Service Appeal No.7560/2021 titled "Muzaffar Iqbal Ahmad Nawaz Vs. Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa"

> 2. Learned counsel for the appellant relies on the report of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Appellate' Medical Board dated 25.06.2021, wherein, following recommendations were made:

*"i. He is advised light duty without weapon."* 

*ii.* He will be under observation for a period of six months and after that he will be reviewed by the Board.

*iii.* Currently, the Board is of the opinion that he can resume his duty."

The above recommendations show that the appellant would be under observation for a period of six months and after, he will be reviewed by the Board. When confronted with the situation, admittedly, his progress was not reviewed as observed by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Appellate Medical Board.

3. Therefore, we send the matter back to the respondents to place the case reflect the case of the appellant to the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Appellate Medical Board for review and after receipt of report of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Appellate Medical Board, the respondents may pass appropriate order. It is further desired that the appellant shall be referred to the Board within 30 days of this order. Consign.
