstwhile Federally Administered Tribal Areas Act 2021 (Annex-D), the service promotion quota of all services cadres would not be affected.
- Para 6 needs clarification. Upon regularization of the services of 25 employees working in PSU Small Dams under the *Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Regularization of service of employees of erstwhile Federally Administered Tribal Areas Act 2021*, the Respondent No. 3 was requested by Respondent No. 2 for creation of the posts which was acceded by Respondent No. 3 and as such post of Sub Engineer was created in BPS 12 as per cadre of the post (Annex-E) in light of Service Rule of the Irrigation Department (Annex-F).
- The application of the appellant was submitted by Respondent No. 2 to Respondent No. 4 which was returned with direction to take up the matter with Respondent No. 3 (Annex-G). Accordingly, the issue was taken up with Respondent No. 3 who regretted (Annex-H) with plea that one-time upgradation of the post of Sub Engineers from BPS 11/12 to 16 was granted one time vide Finance Department Notification No. FD/SO(FR)7-13/2017/6253, dated 07/03/2018 (Annex-I).
- 8) That the appeal is not liable for acceptance.

ON GROUNDS.

- B. Pertain to record.
- C. Correct, however, the committee also recommended the regularization of 25 Nos. employees with condition that service promotion quota of service cadre would not be affected as already explained in Para 4 above.
- D. Incorrect. The scale of BPS 12 has been allotted to the appellant as per cadre of the Sub Engineer as per service rules Irrigation Department.
- E. Incorrect. As explained in para D above.

- F. Incorrect and denied. The new posts were created as per cadres by the Respondent No. including posts of Sub Engineers in BPS 12 as already explained in para 6 above.
- G. Correct. But each and every case has its own circumstances.
- H. Correct. But each and every case has its own circumstances.
- I. That the Respondents also seek permission to raise further points at the time of arguments.

PRAYER

It is therefore, humbly submitted that appeal filed by the appellant, being contrary to the service rules of the Irrigation Department, *Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Regularization of service of employees of erstwhile Federally Administered Tribal Areas Act 2021* and not falling under Section 4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province Service Tribunal Act 1974, may graciously be dismissed with order of cost, please.

REPORT OF THE SUB-COMMITTEE CONSTITUTED FOR SCRUTNY OF THE CREDENTIAL OF PROJECT EMPLOYEES OF PSU SMALL DAMS MERGED AREA IRRIGATION DEPARTMENT

- 1. In pursuance of Notification dated 06-06-2022, a series of meetings of the subcommittee were held on 14-06-2022, 23-06-2022 and 24-06-2022 under the chairmanship of Additional Secretary, Irrigation Department to check the credential of the Project employees of the Project "Creation of Project Support Unit (PSU) for Pre-Construction and Implementation of Small Dams/Power Section" reflected at Sr. No. 97 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Regularization of services of Employees of Erstwhile Federally Administrated Tribal Area) Act, 2021.
 - In the scrutiny the following three categories of employees were found to be tabled for discussion:
 - i. 16 Nos of employees appointed through project policy, notified and amended time to time by the Federal and Provincial Government.
 - ii. 8 Nos of employees of the "Ex-FDA" were appointed on Adhoc basis. Their services are extended through approved summary by the Hon'ble 'Chief Minister Khyber Pakhtunkhwa with the directions to regulate their services under KP Project Policy, 2017. In compliance a notification was issued by the Irrigation Department (Annex-I).
 - iii. 2 number employees i.e., Site-Supervisor and one driver of PSU, whose services have already been extended by the Competent Authority on the same analogy of 08 number employees as explained above (Annex-II).

FINDINGS

- 1. 18 Nos. of employees' credential were checked and found in light of the Project Policy, 2017 and the Act ibid but Mr. Nascem, Assistant Project Director (Accounts), date of birth is 10-03-1959 and it is unanimously agreed that his services could not be regularized owing to the reason that he has attained the age of 60 years prior to the approval of the Act ibid.
- 2. 8 Nos. employees were appointed on Adhoc basis but the competent authority i.e., Chief Minister Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has approved their continuation of services with the direction to regulate their services under Project Policy, 2017 which enables them for consideration under the Act.
- 3. As per TORs of the Committee, the two employees whose services placed at the disposal of Energy & Power Department vide this Department Notification No. SO(G)Irr/2-15/2020, dated 20-01-2021 (Annex-III), it was discussed and unanimously agreed that as the regularized project falls in the administrative control of Irrigation Department therefore, their regularization shall carried-out by Irrigation Department. Later on, their fate/placing of their services keeping in view their speciality should be decided jointly by Irrigation and Energy & Power Department.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the appointment and regularization of services of certain employees appointed on contract basis against project posts in the erstwhile Federally Administered Tribal Areas;

It is hereby enacted by the Provincial Assembly of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa as follows:

- 1. Short title, application and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Regularization of Services of Employees of Erstwhile Federally Administered Tribal Areas) Act, 2021.
- (2) It shall apply to all the employees as defined in clause (d) of subsection (1) of section 2 of this Act.
 - (3) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Definitions.—(1) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,-
 - (a) "Commission" means the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission;
 - (b) "Departmental Selection Committee" means a Departmental Selection Committee, constituted for purpose of making selection for appointment to project post under a Department or office in the erstwhile Federally Administered Tribal Areas;
 - (c) "Government" means the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa;
 - (d) "employees" means a person, who was appointed on contract basis, as per project policy, to a project post, in the erstwhile Federally Administered Tribal Areas, and such post was duly reflected in PC-I of that project, and who possess the prescribed qualification, training and experience for the said post at the time of such appointment;
 - (c) "Department" means a Government Department, as defined in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Rules of Business, 1985;
 - (f) "law or rules" means the law or rules, for the time being in force, governing the selection and appointment of civil servants;
 - (g) "project" means a perpetual nature project in the enstwhile Federally Administered Tribal Areas, the continuation of which and conversion to regular budget is essential for service delivery, duly identified by the Departments and reflected in the Schedule;

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- (h) "project post" means a post in the project; and
- (i) "Schedule" means a Schedule appended to this Act.
- (2) The expression "contract appointment" shall have the same meaning as respectively assigned to them in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act, 1973 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XVIII of 1973).
- 3. Appointment and regularization of services of employees.--- (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in any law or rules, the employees, appointed on contract basis; against project posts, in the erstwhile Federally Administered Tribal Areas, and holding such project posts till the commencement of this Act, shall be deemed to have been validly appointed, on regular basis, from the commencement of this Act, subject to verification of their qualifications and other credentials by the concerned Department.
- (2) All such employees, after the commencement of this Act, shall, in lieu of pension and gratuity, be entitled to receive such amount contributed by them towards the Contributory Provident Fund, along with the contributions made by Government to their account in the said Fund, in the prescribed manner.
- (3) A Committee, headed by the Secretary of the Department concerned, with the following membership, shall scrutinize all the credentials of the employees, before issuance of the regularization orders:
 - (a) head of the Attached Department concerned;
 - (b) representative of the Establishment and Administration Department of Government;
 - (c) representative of the Finance Department of Government;
 - (d) representative of the Planning and Development Department of Government; and
 - (e) Deputy Secretary of the Department concerned.

General conditions for regularization.—For the purpose of regularization of the employees under this Act, the following general conditions shall be observed:

(a) the service promotion quota of all service cadies shall not be affected;

- (b) the employees shall possess the same qualification and experience as required for a regular post;
- (c) the employees have not resigned from their services or terminated from service on account of misconduct, inefficiency or any other grounds before the commencement of this Act; and
- (d) the services of such employees shall be deemed to have been regularized only on the publication of their names in the official Gazette.
- 5. Determination of seniority.--(1) All employees, whose services are regularized under this Act, shall rank junior to all civil servants belonging to the same service or cadre, as the case may be, who are in service on regular basis on the commencement of this Act, and shall also rank junior to such other persons, if any, who, in pursuance of the recommendation of the Commission or Departmental Selection Committee, as the case may be, made before the commencement of this

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Act, are to be appointed to the respective service or cadre, irrespective of their actual date of appointment.

- (2) The seniority inter-se of the employees, whose services are regularized under this Act within the same service or cadre, shall be determined as per provisions of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act, 1973 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XVIII of 1973) and rules made thereunder.
- Removal of difficulties.—If any difficulty arises in giving effect to any of the provisions of this Act, the Chief Minister of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa may make such order, not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, as may appear to it to be necessary for the purpose of removing such difficulty.

Overriding effect.—Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any other law or rules, the provisions of this Act shall have an overriding effect and the provisions of any such law or rules to the extent of inconsistency to this Act shall cease to have effect.
