<u>Civil Petition No.428-P of 2020,</u> <u>Civil Petition No.429-P of 2020:</u>

Leave to appeal is sought against a judgment of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, Peshawar dated 22.07.2020. Through the impugned judgment, the service appeals filed by the respondents were allowed and they were reinstated into service with a direction that

2. We have heard the learned AOR at considerable length and gone through the record. We have also examined the documents filed by way of CMA No.8850/2023 which were filed pursuant to our dated 27.09.2023. In light of what has been stated in the documents, we have examined the judgment of the Tribunal. We find that the Tribunal has examined all legal and procedural aspects of the matter and recorded conclusions which are duly supported by the relevant principles of law on the subject. We have not found any legal or jurisdictional defect or error in the impugned judgment that may furnish basis or ground for grant of leave to appeal in the matter. Even otherwise, no question of law of public importance within the contemplation of Article 212(3) of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 has been raised through these petitions. Consequently, these petitions are dismissed. Leave to appeal is refused.

Civil Petition No.2442 of 2020:

The Learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition in order to approach the departmental authorities for the relief that he seeks. Dismissed as withdrawn.
