AMENDED SERVICE APPEAL U/S 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974 WHICHEBY THE DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL OF THE APPELLANT WAS NOT DECIDED IN WHICH HE CLAIMED HIS SENIORITY WITH ALL BACK BENEFITS FROM THE DATE OF HIS ORIGINAL / INITIAL APPOINTMENT.

Respectfully Sheweth:

1. That in the above Amended Service Appeal, private respondents has been impleaded which are inadvertently not mentioned in

Khyber akhtukhwe Service Tribuand Peshawar

the main service appeal therefore this amended service appeal may please be decided in the light of above submissions.

- 2. That the appellant was appointed as Drawing Master (BPS-09) on 04.07.1996 on temporary basis. He assumed the charge of the post in Government High School Gandheri A.V.P., Tangi Charsadda. (Copy of the appointment order dated 04.07.1996 and certificate of transfer of charge dated 01.09.1996 are attached as *annexure A & B*).
- 3. That the appellant including hundreds of other employees / government servants were politically victimized and were terminated to accommodate blue eyed of political personalities.
- That the appellant was re-appointed on the same post i.e. Drawing Master (BPS-15) again on temporary basis, even though he completed his probationary period previously. The reappointment was due to the passing of KPs Sacked Employees Act, 2012, in which all the employees who were terminated due to political victimization were again appointed on their respective posts. (Copies of the re-appointment order dated 31.12.2012 and certificate of transfer of charge dated 03.01.2013 are attached as annexure C&D).
- 5. That the word re-appointment has been mentioned in the above mentioned Act and after re-appointment, the appellants previous service as well as the period in which he remain unemployed due to illegal orders of termination was not counted. The benefits of his service was not given to him from the date of his initial /

original appointment which is 04.07...996. (Copy of termination order dated 13.02.1997 is attached as *annexure D-1)*.

- 6. That the appellant including other government servants submitted writ petition before the Hon'ble Peshawar High Court challenging the KP Sacked Employees Act, 2012 which had contradiction with the Federal Law which was passed by the parliament, however, the writ petition was dismissed as it become infructuous after passing of the judgment of Supreme Court of Pakistan. (Copies of the Federal Sacked Employee Act, writ petition No. 2493-P/2013 and order dated 09.03.2022 as well as judgments dated 28.01.2022 & 17.12.2021 of Supreme Court of Pakistan in Civil Petition and Review Petition along with circular dated 15.08.2022 are attached as annexure E, F, G, H, I & J).
- 7. That the appellant as per the law is entitled to get his seniority from the date of his initial appointment and he is entitled to all back benefits including promotions which he could not get due to an illegal and unconstitutional act of political personalities.
- 8. That in similar cases, the service appeal was accepted by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Sub Ordinate Judicial Service Tribunal and the Seniority with all back benefits were granted to the appellant in that case. (Copy of the judgment dated 18.12.2021 of Service Tribunal is attached as *annexure K)*.
- 9. That the juniors of the appellants are now his superiors and he is working as their subordinate and it is a continuous trauma for him and even legally it is a recurrent cause of action for him to approach this Hon'ble Tribunal in appeal.

- 10. That the appellant also preferred appeal before the departmental authority and its copies were also provided by the appellant to the respondents and the appeal was not decided.
- 11. That the respondents fail to pass any favourable order by following the law laid down by this Hon'ble Tribunal, Hon'ble Peshawar High Court and apex Court even though under Article 189 and 201 of the Constitution, the judgments of the Superior Courts are binding on all the departments and in judgment reported as "2009 SCMR 01", it has been held that the relief granted to one person shall also be granted to other person even though he did not approach the court in litigation.
- 12. That the non-exercise of jurisdiction and not deciding the departmental appeal itself shows the malafide of the department.
- 13. That the appellant is entitled to his seniority, promotion and all back benefits from the date of his original / initial appointment.
- 14. That not granting the seniority, promotion and all the back benefits to the appellant is illegal, without jurisdiction, without lawful authority and due to political reasons.
- 15. That the appellant has not been treated in accordance with law and is discriminated against.





It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that on acceptance of this Service Appeal, the appellant may kindly be declared to be entitled to his seniority from the date of his initial / original appointment i.e. 04.07.1996 and promotions and all other back benefits etc and it may be directed to the respondents to rectify / correct his seniority and give all back benefits to the appellant in the best interest of justice.


