

ORDER

Ijaz ul Ahsan, J. - Leave to appeal is sought against a judgment of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal dated 1st of April, 2016. Through the impugned judgment, in a Service Appeal filed by the respondent while maintaining the findings of the departmental authorities the Tribunal reduced the penalty of removal of service into penalty of reduction to lower stage of pay scale by two stages for a period of two years. It is clear and obvious that the said period has already expired and the questions raised in this petition are only of academic nature. In the specific facts and circumstances of the present case, we are not inclined to interfere with the judgment of the Tribunal. Consequently, we find no
