

SERVICE APPEAL U/S 4 OF NWFP SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974, AGAINST THE IMPUGNED TRANSFER ORDER DATED 06-01-2014 (ANNEX "A"), WHEREBY THE APPELLANT WAS PREMATURELY TRANSFERRED FROM DARGAI SUB DIVISION TO SWAT AND HIS DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL DATED 04-02-2014 (ANNEX "B"), WAS NOT DECIDED TILL THE EXPIRY OF STATUTORY PERIOD OF LIMITATION.

"Prayer"

- (a) By accepting this appeal and setting aside the impugned transfer order dated 06-01-2014 (Annex "A"), whereby the appellant was prematurely transferred to Swat from C&W Sub Division Dargai, and
- (b) Directing the respondent department to cancel the impugned premature transfer order of the appellant and he may be retained as Senior Clerk at Dargai Sub Division till the completion of his tenure.

Respectfully Sheweth,

- 1. The appellant since his appointment on 27-03-1988 has been serving the department honestly and diligently at different places of posting. That on 31-12-2010, the appellant was promoted to the rank of senior clerk and was posted to Malakand from Swat (Copy annexed hereto **marked "C"**). He assumed the charge of his duties on 01-01-2011.
- 2. That vide order dated 17-08-2012, after serving only for 19 months at Malakand, the appellant was transferred to C&W Sub Division, Dargai (Copy annexed hereto marked "D").

That for the third time after only 16 months of stay at Sub Division Dargai he was again transferred to Swat vide impugned order dated 06-01-2014 (Copy annexed hereto <u>marked "A)</u>.

3. That being transferred for almost four time in the last 3 years, the appellant submitted his departmental appeal dated 04-02-2014 (copy annexed hereto marked "B") before respondent No.1 which was not decided till the laps of statutory period of limitation of 90 days.

Feeling aggrieved and finding no other remedy, the appellant has been constrained to approach the Hon'ble Services Tribunal for the redress of his grievance, inter-alia on the following:

Grounds

- (a) The respondent department has acted in a most arbitrary manner while transferring the appellant prematurely, without allowing him to complete his tenure for the third time without showing any valid cause or cogent reason.
- (b) That the appellant has a clean service record, he was neither served with any adverse remarks nor complaint of any sort was ever filed against him. The respondent department has subjected the appellant to arbitrary treatment for the reasons best known to them.
- (c) The appellant was transferred just to accommodate a blue eyed junior clerk namely Abdul Wahid at Sub Division Dargai. A subordinate employee (junior clerk) has been posted to replace the appellant on the post of a senior clerk in his own pay scale. The impugned order is thus illegal, void and subject to cancellation on this count alone.

That several other officials of same designation are occupying their posts for more than 04 years and have not been disturbed till yet, which amounts to discrimination on the part of the respondent department.

- (d) The impugned transfer order is thus arbitrary, discriminatory, against the principles of equity, law, justice and proprietary, subject to correction by the worthy authority.
- (e) Appellant seeks permission to take several other grounds at the time of arguments.

In view of the above, it is most humbly requested that by accepting this appeal the impugned transfer order dated 06-01-2014 may kindly be set aside and the respondent department may be directed to retain the appellant at his present place of posting at Dargai Sub Division.

Any other relief deemed appropriate may also be granted



PRELIMINARY OBJECTION

- 1. That the appellant has got no locus stand and cause of action to invoke the jurisdiction of this Honorable Tribunal
- 2. That the appellant has not come to the Tribunal with clean hands.
- 3. That the appellant is estopped by his own conduct to prefer the instant appeal.
- 4. That the instant appeal is bad for mis-joinder and not joinder of parties.
- 5. The appellant has, deliberately concealed the material facts from this Hon,able Tribunal.
- 6. The appellant, being civil servant, shall have to serve anywhere as and when his services are needed. That the instant appeal is barred by law.

Comments to Prayers

(a) Incorrect Appellant on his promotion from Junior Clerk (B-07) to Senior Clerk (B-09) was posted as Senior Clerk in the Office of XEN C&W Division Malakand on 31.12.2010 vide (annexed at-C) where he assumed duties on 01.01.2011. Afterwards on 17.08.2012 as (annexed-D) the appellant was posted as SDA (Sub Divisional Accountant) at Dargai Sub-Division (Annex-D) and he remained SDA for more than 1½ years and then was posted at Swat on 06.01.2014 (Copy of orders annexed as "A" with the appeal), hence served for 1½ years as per tenure, specified for PATA/Un-attracted areas (Authority SOR-VI/E&AD/1-4/2003 dated 24.06.2003 (item-iv) and No.SOR-VI/E&AD/1-4/2010/Vol-III dated 10.04.2010. No premature transfer in this case has been made, appellant though hails from Charsadda District as per his domicile entries in official record) is settled at Swat for quite long times and has been posted there without putting him any disturbance.



b. Misconceived, the normal tenure of 1 ½ years had since been completed by the appellant as SDA, so his contention to leave him there at Dargai Sub-Division is not tenable of course he is removed and posted out from post of Sub Divisional Accountant;

FACTS

- 1) Relates to official record.
- 2) Correct to the extent that appellant was posted at Dargai Sub-Division as Sub Divisional Accountant. However his total period of posting with C&W Division Malakand both periods as Senior Clerk stay post, and SDA at Dargai comes to 3-years and 05 days which the appellant has not described in the instant appeal.
- 3) Incorrect. Appellant served at Dargai Sub-Division as SDA from 17.08.2012 to 06.01.2014 i.e 1-year 6-months and 05 days, and not 16 months. The normal tenure if taken into account on one post at Dargai, appellant has served for 1½ years, which is the scheduled period fixed for PATA/unattractive areas, whereas his overall stay with the Executive Engineer's office (Malakand Division) is more than 3-years.

Incorrect. Appellant's 1st time, posting was ordered by the Respondent-2 on the promotion from Junior Clerk to Senior Clerk. The 2nd order was made by the same office of Respondent-2, as SDA, while the 3rd time, posting has been ordered by the replying Respondent-3, after taking into consideration his completion of tenure as per Government Policy.

His departmental appeal of the appellant was not considered being not based according to rules even in the instant case, appellant is well aware about his total period of service with Xen Malalkand on both times postings as Senior Clerk and SDA Dargai Sub-Division as well, which he enjoyed approximately for 3 years in toto. The posting orders of appellant has been made after taking into account the tenure in the office/post.

The appellant has deliberately concealed the material facts from the Honourable Tribunal. Appellant has no valid grounds to prefer appeal before this Honourable Tribunal on the following replying grounds:-

GROUNDS

- a) Incorrect. No arbitrary, un-lawful of un-just orders have been passed. Appellant has not been transferred prematurely. The appellant being civil servant shall have to serve anywhere and at any time under Section-10 of the civil servant Act 1973.
- b) Incorrect. The replying respondent has to see the Government interest at all and have no concern to accept/act on the whim and wishes of officials. The appellant has not been dealt with arbitrary.

- b) Incorrect. The replying respondents has to see the Government interest at all and have no concern to accept/act on the whim and wishes of officials. The appellant has not been dealt with arbitrary.
- C) Incorrect. The appellant has particulary pointed the name of one, Mr. Abdul Wahid stating a Junior person, posted against him is wrong, that are his own speculations, even then the appellant has not made him as Respondent under sub rule-4 of Rule-6 of the KPK Service Tribunal Rules 1974. The correct position of Abdul Wahid is that, he belongs to Malakand District, and was promoted from Junior Clerk (B-7) to Senior Clerk (B-9) on 01.01.2013 and was simultaneously posted as Senior Clerk in the office of Xen C&W Malakand vide Respondent-2 orders dated 01.01.2013 (Annexed-I) the appellant shall restrict matters relating to him as specified in the Ibid Rules of the Tribunal instead to fire in the air, quoting others when none of such incumbents has jeopardized his right.

The appellant has accepted the posting orders and before this and has joined duties at Swat Highway Division on 07.01.2014 (Annexed-II, III) Appellant is receiving salaries since then.

- d) Incorrect. Orders of replying Respondent is clear/regular and just. The appellant is not treated arbitrary or against the natural justice.
- e) The replying Respondent also seeks permission to advance/produce other record/grounds at the time of arguments

Keeping in view the aforesaid replies/comments thereto the replying respondent requests, that the instant appeal (Already stands implemented and accepted by the appellant) become infructious, may graciously be dismissed with


