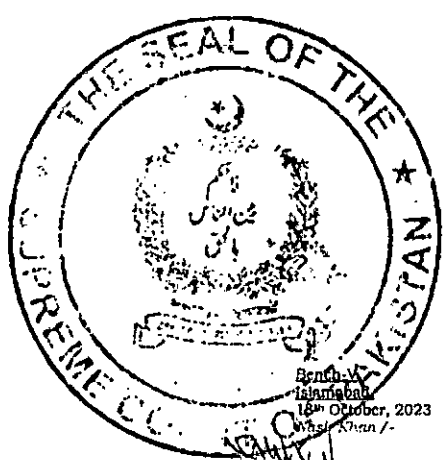

ORDER
