appellant present. Mr. Muhammad Jan, District Attorney for the respondents

present. Arguments heard and record perused.

02. During the course of arguments it came to limelight that the appellant

basically borne on the cadre strength of CCPO Peshawar and was on deputation

basis to Elite Force and as such action against him was required to be taken by

the authorities of his parent cadre as per Police Rules. Rule 9 of the Police

Rules provides procedure of inquiry against officers/officials working in other

borrowing organization. In case the borrowing authority is of the opinion that

the officers/officials on deputation deserve punishment it shall transmit the case

to the lending authority alongwith record of the proceedings and the lending

authority shall take action as prescribed in these rules. As the appellant was on

deputation to Elite Force, therefore, the major punishment of removal from

service does not fall within the domain of the borrowing Elite Force. As such

the case was required to be transmitted to the landing authority for lawful order.

We, therefore, deem it appropriate to remit the case back to the respondent

department for proceedings against the appellant in accordance with law.

03. The instant appeal is disposed of on the above terms. Consign.
