



appeal u/s 4 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act 1974, for directing the respondents to consider the appellant for promotion to the post of Subject Specialist w.e.f 15.01.1999 instead of 31.08.2000 when the vacancies in the promotion quota became available.


4. Arguments heard. File perused.

5. Admittedly early in the year 2003 the appellant filed service appeal bearing No.1019/2003 wherein he prayed that the department may be directed to consider the promotion of the appellant from 31.08.2000 instead of 27.05.2003, however he could not get the desired relief from this Tribunal. Finally the august Supreme Court vide common judgment dated 21.06.2007 converted the Civil Petition No.328-P/2005 of the appellant into appeal, allowed the same and the appellant was promoted as Subject Specialist from 31.08.2000 instead of 27.05.2003.

6. This Tribunal is of the considered opinion that since the matter in issue has already been finally decided by the august Supreme Court of Pakistan by granting promotion to the appellant w.e.f 31.08.2000 hence the present subsequent Service Appeal on the same issue is not maintainable. Consequently the present service appeal and the connected service appeals as mentioned in the para-2 of this judgment are dismissed. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.

SERVICE APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNALS ACT, 1974 FOR DIRECTING THE RESPONDENTS TO CONSIDER THE APPELLANT FOR PROMOTION WITH EFFECT FROM 15.01.1999 INSTEAD OF 31.08.2000 THE DATE ON WHICH VACANCIES IN THE PROMOTION QUOTA BECAME AVAILABLE FOR WHICH APPELLANT PREFERRED A DEPARTMENTAL REPRESENTATION ON 12.12.2013 BUT THE SAME WAS NOT DISPOSED OF WITHIN THE STATUTORY PERIOD OF 90 DAYS.

PRAYER:

On acceptance of the instant appeal, this Hon'ble Tribunal may graciously be please to issue appropriate directions to the Respondents to consider the appellant for promotion w.e.f. 15.01.1999 instead of 31.08.2000 with all consequential back benefits.

Respectfully Sheweth,

Facts giving rise to the present appeal are as under:-

1. That the appellant joined the services of Education Department as S.V. on 12.09.1984 and since then he was performing his duties to the entire satisfaction of the high-ups.
2. That numerous vacancies of Subject Specialists were available in the Department, therefore, before filling in those vacancies, the existing service rules of 1994 were amended vide Notification dated 15.01.1999 (*Annex:-A*) whereby the method of recruitment to the posts of Subject Specialists was re-fixed as under:-
 - (a) *Fifty percent by initial recruitment through Provincial Public Service Commission; and*
 - (b) *Fifty percent by promotion on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness from amongst the Senior English Teachers/Assistant District Education Officers/Assistant Sub-Divisional Education Officers, possessing the qualification prescribed for initial recruitment.*

Whereafter, Respondent No.2 vide letter dated 24.02.1999 (*Annex:-B*) directed all the District Education Officers throughout the Province to provide information of qualified S.E.Ts on the prescribed proforma to prepare a separate subject-wise Seniority List for the purpose of promotion, in response to the same the particulars of the appellant were provided vide Proforma dated 03.05.1999 (*Annex:-C*) whereafter Subject-wise Seniority Lists of SETs (*Annex:-D*) were also prepared and the ACRs of those eligible for

promotion were also requisitioned from the concerned as would be evident from the letter dated 11.08.1999 (*Annex:-E*) which were provided vide List (*Annex:-F*).

3. That thereafter Respondent No.2 issued an advertisement which was published in the daily Mashriq on 11.11.1999 (*Annex:-G*) calling for interview all the eligible and qualified S.E.Ts on 21.11.1999 wherein the appellant appeared and accordingly vide Notification dated 31.08.2000 (*Annex:-H*) appellant was promoted to the post of Subject Specialist on acting charge basis on the basis of his eligibility, seniority and qualification.
4. That subsequently the regular promotion of the appellant was processed by the Department and on recommendation of the Departmental Promotion Committee appellant was promoted to the post of Subject Specialist (BPS-17) on regular basis vide Notification dated 27.05.2003 (*Annex:-I*).
5. That appellant thereafter filed Service Appeal No.1019/2003 before this Hon'ble Tribunal seeking promotion w.e.f. 31.08.2000 instead of 27.05.2003 which was disposed of vide Judgment dated 14.05.2005 (*Annex:-J*) and appellant were held entitled for the salaries of the posts against which they served and their antedation of promotion was declined.

6. That appellant then filed Civil Appeal before the august Supreme Court of Pakistan against the Judgment of this Hon'ble Tribunal which was allowed vide Judgment dated 21.06.2006 (*Annex:-K*) and the Judgment of this Hon'ble Tribunal was set aside and it was declared that the appellant should be deemed to have been regularly promoted as Subject Specialists from 31.08.2000 and not from 27.05.2003.
7. That it is a settled law that a civil servant is entitled for promotion w.e.f. the date of occurrence of vacancies and since vacancies were available on 15.01.1999, therefore, appellant was entitled for promotion w.e.f. 15.01.1999, therefore, he preferred a departmental Representation on 12.12.2013 (*Annex:-L*) for considering his promotion w.e.f. 15.01.1999 instead of 31.08.2000 which was not responded within in the statutory period, hence this appeal inter-alia on the following grounds:-

Grounds:

- A. That Respondents have not treated appellant in accordance with law, rules and policy on subject and acted in violation of Article 4 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 and unlawfully refused to consider the appellant for promotion w.e.f. 15.01.1999, which is unjust, unfair and hence not sustainable in the eye of law.

- B. **That** by now it has become *an axiomatic principle of law enunciated by superior courts* that a Civil Servant is entitled for promotion to the higher grade with effect from the date when post in the promotion quota has fallen vacant and any delay in processing and finalizing the promotion *cannot deprive him from such promotion* i.e. the due date. Reliance in this respect may be placed on the judgment of the *Supreme Court of Pakistan* reported in 2010 PLC (CS) 760 relevant portion of which is as under;-

“Promotion--delay--legitimate expectancy, principle of--civil servant was not promoted despite availability of vacancy-- Service Tribunal allowed the appeal of civil servant and directed the authorities to consider him for promotion from the date when he became eligible for the post as there was vacancy available then--validity--State functionaries were mandated to act with certain amount reasonableness--such canon of due process was not observed in processing civil servant’s promotion matter--having acquired requisite experience and having authored number of articles required for post in question, civil servant had legitimate expectancy for the post in question-- judgment passed by the Service Tribunal was neither against the rules nor the law declared--civil servant was eligible to be considered for promotion when substantive vacancy in promotion quota was available--Judgment passed by the Service Tribunal directing the authorities to consider case of civil servant’s promotion to post in question from the date when vacancy in his quota was available was unexceptionable-- Supreme Court declined to interfere in


the judgment passed by the Service Tribunal--appeal was dismissed."

Similar views were also held by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in identical and similar cases reported in 1997 SCMR 515, 2006 SCMR 1938, 2007 SCMR 682, 1998 SCMR 88 & 1985 SCMR 1158.

- C. That since vacancies were available on 15.01.1999 and by then the appellant was eligible for promotion but because of the lethargic attitude on the part of the Respondents the promotion of the appellant could not be processed timely, due to which appellant was deprived of his timely promotion, therefore, appellant is entitled for promotion w.e.f. date of occurrence of vacancy. It is also a settled law that no one is to suffer for the acts and omissions of the public functionaries.
- D. That the denial to promotion of a civil servant is a continuous wrong and therefore the question of limitation is not attracted in cases of promotion and moreover estoppel does not operate against the law as appellant is entitled for promotion with effect from the date of occurrence of vacancy under the law.
- E. That appellant would like to offer some other grounds during the course of arguments.

It is, therefore, humbly prayed that the instant appeal may graciously be accepted as prayed for above.

Any other relief as deemed appropriate in the circumstances of case not specifically asked for, may also be granted to appellant.

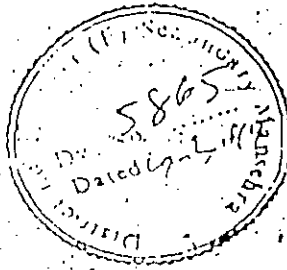



were there any legal impediments in their way of promotion. The authorities cited by the learned counsel for the appellants with regard to ante-dation promotion i.e. 1999 PLC(C.S)587, 2004 PLC (C.S) 835, 1996 SOMR 1334, 1998 SCMR 736, PLJ 1999 Tr.C.(Services) 366, PLJ 1996 Tr.C.(Services)684, 2003 SCMR 13, 1998 PLC (C.S) 980 & 1985 SCMR 1158 are distinguishable and are not applicable to the facts of the present appeals.

11. For what has been discussed above, we are of the considered opinion that since the appellants had rendered services in BS-17 on acting charge basis for sufficient time before their regularization on 27.5.2003, therefore, they are entitled to the salaries of the posts against which they served. So far as their claim with regard to ante-dation promotion is concerned, no case for indulgence of the Tribunal was made out. Accordingly, the instant appeal as well as the connected appeals, referred to above, stand disposed of in the above terms. No order as to costs. File be consigned to the record.

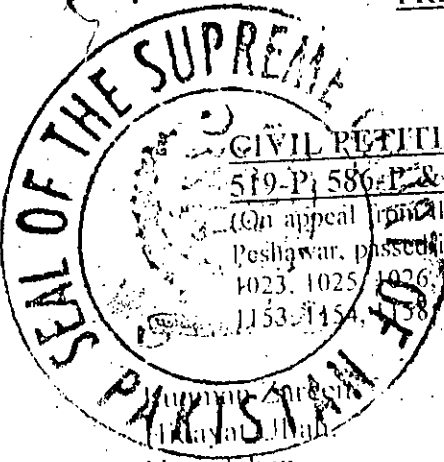

JUDGMENT

KHALIL-UR-REHMAN RAMDAY, J.- All these petitions, twenty-eight in number, involve identical questions of law and facts; arise out of the same consolidated judgment of the learned NWFP Service Tribunal and are, therefore, being disposed of together through this single judgment.

2. The petitioners in all these cases were serving the respondent-Government as S.E.Ts. in different schools of the province. Through a notification dated 31.8.2000, they were 'ADJUSTED' against the higher posts of Subject-Specialists in the following terms:-

"The following SETs holding M.A./M.Sc. Degrees in the relevant subject for the post of Subject Specialists are hereby adjusted against the post of Subject Specialists on acting charge basis in the schools noted against each on seniority basis with immediate effect subject to the terms and conditions in vogue or ones to be framed in future."

3. After the petitioners had held the said higher posts of Subject Specialists and Headmasters for about three years, a further notification was issued on 27.5.2003 which read as under:-

"On the recommendation of the Departmental Promotion Committee, the Competent Authority has been pleased to promote the following S.E.Ts. (BPS-16) (I/C S.S.) to the rank of Subject Specialists (BPS-17) on regular basis with immediate effect and adjusted in the schools as noted against their names."

4. The petitioners felt aggrieved of their promotion to the said post from 27.5.2003 and not from the date when they had been actually appointed to the said posts though on acting charge basis i.e. from 31.8.2000. They sought redress of their said grievance from the learned Service Tribunal but failed.

5. Hence these petitions.

6. It has not been denied even before us that clear vacancies of Subject Specialists existed on 31.8.2000. It has also not been denied that all the petitioners possessed the requisite qualifications for being regularly promoted to the said posts on the said date

and no impediment existed in their way to such a promotion. The reason offered for not so doing was that since a large number of S.E.T's. were to be promoted, therefore, it took the Departmental Promotion Committee some time i.e. about three years to do the needful. It was, however, submitted that no financial loss had accrued to the petitioners because during these three years when they were holding the said higher posts, they had been paid salaries etc. attached to the same.

7. The learned Tribunal non-suited the petitioners essentially on the ground that during the period in question when they were holding the said higher posts on acting charge basis, they were entitled only to the salaries of the said posts and nothing more and that they were not possessed of any right to claim regular promotion from 31.8.2000. A mention had also been made by the learned Tribunal that during this period some twenty-seven persons had got directly recruited as Subject Specialists who had not been arrayed as parties to the appeals filed by the petitioners before the said learned Tribunal; that ante-dating the promotion of the petitioners to the said posts would adversely affect the seniority of the said direct appointees and since they had not been made parties to the said appeals, therefore, the sought relief could not be granted to them. From the impugned judgment of the learned Service Tribunal, an impression is also gathered that while refusing the said relief to the petitioners, the said learned Tribunal had also been influenced by the fact that they had not re-coursed to the available remedies in the year 2000 when they had been promoted to the posts in question on acting charge basis only and not on regular basis.

8. We have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have also perused the record in the light of the submissions made before us.

9. It is then a position admitted on all sides that nothing existed in the way of the petitioners on 31.8.2000 which could have dis-entitled them to regular promotion to the posts in question and that it was only the usual apathy, negligence and bureaucratic red-tapism which had deprived the petitioners of the fruits that they deserved. The

petitioners could not be permitted to be punished for the faults and in-action of others.

We are of the view that where a post was available against which a civil servant could be promoted; where such a civil servant was qualified to be promoted to such a higher post; where he was put on the said higher post on officiating or acting charge basis only because the requisite exercise of allowing the regular promotion to the said post was being delayed by the competent authority and where he was subsequently found fit for the said promotion and was so promoted on regular basis then he was entitled not only to the salary attaching to the said posts but also to all consequential benefits from the very date from which he had been put on the said post on officiating or acting charge basis and we hold accordingly.

10. The learned Tribunal had brushed aside some precedent cases cited before it including some cases of this Court by declaring that the same were distinguishable. We have gone through the said judgments delivered by this Court and find that the learned Tribunal had failed to read the said judgments properly and to appreciate the ratio of the same in its correct prospective.

11. One such judgment to which a reference had been made in detail in the impugned judgment was SARWAR ALI KHAN'S CASE reported as PLD 1994 SC 233. This was a case where a Deputy Registrar of the Sindh Labour Appellate Tribunal had been appointed to the post of the Registrar of the same Tribunal on 5.7.1988 with immediate effect and till further orders but in his own pay and scale. It was almost three years later that he was regularly promoted to the said post on the recommendation of the Departmental Promotion Committee. Since there was no prospect of his further promotion beyond the post of Registrar, therefore, he had claimed only the salary of the post of Registrar which he had held on officiating basis for about three years and had prayed for nothing more. This claim was denied to him which finally led him to this Court. And this is what was held by this Court in the said facts and circumstances:-

..... This cannot be stretched to cover the case in hand, where the incumbent has worked against that post on his own pay and status for three years, particularly when there was no legal

impediment in his way to be promoted at that time on regular basis when he was inducted on 5.7.1988. In the instant case, since the appellant was eligible and qualified for promotion to B-18, there appears no justifiable reason to deprive him of the salary and others benefits of that post for a period of three years, which he would have received, had he been promoted on regular basis. The appellant had discharged full duties and responsibilities of the higher post and in the absence of some plausible reason, he cannot be deprived of the salary and other benefits connected with that post."

(under-lining is ours)

12. Dealing with this judgment, the learned Tribunal had failed to appreciate the principle laid therein by this Court by omitting to give the requisite weight to the principle enunciated and the words "OTHER BENEFITS" emphasized by this Court through the said judgment.

13. Another judgment of this Court placed before the learned Tribunal for its guidance was the one delivered in the case of CHAUDHRY MEHMOOD AKBAR reported as 2003 SCMR 13.

14. This was a case where Muhammad Afzal, the respondent in that case, while serving as a Deputy Superintendent of Jail on 21.12.1989, was transferred and posted as Superintendent of Jail in his own pay and scale and it was almost five years thereafter i.e. on 1.9.1994 that he was regularly promoted to the said post of Superintendent. He reached the Service Tribunal claiming regular promotion from the date when he had been appointed to the said post of Superintendent i.e. from 21.12.1989 instead of the date of his regular promotion to the same i.e. on 1.9.1994. The learned District Attorney who represented the Government before the learned Tribunal did not object to the grant of the said relief and the same was accordingly allowed to him. One Muhammad Akbar questioned the said judgment of the learned Tribunal before this Court submitting that he was senior to Muhammad Afzal in service; had been promoted to the post of Superintendent of Jail after Muhammad Afzal had been put on the said post in his own pay and scale but before his regular

Muhammad Afzal with effect from 21.12.1989 would operate prejudicially to his seniority and interests vis-a-vis the said Muhammad Afzal. After hearing all the sides, this Court sanctified the promotion of Muhammad Afzal with effect from the date when he had been actually put on the said higher post i.e. with effect from 21.12.1989 subject only to the proviso that the same would not adversely affect the rights of the other Superintendents of Jail who were senior to the said Muhammad Afzal.

15. A bare perusal of these judgments would thus show that this Court had always accepted the principle that a person who was asked to hold a higher post to which he was subsequently promoted on regular basis, was entitled to the salary etc. attaching to such a post for the period that he held the same; that he would also be entitled to any other benefits which may be associated with the said post and further that if a vacancy existed in a higher cadre to which a civil servant was qualified to be promoted on regular basis but was not so promoted without any fault on his part and was instead put on the said post on officiating basis then on his regular promotion to the said post, he would be deemed to have been so promoted to the same from the date from which he was allowed to hold the said higher post unless justifiable reasons existed to hold otherwise.

16. The appeals filed by the petitioners before the learned Service Tribunal could not have been dismissed on the ground of limitation. Firstly, because it was the subsequent notification dated 27.5.2003 which had ordered their regular promotion not from the date that they had been promoted to the posts in question on acting charge basis but from the date of the said notification, which had caused grief to them. Therefore, limitation would start running against them not from 31.8.2000 but from 27.5.2003. And secondly, because on similar question of limitation, this Court had thus held in SARWAR ALI KHAN'S CASE (supra):-

"..... it can be said that presumption favourable to the civil servant (Appellant) would be that it was temporary arrangement and would not last long but it lasted for three years. Filing representation was also proper remedy and in such circumstances,

it would not be fair to knock down service appeal as time-barred on the ground that first notification was not challenged." 44

17. This brings us to the question whether the petitioners could have been denied relief by the learned Tribunal on the ground that allowing relief in question to them could have operated to the prejudice of some persons who had been directly recruited to the posts of Subject Specialists between 31.8.2000 and 27.5.2003 and who had not been impleaded as respondents in the said appeals. Suffice it to say that the appeals filed by the petitioners before the Service Tribunal did not seek seniority over the said directly recruited persons and what they were asking for was the vindication of their right to regular promotion from the date in question and if the petitioners were found entitled to the same then they could not be deprived of it only because it could have caused some prejudice to some others nor could the said others be heard to deny the said benefit deserved by the petitioners. Therefore, we find that non-impleading of the said direct recruits to the appeals filed by the present petitioners in the learned Tribunal could also be no ground to deny them a right which had lawfully accrued to them.

18. Having thus examined all aspects of the matter and for the above-discussed reasons, all these petitions are converted into appeals which are allowed as a result whereof the impugned judgment of the NWFP Service Tribunal is set aside and as a further result whereof it is declared that the petitioners (now appellants) shall be deemed to have been regularly promoted as Subject Specialists from 31.8.2000 and not from 27.5.2003.

- 4 That the appellant is not an aggrieved person under article 212 of the constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973.
- 5 That the instant appeal is against the relevant provisions of law.
- 6 That the appellant has filed the instant appeal on malafide intentions just to put extra ordinary pressure on the Respondents for the grant of illegal and even unauthorized service benefits.
- 7 That the appellant has not come to this Honorable Tribunal with clean hands.
- 8 That the instant appeal is liable to be dismissed for mis-joinder & non-joinder of the necessary parties to the present appeal.
- 9 That the appellant is estopped by his own conduct to file the instant appeal.
- 10 That the instant service appeal is not maintainable in its present circumstances of the case.
- 11 That the order dated 31-8-2014 is legally competent and is liable to be maintained in favour of the Respondents in the interest of justice.
- 12 That this Honorable Tribunal has got no jurisdiction to entertain the instant service appeal
- 13 That the appellant has been treated as per law, rules & relevant policy in the instant case.
- 14 That the appellant is not entitled for the grant of the relief he has sought from this Honorable Tribunal.
- 15 That the promotion / up gradation is always with immediate effect, under the discretion of the competent authority.

ON FACTS


- 1 That Para-1 needs no comments being pertains to the service record of the appellatant.
- 2 That Para-2 is correct to the extent that vide Notification dated 15-1-1999 the method of recruitment to the post of subject Specialist has been re-fixed at a ratio of 50% by initial recruitment through the Public Service Commission Govt: of KPK Peshawar & the remaining 50% quota has been granted for the promotion on the basis of seniority cum- fitness from amongst the SET /ADEO/ASDEO (M/ F) processing the prescribed qualification as has been made mandatory for the recruitment against the said post through initial recruitment. The Respondent No: 2 vide his office letter dated 24/2/1999 has directed all the concerned DEOs for the purpose of preparation of subject wise seniority list for the grant / award of promotion against the Subject Specialist post, hence the Notification dated 15-01-1999.
- 3 That Para-3 is correct to the extant that the Respondent No: 2 has issued / published an advertisement dated 11-11-1999 in the daily "Mashriq" Peshawar with the directions to the candidates appear for test & interviews on 21/11/1999 at their respective stations. The appellatant has been applied for the same post & has been adjusted on I/C base against the SS post in BPS-17 vide Notification dated 31-8-2000 vide S/No: 244/2011 of the said Notification, hence the plea of the appellatant regarding his promotion wef 15-1-1999 is baseless & is liable to be struck down being merit-less & without any solid foundation.
- 4 That Para-4 is correct, hence no further comments.
- 5 That the Para-5 is correct to the extant that the service appeal; No: 1019/2003 Titled Nasir Khan Versus Government has been rejected / dismissed by this Honorable Service Tribunal vide judgment dated 14/5/2005 with the directions to the Respondents that the appellatant is not entitled for the grant of promotion against Subject Specialist in Pak: Studies wef 31-8-2000 instead of 27/5/2003.
- 6 That Para-6 is also correct to the extant that the August Supreme Court of Pakistan has directed the Respondent department, for the grant of promotion to the appellatant wef 31/8/2000 instead of 27/5/2003.
- 7 That Para-7 is incorrect & denied, the appellatant is not entitled for the grant of promotion against the SS post wef 15-1-1999 on the grounds that during the said period i.e 15-1-1999, the Respondent department has got no vacant post for SS & the appellatant has been adjusted against the same post as an In-charge civil servants /SS. Similarly, it is further submitted that the Respondents has already implemented the judgment of the August Supreme Court of Pakistan in its true letter & spirit & has thus granted promotion to the appellatant wef 31-8-2000, hence the plea of the appellatant regarding the grant of his promotion wef 15-1-1999 is baseless as the matter has already been decided by the August Supreme Court of Pakistan once for all in the interest of justice. Hence the departmental appeal of the appellatant is also illegal & against the relevant provisions of law, rules, policy & circumstances of the instant case. However, the Respondents, further submit on the following grounds inter alia:- (copy of the judgment of August Supreme Court of Pakistan is attached as Annexure "A").

ON GROUNDS

- A That ground-A is incorrect & denied, the Respondents have acted as per law, rules & criteria in the instant case wherein the appellatant has been made entitled for the grant of promotion against the SS post wef 31/8/2000 in compliance of the judgment date 21/6/2006. Hence the appellatant is not entitled for grant promotion wef 15-1-1999 against the Subject Specialist.

- B That ground-B is also incorrect & denied, the appellant is not entitled for the grant of his promotion wef 15-01-1999, nor any such vacancies were available with the Respondents during that period for the adjustment of the appellant on the same vacancies, Hence the plea of the appellant for the grant of promotion wef the above said date is baseless & is liable to be struck down.
- C That ground C is also incorrect & denied, detail reply of this Para has already been given in the foregoing paras, hence no further comments.
- D That ground-D is also incorrect & denied, the Respondents has acted as per law & rules in the instant case by granting promotion to the appellant wef 3-8-2000, hence the case / departmental appeal of the appellant has also become badly time barred, hence is liable to be dismissed in favour of the Respondents on this score too.
- E That ground E needs no comments, however the Respondents seek leave of this Honorable Tribunal to advance additional grounds & case law / record at the time of arguments.

In view of the above made submissions, it is humbly requested that this Honorable Tribunal may very graciously be pleased to dismiss the instant appeal with cost in favor of the respondent Department.

Respectfully Sheweth,

Preliminary objections.

Preliminary objections raised by the answering Respondents frivolous and vexatious. The appellant has got a strong cause of action and for that matter locus standi to file the instant appeal which is within time. Appellant has brought all the facts of the case on the record alongwith documents bonafide. All the relevant parties have been properly arrayed and moreover estoppel has no application in the instant appeal.

Facts:

1. Being not replied hence admitted.
2. Being admitted needs no reply.
3. Partially admitted, however, the plea of the appellant regarding his promotion w.e.f. 15.01.1999 is in accordance with law and hence is entitled to the same.
4. Being admitted needs no reply.
5. Partially correct. The service appeal of the appellant was partly allowed to the extent of his entitled for the salaries of the post against which he served.
6. Being admitted needs no reply.

7. Incorrect hence denied. The instant case is on altogether different footing because under the law a civil Servant is entitled for promotion w.e.f. the date of occurrence of vacancy. As the vacancies were vacant on 15.01.1999, therefore, appellant is entitled for promotion to the same post w.e.f. the same date.

Grounds:

- A. Incorrect. The Respondents have not acted in accordance with the law and rules. Appellant is entitled for promotion w.e.f. 15.01.1999 when clear vacancies in the quota were available.
- B. Incorrect hence denied. The vacancies in the Promotion quota were available but the promotion of the appellant was unduly delayed for no fault on his part.
- C. Being not replied hence admitted.
- D. Incorrect. The appeal of the appellant was within time.
- E. That appellant would also like to offer some other grounds at the time of arguments.

It is, therefore, humbly prayed that the reply of answering Respondents No. 1&2 may graciously be rejected and the appeal as prayed for may graciously be accepted with costs.
