Abdur Rahman son of Noor Aziz Khan hereinafter referred to as the appellant has preferred the instant service appeal under Section 4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974 with a prayer to grant him notional promotion with all service benefits.</p> <p>3. Brief facts giving rise to the present appeal are that the appellant was serving as officer of the schools administration branch when promoted from BPS-18 to BPS-19 on regular basis w.e.f. 26.12.2003. That while serving in BPS-19 he was recommended for promotion to BPS-20 in the working papers dated 20.06.2013. That the appellant stood retired from service on 29.12.2013 where-after meeting of Provincial Selection Board was held on 07.01.2014 wherein appellant was recommended for promotion to BPS-20 but despite</p>

recommendations appellant was not promoted constraining him to prefer departmental appeal dated 23.06.2014 which was not responded and hence the instant service appeal on 08.05.2015.

4. Learned counsel for the appellant has argued that the appellant was entitled to promotion on notional basis as he was found entitled to such promotion and was so recommended but no notification regarding his promotion was issued constraining him to prefer departmental appeal followed by the instant service appeal.

5. Learned Addl. Advocate General representing the respondents has argued that since the appellant stood retired from service before issuance of notification as such the same was not issued by the authority.

6. We have heard arguments of learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

7. We deem appropriate to reproduce the relevant para from the minutes of Provincial Selection Board held on 07.01.2014:-

Note:

As the retired officer at S.No. 7 of the panel was recommended for promotion on notional basis on the ground that the vacant posts were available on the date of his retirement."

S.No.	Name of Officer	Recommendations of the Board
7.	Mr., Abdur Rahman	His date of birth is 30.12.1953. He joined government service on 11.08.1974. He was promoted to BS-19 on 09.02.2004. No enquiry is pending

against him. His service record upto 2012 is generally good. He retired from service on 29.12.2013 on attaining the age of superannuation.

The Board recommended the officer for promotion to BS-20 on notional basis from the date of his retirement.

8. We have consulted the record placed before us and have come to the conclusion that no action whatsoever was taken on the recommendations made by the Provincial Selection Board referred to above. We therefore deem it appropriate to direct that the authority shall consider the said recommendations of the P.S.B and pass any order deemed appropriate regarding notional promotion of the appellant within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of this judgment. The appeal is accepted in the above terms. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.



Learned counsel for the appellant argued that the appellant was serving in Education Department in BPS-19 since 2003 and was entitled to be considered for promotion to BPS-20 as 24 vacancies in BPS-20 were available and appellant was at serial No. 7 of the seniority list and was so recommended for promotion on 20.6.2013 which case was not further processed and appellant retired from service on 29.12.2013. That even after the retirement appellant was entitled to notional promotion which was not granted vide impugned order dated 17.3.2014 whereafter appellant preferred departmental appeal on 23.6.2014 followed by Writ Petition which was dismissed on 2.4.2015 and hence the instant service appeal on 8.5.2015.

That the appellant is entitled to notional promotion from BPS-19 to BPS-20 as vacancies were available at the time of regular service of the appellant.





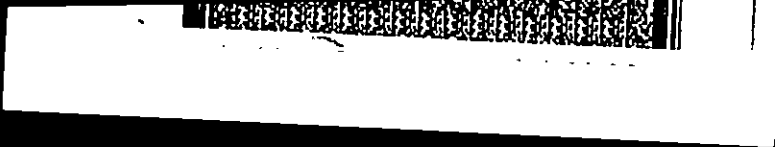

Any other relief which deems Just and proper may also be granted to the appellant keeping in view facts and circumstance of the case.

Respectfully Sheweth:

That brief facts and grounds giving rise to the instant Service Appeal are as under;

1. That the appellant as an Officer of the School administration at BPS-18 was regularly promoted to BPS-19 with effect from 26-12-2003 vide Notification bearing No. S.O (S) 1-2/2004/B-18 to B-19 dated 09-02-2004 issued by Respondent No.3.

(Copy of the Notification is annexed as Annexure-"A")

2. That since date the appellant performed his duty with excellent service record till 29 -12-2013 but due to miscellaneous reasons he remained on the same basic scale for about more than 10 years. It is pertinent to mention here that several posts of BPS-20 were lying vacant during his qualified service.
3. That according to applicable policy issued by Respondent No.2 vide Notification bearing No. SO (G)/S & LD /1/2003 Vol-II dated 09-04-2004 and 04-05-2009 respectively; the appellant was duly qualified for promotion to BPS-20.
4. That last time on 20-06-2013 respondent No. 4 and 5 prepared the final working paper of Officers (Male) qualified for promotion from BPS-19 to BPS-20 and put the same before Respondents No.1 to 3, where the appellant was stood at Serial No.5 amongst the eligible officers on merit.

(Copy of final working paper is annexed as annexure "B")

5. That along with the afore said merit/working paper the availability report of 24 vacant posts of BPS-20 was also provided.

(Copy of Vacancy report is annexed as annexure "C")

6. That during more than 06 Months of his remaining service as well as completion of process for recommendation by Selection Board and approval of Chief Minister as competent authority; promotion order of the appellant remained suspended/not issued due to reasons best known to respondent No.2 and the appellant got superannuation retirement on 29-12-2013 after completion of 9/10 years qualified and regular service at BPS-19 as Principal Government Centennial Model High School Chitral.

7. That on 07 -01-2014 the Provincial Selection Board also recommended the appellant for promotion to BPS-20 and final approval was also accorded by the Chief Minister.

8. That on 17-03-2014 the Respondent No.2 vide Impugned Notification bearing No. SO (E-1) E & AD/9-88/2014 issued promotion order of 18 officers of Teaching cadre of Elementary and Secondary Education from BPS-19 to 20 on regular basis excluding the appellant and including 15 officers of low merit as listed at working paper dated 20-06-2013 and the appellant was even not informed about the impugned order.

9. That at the last week of May, 2014 the appellant through his own sources came to know about the afore said notification and approached the office of Respondent No.2, where he was informed that his case for notional promotion has been send to Governor of KPK through Chief Secretary as hardship case and he has to wait for some more time.

10. That on 23-6-2014 the appellant also filed a departmental appeal to Respondent No.1 but in vain.

11. That on 18-10-2014 the appellant filed a Writ Petition bearing No.WP.No.3146-P/2014 before the Peshawar High Court Peshawar, which was disposed on 02-04-2015 and the attested copies provided on 09-02-2015, whereby the appellant has been asked to approach this honourable Tribunal.

12. That as a matter of right and having no other remedy; the appellant approaches this honourable Tribunal inter alia on the following amongst the following others;


GROUND S;

- A) The admittedly the appellant was duly qualified for promotion to BPS-20 as per policy/rule applicable on subject because the appellant remained at BPS-19 for about ten years while 05 years service at BPS-19 was required for his promotion .
- B) That 24 vacant posts were also available as evident from report submitted along with his working paper by the competent authority on 20-06-2013 and the Provincial Selection Board as well as Chief Minister has also approved his promotion to BPS-20.
- C) That the delay of process for promotion of appellant from 20-06-2013 to 17-03-2014 resulted to deprive him from regular promotion as he retired on 29-12-2013, therefore to refuse grant of Notional Promotion to him is likely to deprive him from his vested right.
- D) That in the like circumstances other female Officers of the same department have been granted Notional Promotion vide Notification bearing No.SO S/F E&SE/1-3/2013 (**Annexure "G"**), therefore according to law and procedure there is no exemption to appellant from the same benefit.

Respectfully Sheweth,

The Respondents submit as under:-

Preliminary Objections:-

1. That the appellant is not an aggrieved person within the meaning of Article 212 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973.
2. The appellant has got no cause of action/ locus standi.
3. The instant appeal is badly time barred.
4. The appellant has concealed the material facts from this Hon 'able Tribunal, hence is liable to be dismissed on this score.
5. The appellant has not come to this Hon 'able Tribunal with clean hands.
6. The appellant has filed the instant appeal on malafide intentions just to pressurize the Respondents for illegal service benefits.
7. The present appeal is liable to be dismissed for mis-joinder & non joinder of necessary parties.
8. The instant appeal is against the prevailing law and rules.
9. The appellant is estopped by his own conduct to file the instant appeal.
10. The instant appeal is not maintainable in its present form and also in the present circumstances of the issue.
11. That the Notification dated 17-03-2014 is legally competent and liable to be maintained in favour of the Respondents.
12. That the instant Service Appeal is bared by Law, Rules & Policy.
13. That the grant of promotion is not a vested right of the Appellant.
14. That the Appellant has got retired from service on 29-12-2013 prior to the issuance of the impugned Notification dated 17-03-2014.
15. No Departmental Appeal against the impugned Notification has been filed by the Appellant.

FACTS.

1. Para-1 needs no comments being related to the Service record of the appellant.
2. Para-2 is incorrect & mis-leading on the grounds that the Appellant has got retired from Service on 29-12-2013 against the Principal post in BS-19 prior to the issuance of impugned Notification dated 17-03-2014, hence his case was not considered for the grant of promotion in BS-20 in the Respondent /E&SED, as per meeting of the PSB held on 07-01-2014 for the purpose of

grant of promotion to the officers of E&SED from BS-19 to Bs-20 against the 24 vacant posts. (Copy of the PSB Minutes is Annex-A)

3. That Para-3 is incorrect to the extent that there were 24 vacant position BS-20 of Teaching Cadre and on the basis of the said vacant posts, the Respondent No. 1 has prepared and submitted working papers of 74 officials of the said cadre working in the Respondent Department of E&SE in BS-19 including the Appellant in which 29 candidates/officials have been declared as fit/eligible for the grant of promotion in BS-20 Teaching Cadre against the Principal Post for the purpose of Provincial Selection Board meeting held on 07-01-2014 who recommended 24 eligible candidate for the grant of promotion in BS-20 vide impugned notification dated 17-03-2014 issued by the Respondent NO. 1. However the Appellant has got retired from service on 29-12-2013 in BS-19 against the Principal post prior to issuance of the impugned Notification dated 17-03-2014 by the Respondent No. 3 in light of the recommendations of the PSB meeting in the interest of public service with immediate effect.(copy of the impugned Notification is Annex-B).
4. That Para-4 is correct to the extent that the working papers were prepared by the Respondent No. 3 and on the basis of the said working papers, the PSB meeting was held on 07-01-2014 wherein the cases of the above mentioned 74 officials of BS-19 were discussed and considered and consequent upon the said meeting, the Respondent No. 1 has been pleased to recommend 24 eligible officials of Teaching Cadre for the grant of promotion in BS-20 post against the Principal post in the Respondent Department of E&SED wherein, the Appellant could not be recommended on the grounds that he has got retired from the service on 29-12-2013 prior to the issuance of the impugned Notification dated 17-03-2014 issued by the Respondent No. 3 in the interest of public service and with immediate effect.
5. That Para-5 is incorrect and denied. Detailed reply of this para has already been given in Para-4, hence needs no further comments.
6. That Para-6 is incorrect and mis-leading. The PSB has acted as per Law, Rules and criteria vide its meeting held on 07-01-2014. Therefore the plea of the Appellant in this para is also without any force and legal justification, hence denied.
7. That Para-7 is incorrect and denied, the Respondent No.1 acted as per Law, Rules & Policy hence the plea of the Appellant is also liable to be struck down of being merit ~~less~~ and without any legal footings on the grounds that he has got retired from service on 29-12-2013 against the Principal post in B'S-19 prior to the issuance ^{of} the impugned Notification dated 17-03-2014 issued by the Respondent No. 3 in the interest of public with immediate effect.
8. That Para-8 is correct to extent that the Respondent No. 3 has been please^d to issue the impugned Notification dated 17-03-2014 of the eligible

candidates/officers for the grant of promotion in BS-20 in the E&SE Department in the interest of justice.

- 9. That Para-9 is correct that the Respondent No. 3 has issued the impugned Notification dated 17-03-2014 excluding the Appellant on the grounds that he has got retired from the service on 29-12-2013 against the Principal post in Bs-19 prior to the issuance of the impugned Notification dated 17-03-2014, hence he^{is} not entitled for the grant of notional promotion along with service benefits in BS-20 in the light of relevant rules and policy hence the plea of the Appellant is liable to be dismissed in favour of the Respondents in the interest of Justice.
- 10. Para-10 is also incorrect and denied, No Departmental Appeal has been filed by the Appellant against the impugned Notification dated 17-03-2014, hence the plea of the appellant is meritless & is liable to be dismissed.
- 11. Para-11 is correct to the extent that the Appellant has filed a writ petition No. 3146-P/2014 before the Hon'able Peshawar High Court Peshawar which was dismissed vide judgment dated 02-04-2015 under the mandatory provision of Article 212 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973 in favour of the Respondents. (Copy of the judgment is Annex-C).
- 12. Para-12 needs no comments. However, the Respondents further submit on the following grounds inter-alia.


GROUND.


- A. Incorrect and denied: The appellant has been treated as per law, rules and policy vide impugned Notification dated 17-03-2014 issued by the Respondent No. 3 in the light of the recommendations of the PSB meeting held on 07-01-2014, hence the statement of the Appellant in this ground is against the law and facts of the case.
- B. Incorrect and denied, the Appellant has got retired from service on 29-12-2013 hence, the statement of the Appellant in this para is against the Law and facts as mentioned in foregoing paras of the instant reply on behalf of the Respondents, hence liable to be dismissed.



issuance of impugned Notification dated 17-03-2014 wherein he has made not entitled for the grant of promotion on notional basis in BS-20.


- F. Incorrect and denied, this Hon'able Tribunal has got no jurisdiction to entertain the instant matter, hence liable to be dismissed.


