 That the appellant is widow of deceased Zakir Ullah COC BPS-16 in District Judiciary Shangla, who was died during service on 15th May 2022.
 (Copy of death certificate is attached as annexure-A).

2. That during the service the Appellant's husband has performed his duty with full devotion and no complaint whatsoever has been made against the appellant.

That on initiative of government a letter bearing No. SOR-I(E&AD) 4-17/2020 dated 07.02.2020 was circulated which included a list of government officers/official whose spouses were the beneficiaries of the Bernazir Income Support Program, hence in compliance of the same the Peshawar High Court Peshawar vide letter bearing No. 6154-206/Admn: dated 23.04.2020 addressed to all District & Sessions Judges of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa to take disciplinary action against those Govt. Servant himself of through spouse received income support from BISE. (Copies of letters alongwith list are attached as Annexure-B). That in compliance of the same a show cause notice dated 12.05.2020 was issued to the appellant's husband in response of show cause notice, by the respondent No.2 of show cause notice the appellant's husband properly reply the show cause and denied all the allegations. After hearing without conducting proper inquiry passed the impugned order dated 11.07.2020, whereby the accused was imposed and awarded upon minor penalties i.e.

- i. With holding of increments for three years non-accumulative effects.
- ii. Recovery of Rs.131,874/- from the appellant which was received by the appellant's spouse. (Copy of Show Cause notice alongwith order dated 11.07.2020 and reply of show cause notice are attached as annexure C-D).
- 5. That the appellant aggrieved from the said orders of the respondent No.2 and filed Departmental Appeal under Sub Rule (I) of rule 3 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Appeal) Rules, 1986 before the Appellate forum Peshawar High Court Peshawar. After hearing on 14.10.2023, the appeal was partially

allowed and set aside the order to the extent of 03 years holding of increments while to the extent of recovery of Rs.131,874/- was dismissed. (Copy of the said departmental áppeal alongwith consolidated judgment is attached as annexure-E).

That feeling aggrieved the Appellant prefers the instant service appeal before this Hon'ble Tribunal on the following ground inter alia:

<u>GROUNDS</u>:-

- A. That the appellant's husband has not been treated in accordance with law and rules and hence his rights secured and granted under the constitution of Islamic republic of Pakistan, 1973 were badly violated.
- **B.** That no departmental or regular inquiry was conducted against the appellant's husband by the respondent No.2 and no chance of personal hearing has been provided to the appellant's husband and in this respect the appellant's husband relied upon the judgment dated 2008 SCMR page-1369.

C. That it is a well settled maxim that no one can be condemned unheard because it is against the natural justice of law and in this respect the appellant relied upon a judgment reported on 2008 SCMR page-678.

That no charge sheet or statement of allegation has been issued against the appellant's husband.

That the appellant's husband never applied to the BISP for Financial Support nor received the said amount from the BISP nor appellant herself applied for the said financial support. The BISP programme was launched in the year 2010 which was based on fixed ratio of poverty. At that time there was no any clear policy or rules that Govt. servant or their spouses were not entitled to take benefits from the said income support program. Now recently the Govt. has changed its policy on 23.12.2019 in this regard Article 12 of the constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan is very much clear. Hence, the appellant's husband has not committed any misconduct and is not liable to any punishment because appellant's husband nor his spouse personally appeared before the interview/ officials of the BISP.

That any other ground not raised here may graciously be allowed to be raised at the time

of arguments on the tie of full arguments on the instant service appeal.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of this appeal, the impugned order dated 14.10.2023 to the extent of recovery Rs.131,874/- may kindly be set aside and any other remedy which this August Tribunal deems fit and appropriate that, may also be awarded in favour of the appellant.







Respected Sir,

With reference to show cause notice No. 709/ DSJ/ZQ(SH) dated 12.05.2020 served to me with the allegations that my spouse was beneficiary of Benazir Income Support Program. My reply to the show cause notice is as under:-

That in the year 2010, a survey team of BISP visited our village and asked the women folk of our village for their CNICs by saying that government through BISP program is paying income support to women of the rural areas throughout Pakistan. On this like other women of the village, my wife may have given them her own CNIC. At that time I was not present at home.

That we never applied BISP for income support in fact they themselves enrolled my wife in BISP.

That neither 1 nor my wife was in knowledge that government employees and their families are not eligible for BISP grant, nor the BISP ever asked about this fact and nor there was anything in black in white in the shape of clear policy or rules in this

regard. In fact this condition was implicated in the cabinet meeting held on 24th December 2019 and 0.8 million people including government employees were excluded from BISP. Before this no such conditions were implicated and there is no such policy or rule that government servants or their families were not entitled. While at the time of survey in 2010, BISP had fixed a ratio of poverty in which the people who came in score of 16-17 or less were included in their program and at that time, there were no prohibitions for government employees and the score was fixed on social poverty status. But now the government changed its policy and government employees who came under score of poverty during the survey could not be blamed for misconduct etc. Besides this, no government employee can hide his personal information or data from any other government department because his personal information or data can easily be accessed from NADRA and this fact is evident from the act taken by government by getting personal information of people and removing them from BISP.

That according to report of BISP, each and every record was processed through a highly transparent mechanism by

applying various biometric checks for poverty score and then NADRA awarded contract for complete verification which is evident from their report. The important portions of the said report consisting of five



Vide letter of the Hon'ble Peshawar High Court, Peshawar bearing No. 6154-206/ADMN: dated 23.04.2020, list received included name of Mr. Zakir Ullah (EPS-16) s/o Sabir Khan CNIC No. 15505-0209199-7 presently working as Assistant/clerk of Court in the Court of Senior Civil Judge (Admin) Shangla at serial No. 02 for having his wife having CNIC No. 15505-02037394, as beneficiary, for receiving an amount of Rs. 1,31,874/- from Benazir Income Support Program despite of the fact that accused/official being government servant and his wife was not entitled for receiving the same.

Disciplinary proceeding were initiated against accused/official by dispensing inquiry and adopting shorter procedure as per Rule 7 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Efficiency and Discipline), Rules 2011.

On 12.05.2020, show cause notice bearing No. 709/D&3J/ZQ(SH) was issued to Mr. Zakir Ullah Assistant/Clerk of Court as to why penalty provided under Rule 4 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant FURM "A" FORM OF ORDER SHEET

On 28.05.2020, Mr. Zakir Ullah Assistant/
Clerk of Court submitted written reply to show cause notice in which he has mentioned that neither his wife nor he was in the knowledge that Government employees and their families are not eligible for Benazir Income Support Program nor concerned officer of Benazir Income Support Program asked about the said fact.

In the reply there is at least no denial of the fact that he was not government servant and his wife has not received the BISP cash grant.

Vide letter No. 680/D&SJ/ZQ(SH) dated 30.04.2020, relevant information were sought from Assistant Director BISP Shangla who vide letter No. AD/BISP/ALP/SH/21-6 dated 05.05.2020 submitted the same.

According to the information received, wife of Mr. Zakir Ullah Assistant having CNIC No. 1550502037394 has received an amount of Rs. 1,31,874/- as BISP cash grant. Accused/official submitted application to Assistant Director BISP Tehsil Puran District Shangla who has reported that amount of Rs. 29338/- has not been received by wife FORM "A" FORM OF ORDER SHEET

has also verified that amount of Rs. 5000/- has also not been received by wife of Mr. Zakir Ullah. Thus, deducting the amount not received by wife of Mr. Zakir Ullah Assistant/Clerk of Court, the remaining amount received by wife of Mr. Zakir Ullah Assistant/Clerk of Court is Rs. 107,536/-. The reply of the show-cause notice submitted by Mr. Zakir Ullah Assistant/clerk of Court was found not satisfactory. Mr. Zakir Ullah Assistant/Clerk of Court was heard in person but he could not justify receiving of BISP cash grant in the name of his wife, being a government servant and his wife not entitled to receive the same. The BISP was meant for poor and needy people, who had no bread earner or live below

> Therefore, in view of the above, charges enumerated in the show-cause notice are proved against the accused/official and the following minor penalties as embodied in Rule 4(1)(a)(ii)(iii) of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011 are imposed:

> > He is awarded penalty of withholding increments for three years with non-accumulative effect under Rule (4)(1)(a)(ii) of the ibid rules.

> > Recovery of Rs 107536/- be made from pay of accused/official and be deposited in government treasury under Rule 4(1)(a)(iii) of the ibid rules.

That in compliance of the same a show cause notice wasissued to which was commented/replied by the appellant and the competent authority after hearing the appellant and without conducting inquiry passed the impugned order dated 11.07.2020 against the appellant. (Copy of reply and Order are annexed)

That the Benazir Income Support was launched in the year 2010, which was based on fixed ratio of poverty. At that time there was no any clear policy or rules that Govt servants or their spouses were not entitled to take benefits from the said income support program. Now recently the Govt has changed its policy, therefore the appellant has not committed any misconduct and is not liable to any punishment because appellant nor his spouse personally appeared before the interviewer/official of the BISP.

by the officials of the BISP as they were required under the rules to stop enrolment/stop payment of grant, despite the fact at that time the BISP in corroboration with NADRA pledge that the NADRA played a crucial role of identifying the rightful person under the BISP by applying various

biometric verifications. As per report of (Targeting Process Evaluation) <u>all entries were made by the NADRA after</u> <u>proper scrutiny and data entry mechanism</u> and it was a mandate of the Ibid policy that biometric verification of every individual carried out then how for the fault committed by NADRA and the BISP the appellant could become sacrificial animal.

That the Hon'ble District and Sessions Judge Shangla, instead of initiating an impartial inquiry regarding receiving of benefits of the said program by the appellant himself, ordered disciplinary proceedings against the appellant. • That the appellant neither received any amount nor he himself is named as a beneficiary by the Peshawar High Court, Peshawar vide it's letter bearing No. 6154-206/Admin : dated 23.04.2020 but his spouse was named therein, for which he couldn't be held liable. It is also a matter of importance that the said form belongs to the spouse/wife of the appellant and the appellant came to know about the matter after receiving show cause notice from the Hon'ble District & Sessions Judge that his wife receiving benefits from BISP That it is the rule/command of Islamic law that no one should be punished for the offence committed by other, even by close relative.

That the appellant condemned for the charges which had no nexus to him, hence the order appeal herewith is harsh and untenable in the eyes of law.

Therefore, it is requested that my case may kindly be consider on humanitarian basis and therepresentation in hand may be accepted and the impugned order dated 11-07-2020 passed by the Hob'ble District &. Sessions Judge, may be set aside and the appellant may kindly be exonerated from the subject penalties imposed. upon him.

ISHTIAO IBRAHIM, J .- This single judgment is meant to decide the instant Departmental Appeal as well as the connected Departmental Appeals, list of which is attached with the judgment as Annexure-A (consisting 02 pages)

Brief facts leading to instant Departmental Appeals 2. are that Benazir Income Support Programme (BISP) was launched with two main objectives; to cushion the adverse impact of the food, fuel and financial crisis on the poor; and a longer terms objective of providing a minimum income support package to the unprivileged and to those most vulnerable to future shocks. The Government unearthed a scam relating to Benazir Income Support Programme (BISP). It was found that the amount was received by such persons/employees of the subordinate judiciary who were ATTESTED MINER/ Postawar High Court not entitled to BISP. In this regard a list of illegal recipients was shared with Peshawar High Court Peshawar which was further transmitted to all the District & Sessions Judges/ZQs/Judges of Anti-Terrorism Courts/Senior Civil Judges/AIQ and the Presiding Officers of Labour Courts in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa with directions that disciplinary proceedings be initiated against the delinquent officials by dispensing with inquiry and adopting shorter procedure under rule-7 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Efficiency and Discipline) Rules, 2011. Disciplinary action was initiated against the illegal recipients/employees and the following penalties were imposed upon them.

Penalty of withholding of increments. Recovery of the amount/aid received in BISP.

Feeling aggrieved the employees have filed these
 Departmental Appeals under Sub Rule (1) of Rule 3 of
 Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Appeal) Rules, 1986.
 Heard.

5. On record there is an office order dated 26.09.2020, passed by Hon'ble the then Chief Justice Mr. Waqar Ahmad Seth (late), wherein, identical matters/departmental appeals of the employees of Peshawar High Court Peshawar were accepted and decided in the following manners;

I. The penalty of stoppage of increment is s aside/recalled/reviewed.



- 11. Office shall recover in 10 equal installments from these Officials the amount received from BISP either by the Official himself or through his spouse. The target date to reckon while calculating the installments is the date the official was employed in this Court. Thus; the amount received earlier thereto would not come within the ambit of this recovery.
- III. The Director Budget & Account and the respective Account Officers of the District Judiciary (as the case may be) shall make necessary calculation after verification of record and shall issue necessary vouchers for payment of the said amount.

IV. If for any reason there is a default in payment of installment, then the amount shall be recoverable from the salary of the concerned officials.

6. The cases of the present appellants are no more different from the cases of the appellants/employees dealt with in the order supra, therefore, following the ratio of order ibid these appeals are partially accepted and disposed

of in the terms that;

a. The penalty of stoppage of increment is set aside.

Recovery of amount received by the appellants or their spouses from BISP (if not already recovered) shall be made from the appellants in monthly installments in the following manner;

BPS-1 to 5 BPS-6 to 11 BPS-11 and above *Rs.4000/- per month. Rs.7000/- per month. Rs.8000/- per month.*

If the appellants want to deposit the entire amount, he may deposit the same with the concerned authority. The determination/calculation of the amount to be recovered from the employees should be reckoned from the date of entry into service/appointment. Thus, the amount received earlier thereto would not come within the ambit of this recovery.

7. So for as Departmental Appeal No.10/2020, <u>titled</u> <u>"Zakirullah Vs. District & Sessions Judge, Shangla"</u>, is concerned, Superintendent, District & Sessions Judge, Shangla, appeared and stated that the appellant has passed away in the year 2020, and his widow is receiving his pension which is the only source of their bread and butter. Therefore, keeping in view the special circumstances <u>Rs.3000/-</u> per month shall be recovered from her pension to make the recovery good.

8. In view of above, the instant and the connected Departmental Appeals are disposed of in the above terms.
