**PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS:** -

1. This Honorable Tribunal has no jurisdiction to adjudicate the matter as no final or appellate orders have been passed on the departmental Appeal nor any punishment been awarded.
2. The Appellant is estopped by his own conduct to prefer the appeal.
3. The Appellants have deliberately concealed the important facts/rules of the case from this Honorable Tribunal.
4. The Appellant has no locus standi and cause of action.
5. The Appellant has not come to the Tribunal with clean hands.
6. The appeal is bad for misjoinder and non-joinder of necessary parties.

**ON FACTS:** -

1. Pertains to record, however the date of his joining the department is 15-03-1988, not 17-03-1988.
2. Correct to the extent that "DEPARTMENTAL PROFESSIONAL EXAMINATION" conducted w.e.f from 25/10 to 28/10/2021 as stated in para-2 of the Main Appeal, actually is applicable under B&R code for the purpose of Induction/Promotion to the next tier post of Sub Divisional Officer/Assistant Engineers/Assistant Research Officer (BPS-17) as per the Appointment/Recruitment Rules, 2010 in the C&W Department (**Annexed-I**) refer to sub clause (c) against the Post at Sl.No-4 in column 5 (Method of Appointment/Recruitment).
3. Correct the Competent Authority in the Finance Department vide Notification dated: 07/03/2018 upgraded the Post of Sub Engineer from BPS-11/12 to

BPS-16 to person/incumbent, having 10 years or more services at their credit in the same scale in all the departments of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, giving immediate effect, means w.e.f 07/03/2018. All those such Sub Engineers who were fulfilling the requisite criteria have been elevated to BPS-16 including the present Appellant Copies of Pay Roll for 07/2023 and relevant entries recorded in the Service Book (Pt-II) at Page-9 are also Annexed-II/III. This fact and position has been kept concealed from the Tribunal, the reasons best be known to the Appellant.

4. Incorrect and misstatement. All those Sub Engineer who were in Service on 07/03/2018, having 10 years OR more Service at their credit are availing the benefit of the ibid upgradation including this Appellant as stated in Para-3, above.
5. Frivolous/trifling, actually the judgment passed on 02/03/2016 in Service Appeal No. 1330/2010 and in some other 52-Nos connected Appeals(s), speaks on the matter "**who were fulfilling the criteria**" but were ignored the Senior Scale Grade B-16, their cases were decided to be entertained alike other Sub Engineers who fulfilled the criteria of being upgraded as Senior Scale grade, B-16 awarded by the department or on the Courts intervention but those who sued their cases as mentioned below, have not been granted Senior Scale B-16 because of the facts they had not passed/cleared the requisite prescribed examination both the times in 08/94 and 06/96 as well.


But the present Appellant does not come under the orbit of "fulfilling the criteria" as he/they have not Cleared/Passed the prescribed Departmental Examination of "B" Grade twice, which are described here under:-

6. Incorrectly assumed. The expressive direction of the Court (Tribunal) orders dated 02/03/2016 concerns the mater "To extend the benefit of its Judgement to other Sub Engineers who fulfill the criteria of being upgraded as Senior Scale Grade, B-16 are clear and spoke in the mater who are senior and fulfill the criteria and their juniors, fulfilling the criteria have been granted B-16, shall equally be dealt. As explained in Para-5, above, the present Appellant's Case is different, he is not coming in the position and status "fulfill the criteria", being not passed the prescribed Examinations at both the times. And as such, is not entitled to Senior Scale Grade, B-16 alike others who having passed the Examination and fulfilling the criteria as per the orders of Tribunal dated 02/03/2016.
7. Incorrectly stated, appellant is not similarly placed Sub Engineers. The Appellant if had/have passed the ibid examination, then he would to say, similarly placed person. Passing of prescribed Examination is mandatory for the purpose of grant of Senior Scale Grade B-16. So far the question of passing the Professional Examination, the position has been fully elaborated in Para-2, above which provides a pave to the next promotion, to the posts of SDO/AEs BPS-17 and not for the purpose of BPS-16 Senior Scale.
8. Correct, as there was no force in the department appeal nor the Appellant was fulfilling the criteria as expedited in Para-6, above, hence not entertained.

9. Mis-conceiving. The benefit of this Tribunal Judgment dated 02/03/2016 cannot be extended to the Appellant, he has not passed the requisite "B" Grade Examination, not fulfilling the criteria, is not entitle to any relief of B-16, Senior Scale grade nor his case is attracting to be considered under the ibid judgment.
10. Incorrect. As explained in Para-6, 7 and 9 above, Appellant is not entitled to the same relief, when he does not fulfill the criteria (passing the "B" Grade Examination, so how he claims the principal/scope of consistency and equality).
11. There is no force in this Appeal, it is not necessary to allow further points. At the same time attention is invited to the Emerging controversies, i.e. (iii) Legal status of Appointment against higher Posts in OWN PAY SCALE as noticed by this honorable Tribunal deciding the Appeal No. 1330/2010, on 02/03/2016 in Para-16 and deliberating the issue in Para-24, termed such appointments in Own Pay Scale as illegal and condemnable, deemed the practice derogatory to law and rules, directed to be discontinued forthwith. The Appellant at present holds the appointment as SDO in Own Pay Scale, which is apparent from the Pay Roll of the Appellant for 07/2023.

In the above state of circumstances, it is graciously prayed that the Appeal devoid of merits may please be dismissed with heavy cost against the Appellant as he is not coming within the orbit of "**Similarly Placed Employees.**"
