The appellant is aggrieved from the order dated 13.06.2019 passed by the Regional Police Officer, D.I.Khan in pursuance of the judgment of this Tribunal passed on 25.03.2019, in service appeal No. 871/2018, whereby, the appellant was, though, reinstated for the purpose of de-novo enquiry but an observation was made that he would not claim any financial benefits during this period i.e. the period of reinstatement for the purpose of de-novo enquiry. The respondents have annexed copy of an order dated 08.02.2021 passed by the District Police Officer, D.I.Khan, whereby, the said period was treated on full pay as if he had performed duty during the said period. When confronted with the above order, learned counsel for the appellant does not press this appeal. Dismissed accordingly. However, the appellant is at liberty to challenge any of the terms of the order dated 08.02.2021, if he is so desirous, which, if done, has to be decided on its own merits. Consign.


