He submitted that the impugned order passed in violation of the rules and transfer/posting policy of the government, therefore, the same may be set aside and appellant may be left to serve in the Maulvi Ameer Shah Memorial Hospital, Peshawar.
- 5. The learned Government Pleader resisted this appeal by stating that the appellant has long ago completed his tenure at Maulvi Ameer Shah Memorial Hospital, Peshawar and due to instant litigation, he wants to prolong his stay in the same hospital with malafide intentions. He next submitted that the instant appeal is against the impugned order dated 22.09.2014 which has been replaced by order dated 25.2.2015 but the same has not been



questioned by the appellant either in the instant appeal or in his departmental appeal. In this situation, the learned Government Pleader submitted that the instant appeal has also become infructuous like his previous appeal. He submitted that the appeal may be dismissed.

- We have heard the learned counsel for the appellant and learned Government Pleader at length and have carefully perused the record.
- 7. That the impugned order was politically motivated there is no solid proof of the same on record. The appellant has also completed his tenure at Molvi Ameer Shah Memorial Hospital, Peshawar and perpetuation of his stay there would amount to his desire to stay in place of his choice. On perusal of the entire record of this appeal as well as previous one, the instant appeal is also not maintainable in which the subsequent order dated 25.2.2015 has not been made impugned.

- 1. That appellant is serving as Office Assistant in the Directorate of Health Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, to the best satisfaction of his superiors.
- 2. That respondent No.2 has made a game of posting/ transfer of the officials instead of a matter of policy, as appellant has been transferred six times to different places within a span of one and half year.
- 3. That appellant was transferred on 26.02.2013 from HMC Peshawar to Sarhad Hospital for Psychiatric Disease Peshawar, followed by a cancellation of said transfer order dated 14.05.2013. The appellant was again transferred on 20.05.2013 and the same was cancelled on 29.05.2013. (Copies of transfer orders dated 26.02.2013, 14.05.2013, 20.05.2013 and 29.05.2013 are attached as annexure "A/1" to "A/4" respectively).
- 4. That subsequently the appellant was posted on 06.08.2013 in the Molvi Ameer Shah Memorial Hospital, Peshawar and again the impugned transfer order dated 22.09.2014 was issued in strict violation of posting/transfer policy. (Copies of transfer orders dated 06.08.2013 and 22.09.2014 are attached as annexure "B" to "B/1" respectively).
- 5. That feeling aggrieved from impugned transfer order, the appellant filed departmental representation on 24.09.2013 which was left

- undecided. (Copy of departmental representation is attached as Ann: C).
- 6. That the impugned transfer order dated 22.09.2014 and later on, non-deciding the departmental representation is illegal, without jurisdiction and without lawful authority.
- 7. That impugned posting order dated 22.09.2014 has been issued in violation of posting/transfer policy where normal tenure for posting is three years but appellant has been posted on different places within a short span of time.
- 8. That the impugned transfer order passed by respondent No.2 in a shot span of time, indiscriminately without rhyme or reason shows malafide on the part of respondents and is against the proclaimed policies.
- 9. That the impugned posting order is arbitrary, against the canons of justice, equity and fair play, hence, liable to be set aside.
- 10. That the appellant has not been treated in accordance with the law and has been discriminated against.



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



APPLICATION FOR INTERIM RELIEF BY WAY OF SUSPENDING THE TRANSFER ORDER DATED 25.02.2015.

Respectfully Sheweth:

- 1. That the above mentioned appeal is pending adjudication before this Honourable Tribunal, which is fixed for 12.03.2015.
- 2. That applicant is the employee of Health Department and serving to the best satisfaction of his superiors but is facing tough situation without any fault on his part and without any complaint as he has been transferred seven times within a span of about two years, as very clear from pending appeal.



- 3. That applicant was serving in the Maulvi Amar Shah Hospital Peshawar through office order dated 26.08.2013 when ironically his transfer order was issued on 22.09.2014 within a span of one year. The applicant filed a constitutional petition against the said illegal transfer order, which was entertained by Honourable High Court, and remanded the case to this Honourable Tribunal, where interim relief was granted and impugned order remained suspended by the order of this Honourable Tribunal. (Copies of PHC order dated 02.10.2014 and this Honourable Tribunal order dated 28.10.2014 are attached as annexure "A" & "B" respectively).
- 4. That during pendency of above mentioned appeal, the respondent D.G Health in violation of law, rules and posting/ transfers policy, again issued transfer order of the applicant vide order dated 25.02.2015. (Copy of impugned transfer order dated 25.02.2015 is attached as annexure "C").
- 5. That the order dated 25.02.2015 is illegal, without jurisdiction and without lawful authority, in violation of law, rules and policy.
- 6. That the Medical Superintendent of Maulvi Ameer Shah Memorial Hospital through a letter dated

28.02.2015, requested the respondent D.G Health for cancellation of impugned transfer order dated 25.02.2015 of the applicant from his subordination, being a honest, punctual, hard working and dedicated official. (Copy of letter dated 28.02.2015 is attached as annexure "D").

- 7. That the order dated 25.02.2015 is based on malafide and ulterior motives as it has been issued during pendency of above mentioned appeal and inspite of status quo order.
- 8. That the impugned order dated 25.02.2015 is solely on political influence and for making happy the political boss as the copy of same has been made to him.
- 9. That the DG Health by himself wrote to the Secretary Health through a letter that the applicant cannot be transferred as he has not completed his statutory period in the said Maulvi Ameer shah Memorial Hospital, but then being influenced by the Minister for Health the posting order dated 25.02.2015 has been issued.
- 10. That the applicant has a good prima facie case and is hopeful of its success.

- 11. That the balance of convenience also lies in favour of the applicant and if the interim relief as prayed is not granted the applicant will suffer an irreparable loss.
- 12. That the impugned order has been issued in violation of superior courts judgments.

It is, therefore, humbly prayed that on acceptance of this application, the transfer order dated 25.02.2015 may kindly be suspended till final disposal of appeal in the interest of justice.

WRIT PETITION UNDER ARTICLE 199 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF PAKISTAN, 1973.

Respectfully Sheweth:

1. That petitioner is serving as Office Assistant in the Directorate of Health Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, to the best satisfaction of his superiors.

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- 2. That respondent No.3 has made a game of posting transfer of the officials, instead of a matter of policy, as petitioner has been transferred six times to different places within a span of one and half year.
- 3. That pelitioner was posted on 26.02.2013 from HMC, Peshawar to Sarhad Hospital for Psychiatric Disease, Peshawar, followed by a cancellation of said transfer order dated 14.05.2013. The petitioner was again transferred on 20.05.2013 and the same was cancelled on 29.05.2013, similarly, the petitioner was posted on 06.08.2013 in the Molvi Ameer Shah Memorial Hospital, Peshawar and he was again transferred on 22.09.2014. (Copies of all transfer orders are attached as annexure "A" to "A/5" respectively).
- 4. That the impugned posting order dated 22.09.2014 is illegal, without jurisdiction and without lawful authority.
- 5. That impugned posting order dated 22.09.2014 has been issued in violation of posting/ transfer policy where normal tenure for posting is three years but petitioner has been posted on different places within a short span of time.
- 6. That the impugned transfer order passed by respondent No.3 in a shot span of time and time and again indiscriminately without rhyme or reason shows malafide on the part of respondents and is against the proclaimed policies.

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- 7. That the impugned posting order is arbitrary, against the canons of justice, equity and fair play, hence, liable to be set aside.
- 8. That the petitioner has not been treated in accordance with the law and has been discriminated against.
- 9. That the impugned posting order is contrary to the judgment of Supreme Court of Pakistan (PLD 2013 SC-195) where the law has been clearly laid down on the subject.
- 10. That impugned order glaringly violates the rule of law and public policy and therefore, needs to be struck down.
- 11. That in similar circumstances this Hon'able Court has interfered and has set aside the premature posting/transfer orders. (Copies of order and judgment are attached as annexure "B" & "C" respectively).
- 12. That the petitioner has left with no other remedy except to approach this Hon'able Court through the instant writ petition as the Service Tribunal is not functioning. (Copies of the order sheets are attached as annexure "D").
- 13. That the petitioner may be allowed to put forward any other document/argument at the time of hearing the writ petition.

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It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that on acceptance of this writ petition, the impugned posting order dated 22.09.2014 may kindly declared as illegal, without jurisdiction and without lawful authority, for ulterior motives, malafide and political influence. The posting order dated 06.08.2013 may kindly be declared to be in field.

Any other order deemed appropriate to this Honorable Court in the above mentioned circumstances.

INTERIM RELIEF

. By way of interim relief, it is respectfully prayed that the impugned order dated 22.09.2014 may kindly be suspended till final disposal of the writ petition as the petitioner has got a good prima facie case.

Arguments could not be heard on the issues raised in the order sheet dated 16.10.2014, as learned AAG informed that appellate authority in the case of appellant is the Chief Minister with whom he could not establish contact in order to know about the present status/stage of the departmental appeal preferred by the appellant. The learned AAG, therefore, requested for a short adjournment in order to inform the Court/Tribunal about the above fact. Private respondent No.3/petitioner moved application for issuance directions to Dr. Muhammad Iqbal not to pressurize the applicant for handing over charge to him. Dr. Muhammad Iqbal has been transferred from DHQ Hospital Bannu to Kohat as DHO vice the private respondent No.3/petitioner vide impugned notification dated 29.09.2014 whereby the appellant has been transferred from the post of M.S Khyber Teaching Hospital, Peshawar and private respondent No.3/petitioner has been transferred from the post of DHO Kohat and posted as M.S KTH, Peshawar vice the appellant. There can be no two opinions that the august High Court suspended the impugned notification dated 29.09.2014, obviously as a whole, which order was further extended and ordered to continue to remain operative in the meantime. Therefore, there should be no doubt that with the suspension of transfer and posting order of the appellant and private respondent No.3/petitioner, the transfer/posting order of Dr. Muhammad Iqbal, made vide the same notification dated 29.09.2014, already suspended by the august High Court vide order dated 02.10.2014 and extended vide order of the Tribunal dated 16.10.2014, is equally applicable to the transfer/posting of Dr. Muhammad Iqbal, as each and every transfer/posting stands suspended with the suspension of the impugned notification dated 29.09.2014. With this clarification, the application is disposed of. To come up for further proceedings/arguments, in view of issues raised in the order sheet dated 16.10.2014, on Maismail 29,10,2014.

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Appellant in person, Mr Muhammad Abee, Butt, AAG and private

respondent No 3 in person present. The learned AAG stated that the departmental appeal is in process and that he would confirm outcome of the departmental appeal as soon as he receives any information with regard to that from the Chief Minister's Secretariat, Arguments could not be heard due to non-availability of learned counsel for the appellant owing to strike of the Bar. The appellant stated that his counsel is proceeding to Islamabad to appear in the august Supreme Court of Pakistan on 30th and 31st October. The appellant, therefore, requested for adjournment of the case and its fixation after Moharram holidays. The learned AAG proposed that since the appellant is mainly relying on the order of the august High Court dated 16.9 2014, the Tribunal may also refer the case to the respondent-department with the same directions while disposing of the appeal. The appellant, on the other hand, stated that without consultation and advice of his counsel, he is not in a position to respond to the proposal made by the learned AAG. A last chance is given for arguments, on the issues raised in the order sheet dated 16.10.2014, before Primary Bench on 5.11.2014.

05.11.2014

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Appellant alongwith his counsel and Mr. Kabirullah Kattak, Asst: AG for the respondents present. The learned counsel for the appellant submitted before the Court that the instant appeal has been partly heard by worthy Chairman and requested that it may be transferred to the same Bench for further arguments. This case be put up to the Chairman for further proceedings/order. Parties are directed to appear before the Chairman on 10:11,2014.

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16.10.2014

Appellant with counsel present. The instant appeal, alongwith service appeals No.1226/2014,1231/2014 and 1232/2014 have been received from the Hon'ble High Court with orders dated 2.10.2014 and 9.10.14, respectively for 'decision strictly in accordance with law and for considering the competency/maintainability of the appeal during pendency of the representation of the petitioner'. The Hon'ble High Court, in the said orders, directed that the impugned notifications/orders in the respective appeals 'shall remain suspended (till today) and not thereafter'.

At the outset, the learned counsel for the appellant (Mr. Ghulam Mohy-ud-Din Malik, Advocate, Supreme Court of Pakistan) (whose arguments were also adopted by the learned counsel in the aforementioned appeals, also received from the Honble High Court alongwith the instant appeal), contended that after an order by the Honble High Court and receipt of the appeals by the Tribunal from the Honble High Court with the aforementioned orders, this Tribunal is now bound to examine whether the Tribunal is validly constituted in the light of existing law on the subject, as the question of constitution of the Tribunal precedes the matter of constitution of Benches, to which the appeals are then referred for adjudication/order either at the preliminary or final stage. The learned counsel further contended that undoubtedly the law allows only the Chairman or a sole Member to hear and pass order at the preliminary stage but the question would nevertheless be that whether the Tribunal is validly constituted and whether in case of non-constitution of the Tribunal, the Benches i.e Primary or Final Benches could lawfully hear appeals and pass orders, because the NWFP (Khyber Fakhtunkhwa) Service Tribunal Act, Service Tribunal amended through Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Amendment) Act, 2013, provides that the Tribunal shall consist of a Chairman and two Members, one of whom is a District and Sessions Judge and the other is a Civil Servant in BPS-20 and above.

The objection to the constitution of the Tribunal has arisen in the backdrop of down-gradation/reversion of the learned Member (Judicial) of the Tribunal who has been rendered non-functional as he is no longer a District and Sessions Judge to qualify for the position of Member of the Tribunal.

It was also pointed out, during the course of arguments, that though one of the Member has been rendered non-functional by virtue of the subsequent development, as at the time of his appointment as Member of the Tribunal he was a District and Sessions Judge; but the Tribunal is still validly

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one from the executive and other from the judiciary, notwithstanding the current status of the learned Member (Judicial). Moreover, the Tribunal is also assumed to continue as a validly constituted Tribunal on the analogy of Article 192 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 where-under a High Court shall consist of a Chief Justice and so many other Judges as may be determined by law or, until so determined, as may be fixed by the President; and that the High Court is never presumed as not validly constituted owing to shortage of Hon'ble Judges as determined/fixed under the said provision of the Constitution as long as the Hon'ble Chief Justice and even a single Hon'ble Judge of the High Court are there to perform their functions.

The learned counsel for the appeilant pointed out that number of Honble Judges of the High Court is not determined/fixed in the Constitution, whereas the number of Members of the Tribunal is clearly and unequivocally fixed in the law and that owing to change in the status/position of a learned Member, the Tribunal will, lawfully, not be validly constituted. The learned counsel maintained that in a similar situation, the Honble Peshawar High Court has, while taking cognizance of the situation prevailing in the Tribunal, assumed jurisdiction and directed the respondents not to pass any adverse order affecting the service career of petitioner till the date Service Tribunal Khyber Pakhtunkhwa is legally constituted, vide order dated 16.9.2014 in writ petition No. 2726-P/2014 with I.R., on which reliance has also been placed by the Honble Peshawar High Court in the aforementioned orders while referring the writ petitions to the Tribunal for further order in accordance with law. In order to further augment his arguments, the learned counsel also referred to PLD 2014 Supreme Court 232(b).

Since very important legal questions have been raised with respect to the very constitution of the Tribunal, it would be appropriate to deal with the questions raised at the Bar at the first instance before proceeding further with the appeals, and for the purpose, a pre-admission notice be issued to the learned AAG as well as to the Chief Secretary, Govt of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (respondent No. 1) to report about the present status/stage of the departmental appeal preferred by the appellant. In order to ward off the possibility of further legal/administrative complications, the interim relief already granted to the appellant by the Honble High Court shall continue to remain operative in the meantime. To come up for arguments, as above, an 28.10.2014.
