was made that he would not claim any financial benefits during

novo enquiry. The respondents have annexed copy of an order

dated 08.02.2021 passed by the District Police Officer, D.I.Khan,

whereby, the said period was treated on full pay as if he had

performed duty during the said period. When confronted with the

above order, learned counsel for the appellant does not press this

appeal. Dismissed accordingly. However, the appellant is at liberty

to challenge any of the terms of the order dated 08.02.2021, if he

is so desirous, which, if done, has to be decided on its own merits.
