DEFAULT ON 09.10.2023.**


**Respectfully Sheweth;**

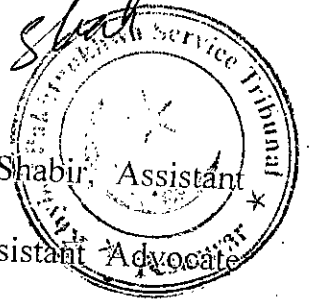
