That on 10.03.2011, the competent authority was pleased to accord sanction to the re-organization/up-gradation and

- 4. That on 20.08.2011, the competent authority order the posting, transfer and adjustment of various officers against the re-designated post. The name of appellant was placed at Serial No. 06 as District Director Agriculture B-19 in own pay and scale. (Copy as annex "C")
- 5. That on 12.05.2015, appellant submitted representation before the authority to award him the benefits of B-19 and also pensionery benefits of B-19 since 10.03.2011 i.e the date of up-gradation of the post but in vain. (Copy as annex "D")

Hence this Appeal, inter alia, on the following grounds:-

GROUNDS:

- a. That appellant has neat and clean service record in his credit.
- b. That on 10.03.2011, sanctioned regarding up-gradation of post at the ratio of 1:15:34:50 for placement in various pay scales, so at the time appellant was performing his duties as District Officer Agriculture B-18 he was then entitled to all benefits of B-19.
- c. That in the whole service law, there exists no concept of own pay scale.
- d. That as per the verdicts of the apex court, every Civil Servant is entitle for benefits of the grade/post on which he performs his duties.
- e. That since 20.08.2011 appellant used to perform his duties in the department as District Director Agriculture B-19, so he was legally entitled for all the benefits of the grade. By

not awarding the said benefits despite his written request, the act of respondents based on malafide.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of the Appeal, order dated 20.08.2011 be modified to the extent of B-19 with all benefits of the grade, with such other relief as may be deemed proper and just in circumstances of the case.
