2. The earlier execution petition was dismissed on 28.02.2023 in the following words:

"This execution petition is misconceived as the respondents had already issued a notification No.6626-30/Edu dated 22.11.2018 in compliance of the judgment of this Tribunal whereby the grievance of the petitioner has been complied with, therefore, the instant execution petition is filed. Consign."

3. As is apparent from the above order, the earlier execution petition was misconceived and was dismissed as such, because compliance of the judgment had already been made by issuance of Notification No. 6626-30/Edu dated 22.11.2018. What next or else is sought in this implementation, is neither known, nor has been explained, therefore, this time it is dismissed with a warning to the petitioner to avoid making fruitless and useless as well as frivolous applications and if made again for the same matter, that would be dismissed with heavy cost upon him.
