

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

In reply to the contents Para No. 1 of the appeal, it is submitted that PICO is an autonomous institute and functioning under administrative control of HMC, which too is an autonomous institute, the appellant has embezzled Rs.88147/- of PICO and thereafter had gone hidden, repeated notices were issued to him, resultantly, an FIR was lodged against him, he was dismissed from the services on 14-12-15, he never performed his duty with honesty & devotion.
- 2. Pertains to record hence no comments.
- 3. Incorrect and misleading, detailed reply has been given in the above Para, the appellant had embezzled money from project account office (PICO), thereafter he disappeared and did not join

his duty, despite repeated notices, an FIR was also lodged against him (Copies of notice in Annex-A).

- 4. Incorrect and misleading, an appellant was proceeded against in accordance with law and finally he was dismissed from the services after observing all legal and codal formalities.
- 5. Subject to proof.

#### **GROUNDS:**

- A. Incorrect. The impugned order is legal and passed by the competent authority after completing the codal formalities.
- B. Incorrect. Proper inquiry was conducted and opportunity of defence was provided to appellant.(Copy of show cause & reply enclosed Annex-B)
- C. Incorrect. Inquiry committees conducted full fledge inquiry & convincing material was collected against the appellant during the proceeding, he was found guilty, and therefore his service was terminated. (Inquiries Reports, Termination Order Annex-C,)

- D. Incorrect. Criminal and departmental proceeding are two separate things and can run side by side with each other & result in criminal case has nothing to do with the department proceedings.
- E. Incorrect. Charges leveled against the appellant were proved during the inquiry proceeding.
- F. Incorrect. Thorough probe was conducted and finally the appellant involvement in the theft was proved.
- G. Incorrect. The department has exercised its jurisdiction within the parameter of law.

It is, therefore, prayed that an acceptance these comments, the content of appeal being devoid of force be dismissed with cost.

### Minutes of the 1st Meeting of the PICO Inquiry Committee.

First meeting of the Facts Finding Inquiry Committee regarding the theft in PICO was held on Saturday 15/08/2015 at 1200 hrs, under the chairmanship of Deputy Dean PICO, Chairman of the Inquiry Committee in his office to discuss the proceedings of the meeting. The following attended the meeting:-

- Dr. Zahid Jadun, Deputy Dean PICO, Chairman.
- 2. Dr. Noor ul Mabood, Director Administration, PICO, Member.
- 3. Dr. Sadiqullah, Assistant Prof. (CEH) PICO, Member.
- 4. Mr. Pervez Akhtar, Program Officer, PICO, Member.
- 2. The Committee discussed the case in detail and established the fact that the Accounts Office of PICO was broken on Friday night after the working hours. The Committee decided to proceed further in the inquiry as per its ToRs and summon the PICO employees concerned with the case to record their statements in its next meeting. Accordingly, eight employees, the Accounts Officer (project), Computer Operator/Account Assistant (Project), Assistant Accounts Officer (Govt.), Account Assistant (Govt.), three security guards and Naib Qasid Accounts Office (Govt.) were issued letter to appear before the inquiry committee on Monday 17th August, 2015 to record their statements. Moreover, the Incharge Thana/Police Station Hayatabad Peshawar was also requested to provide a copy of the registered FIR.

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Subject: Inquiry Report Regarding Theft in PICO.

#### Background:

The Accounts Officer (Project) Mr. Ikram Ullah Jan, PICO Peshawar reported a theft in his office early in the morning of Saturday the 8<sup>th</sup> August, 2015. The Dean PICO, who was on official leave on that day, was informed about the incident through SMS at 09:58 am on 08/08/2015 and Dean PICO instructed Deputy Dean on phone at 10:02 am on the same day to inform police. The Senior members of the PICO Management Committee i.e. Dr. Zahid Jadoon, Deputy Dean, Dr. Noorul Mabood, Director Administration PICO, Ms Samina Anwaar, Sociologist, PICO, Mr. Ikramullah Jan, Accounts Officer (project) PICO, and Mr. Aftab Sher, Accounts Officer (Govt.) PICO, who were present on the same day held an urgent meeting to discuss the incident. The Accounts Officer (Govt.) stressed on to open the locker as he was worried about the Govt. Cash which was kept in the locker and he showed his apprehension that if the police takes away the locker then it will be difficult to know whether the cash was available or not. The safe was then opened/broken and it was found that the total cash kept in the safe was available. The CCTV cameras were also seen time and again but no explicit proof could be seen except one clue that a torch with human shadow behind the accounts office was seen in the camera between 9:45  $pm-1000\ pm$  on Friday 07/08/2015. Moreover, the security guards were found sleeping most of the time. In addition on Saturday 08/08/2015, the HMC Police was also informed about the event and subsequently on the same day, a police party came to PICO, visited the spot and took statements of the PICO concerned employees. They further stated that on the next day they will visit PICO again and will proceed further. On next day they came and advised PICO to send a theft report to HMC Police and Thana Hayatabad for lodging FIR.

After arrival of the Dean PICO, he notified a departmental fact-finding inquiry committee under the chairmanship of Deputy Dean PICO on 13/08/2015 with the following ToRs (Annex-A):-

- i) Possible accuse
- ii) Security Lapses
- iii) Why so much cash was kept in the department
- iv) Who withdraw the cash
- v) Why could it not be submitted in the proper bank account in time and any other matter.

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#### 2. Proceedings

The Inquiry Committee held its first meeting on 15/08/2015 at 1200hrs in the office of the Chairman of the committee, in which it was decided to summon Mr. Ikramullaha Jan, Accounts Officer (project), Ms Beenish, Computer Operator/Account Assistant (Project), Mr. Aftab Sher, Assistant Accounts Officer (Govt.), Mr. Samahatullah, Account Assistant (Govt.), three security guards namely Mr. Mustafa kamal, Mujahid & Mr. Meena Baz and Mr. Wasif Nabi, Naib Qasid working as Dispatcher were issued letter to appear before the inquiry committee on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> August, 2015 to record their statements. (Minutes of the meeting are at Annex-B). Accordingly, on 17/08/2015, statements of all the employees were recorded except Mr. Wasif Nabi, who appeared in the court on that day.

- 3. Findings:- Following are the major findings from the statements of the above mentioned PICO employees and personal observations of the Inquiry Committee:-
  - 1. The inquiry committee after listening to the verbal statements, going through the written statements and after physical verification of the crime scene, established the fact that theft has taken place and Rs. 88147/- has been stolen from the drawer and attempt has been made to break the locker in which a cash of Rs. 1039670/- was kept, which included Rs. 789, 670 Govt. Cash and Rs. 250000/- (Project Cash). On a query the Accounts Officer (Govt.) stated that this cash was of the Income Tax and CPF deductions from the PICO Govt. employees. Whereas, the Accounts Officer (Project) stated that their cash i.e. 250000/- were the students' stipends which could not be paid due to summer vacations of the students and it also included some receipts.
  - 2. The Safe was opened/broken on Saturday the 8<sup>th</sup> August, 2015 and the total cash kept in the Safe was found available.
  - 3. No explicit clue regarding the theft/thief could be found with the help of CCTV camera.

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- 4. Security Lapse/Negligence: While going through the verbal inquiry and written statements of the Security Guards, it was noticed that the security guards were available on duty as per duty rota but they showed negligence as they did not remain active during the incident/theft and remained slept at night instead of awakening and having rounds within & outside the PICO building.
- 5. Accounts Office Negligence: The Govt. cash of Rs. 789,670/- was withdrawn by the Accounts Office (Govt.) on Wednesday August 5<sup>th,</sup> 2015, was taken by Mr. Samahatullah, Account Assistant on the same day to NBP and according to his statement on refusal by the Bank Manager, he brought this cash back to PICO and deposited in the Project Account Office Locker. According to the written statement of Accounts Officer (Project), the cash was again handed over to Mr. Samahatullah & Mr Wasif (dispatcher) on 06/08/2015 and the same was returned for keeping in the safe. While on Friday, 07/08/2015, the project office (Govt.) did not ask about their cash and hence the cash remained in the safe. While according to the statement of Mr. Samahataullah, Account Assistant (Govt.) he asked Mr. Wasif (dispatcher) to deposit the cash on Friday 07/08/2015 and Mr. Wasif replied that he will do it after doing the work of some other officers of PICO but Mr. Wasif then did not come. Moreover, on a query that why the cash could not be deposited in the bank in a proper manner and in time, the Accounts Officer and Account Assistant (Govt.) accounts stated that due to refusal of the NBP staff on 05/08/2015 for not understanding the procedure and certain deficiencies pointed out by SBP on the 06/08/2015 like not completing some documents, the cash could not be deposited in time. The Inquiry Committee feels that an irregularity on the part of the Accounts Office (Govt.) has taken place by not depositing the cash in the Govt. exchequer in time and according to the procedure.
- 6. The Account Officer (Project) could not satisfy the committee when asked to tell why the Govt. cash was kept in his office. The only reason he told was that the cash was kept on the request of Accounts Officer (Govt.) for the purpose of safety, as the only safe in PICO is placed in Accounts Office (Project).

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- 7. Both the Accounts Officers could not satisfy the committee regarding the query as to how much cash they can keep in office as per the Govt. rules.
- 8. The Accounts Officer (Govt.) could not satisfy the Inquiry Committee when asked as to how much cash a dispatcher can carry for official purpose.
- 9. Neither Accounts Officer (Govt.) could satisfy the inquiry committee as to why cash transaction instead of cheque transaction was made.
- 10. On a query from both the Accounts Officers regarding did they keep inform the DDO about keeping this cash for three days in the locker, they replied in negative viz they did not keep the DDO inform about keeping cash in locker.
- 4. Summary of Findings: In view of the above findings, the Inquiry Committee feels
  - i) that security negligence has taken place on the part of security guards for not properly watching the Institute premises.
  - ii) Irregularity has taken place on the part of the Mr. Aftab Sher, PICO Accounts Officer (Govt.) for keeping that much cash in office and not keeping informed the DDO about the reasons for delaying its depositing and handing over large amount of cash to Mr. Samahatullah, Account Assistant and Mr. Wasif Nabi, Dispatcher.
  - iii) Irregularity has been shown by Mr. Samahatullah, Accounts Assistant (Govt.) for not depositing the cash in the bank in time.
  - iv) Irresponsibility was shown by Mr. Wasif Nabi, dispatcher for not depositing the cash in the bank on Friday 08/08/2015.
  - v) Irregularity on the part of Ms Beenish, Accounts Assistant (Project) for keeping the cash Rs. 88147/- in the drawer.

vi) Irregularity on the part of Mr. Ikramullah Jan, Accounts Officer (project) for not intimating the DDO about keeping the Govt. cash in its office locker.

Reference letter No: 1-2/PO/PICO/Vol-III/2015-16 dated 05/09/2015 by the Dean PICO subsequent to the directives of Chairman of BoG a committee was constituted to probe the theft incidence at PICO HMC.

The committee also visited the scene of crime i.e. the broken window and the accounts office from where the money was claimed to be stolen i.e. the drawer of office table and the damaged safe. It also meticulously watched the CCTV footage of the PICO regarding the incidence.

The committee puts forward the following facts & figures about the mishap.

#### FINDINGS:

- 1. A huge amount of money i.e. Rs. 1039670/- (Rs. Ten lakhs thirty nine thousand six hundred and seventy) was kept in the safe of the office of the account officer Mr. Ikram Ullah, of which Rs. 789670/- (Rs. Seven lakhs eighty nine thousand six hundred and severity) was handed over by Mr. Afrab (Govi) & Rs. 250000/- (Rs. Two lakhs and fifty thousand) was put in by Mr. Ikram Ullah. The money belonging to different financial heads of PICO remained there for a long time more than two months. Moreover another amount of Rs. 88147/- (Rs. Eighty eight thousand one hundred and forty seven) was kept in the drawer of a table under the custody of Miss. Beenash Nasir, the computer operator PICO without proper safety.
- 2. Dealing with the National Bank and State Bank for the transactions of the said money was executed by the junior staff i.e. Samahat Ullah Assistant Account Officer & Wasif Nabi, Naib Qasid PICO all the time and neither of the two account officers bothered to contact the bank personally to settle problems faced by the junior staff. Thus a lot of time was wasted without properly securing the Government money in time.

Even DDO of PICO was not informed about the prevailing scenario.

- 3. The theft took place during night time (7th & 8th August 2015), recording of the camera at the back of the PICO showed only a few glimpses of torch light at about 9:45 PM without any clearly identifiable person. The supporting light for the camera to improve night vision was out of order.
- 4. The two security guards on Night Duty i.e. Mr. Mustafa Kamal Chowkider of PICO and Mr. Mujahid Private Guard also showed extreme carelessness. They

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remained awake for while in the reception area of the PICO and moved out of PICO at about 09:30 PM and then slept the whole night in the reception.

5. Based on camera recording Mr. Wasif Nabi, Naib Qasid came at about 6:30 ÅM to the PICO on 8<sup>th</sup> August 2015 quite earlier and even marked his attendance. He left PICO at 7:30 AM and went towards the hospital and remained away for about 15 minutes for which he presented his own explanation that one of his relative was admitted in Cardiology and he spent night with him and thus came earlier to the PICO. He also remained very active the whole day i.e. (8<sup>th</sup> August 2015) moving here and there.

### CONCLUSION / RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. Personnel of the account section i.e. Mr. Ikram Uilah Accounts Officer PICO, Mr. Aftab Sher Accounts Officer (Govt.), Mr. Samahat Ullah Accounts Assistant PICO and Miss. Becnish Nasir Computer Operator PICO have shown extreme carelessness and negligence in properly safeguarding the Govt. money by keeping it in sate & drawer of the account office for a long time. Even they did not inform the DDO about all this in time. Only junior staff and Naib Qasid was deputed for dealing with banks regarding transactions of this money and no account officer did contact the banks official in time. So they should be charged with the act of negligence and mishandling the financial matters and penalized in whatever form permissible under the existing government financial rules and regulations.
  - Mustafa Kamal night Chowkider PICO must be suspended and penalty imposed upon therein according to government rules and regulations. The private security company under which Mujahid was employed as night security guard must be penalized and black listed.
  - 3. Mr. Wasif Nabi, Naib Qasid PICO and the dispatcher whose activities appear suspicious should be suspended and further penalty imposed according to the government rules and regulations.

- 4. All the financial matters must be monitored by the DDO PICO directly, keeping vigilant eye on the accounts record so that the money is secured in government exchequer in time and such a mishap is avoided in future.
- 5. Every person of the account section should perform duty according to their job description and the bank dealings monitored by the account officers themselves.
- 6. Working of the rear cameras of PICO and Eye unit must be improved by providing proper light so that recording at night time is possible. The IT programmer Mr. Imran must be penalized according to laid down rules.
