2. Learned counsel for the appellant was confronted with the minutes of the meeting held on 28.01.2021 on the basis of which. the appellant was reinstated/appointed on 23.02.2023 against the vacant post, according to which, the appellant was recommended for reinstatement as per court judgment with immediate effect without back benefits, to which, learned counsel for the appellant submitted that the appellant was not in the knowledge of giving immediate effect to the reinstatement/appointment order and not granting the back benefits, which he came to know today. Therefore, he does not press this appeal and intends to file representation against the part of the order of reinstatement giving immediate effect instead of giving it effect from the date from which he was terminated. Dismissed being not pressed. The appellant is at liberty to make application/representation to the department for giving effect to the reinstatement order from the date of his earlier termination and for grant of back benefits. Needless to say that if any representation/application is moved, that will be decided on its own merits subject to limitation etc. Disposed of as above. This order shall also decide the connected
