2. The matter was heard at some length. The first point involved in all these appeals is regarding preparation of seniority list of the Junior Clerks/ Political Moharrirs or others in the same scales i.e. BPS-11. It is also the question whether the list of the staff in Grade-11, holding different posts in the offices of the Deputy Commissioners of different districts as well as the erstwhile Political Agents of the Agencies of the Division should be separately prepared or joint list of all the employees in the same pay scale of the entire Division should be prepared at Divisional level. When this point was being argued, the relevant rules were required to be perused but because of non-availability of the relevant rules in possession of either side, the matter was adjourned. The District Attorney is directed to assist the Tribunal, whether there were any rules of the Revenue Department on the above point or the employees should be governed only under the provisions of Section-8 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act, 1973 and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) rules, 1989? In that eventuality, learned District Attorney as well as learned counsel for the appellants and private respondents shall assist the Tribunal, whether the persons, holding the posts in Grade-11, should be part of the joint seniority list at Divisional level or a seniority list of such employees at the District/Agency level should be prepared? To come up for arguments on 17.01.2024 before D.B at Camp Court, D.I.Khan. P.P given to

the parties.
