- 4. That show-cause notice bearing number 3763/CE dated21-10-2015 was issued to the appellant (Copy attached as annexure B), which was duly replied(Copy attached as annexure C)
- 5. That thereafter the respondent No. 2 vide impugned order dated 27-10-2015 removed the appellant from the service as well as the said period was treated as leave without pay. (Copy of the impugned order dated 27-10-2015 is attached as annexure D)



- 2- The learned counsel for the petitioner argued that the petitioner while serving as Ward Orderly under the command of respondent No.3 since 17-8-2011, he was given show cause notice with the statement of allegation for his absence from duty w.e.f 08/10/2015, which was replied to by him; that without considering the humanitarian circumstances, removed the petitioner from his service by impugned order dated 27-10-2015, hence the instant Writ petition.
- 3. Arguments heard in motion and available record appended with the petition perused.
- 4. While going through the record and most particularly through the contents of the petition one could reach to an irresistible conclusion that the petitioner is a civil servant and the matter is of his re-

instatement in service, which does fall within the terms and conditions of service as such, comes within the domain of Service Tribunal. The constitutional jurisdiction of the High Court, in such like matters, is barred by explicit provision of Article 212 of the Constitution. It has been settled by the Apex court time and again that the matters with respect to the terms and conditions of service, could not be agitated before the High Courts, through constitutional petition under Article 199 of the Constitution. Article 212 (2) of the Constitution, unambiguously bars the jurisdiction of the High Courts in the matters exclusively triable by the Service Tribunal. The constitutional jurisdiction under Art.199 of the Constitution can be invoked only, when there is no alternate remedy, available to the aggrieved party. Keeping in view the nature of grievance of the petitioner, he has the right to invoke the jurisdiction of the Service Tribunal.

5. For the reasons discussed above, this petition being not maintainable, stands dismissed in

limine, however, the petitioner is at liberty to approach proper forum for his grievance, if so desire.

Respectfully Sheweth;

Rejoinder to the Preliminary Objections

- 1. Incorrect, the appellant has a good cause of action to file the instant appeal.
- 2. Incorrect, the appellant has a good locus standii to file the instant appeal.
- 3. Incorrect, the instant appeal is quite maintainable in its present form.
- 4. Incorrect, the appeal is not bad for non-joinder and mis-joinder of necessary parties.
- 5. Incorrect, the instant appeal is not barred by any law.
- 6. Incorrect, nothing has been concealed from this Hon`ble Tribunal intentionally or deliberately.
- 7. Incorrect, the instant appeal is well within time; otherwise too, the apex courts favoured the cases to be decided on merits rather on technicalities including the limitation.

Rejoinder to the Facts

- 1. Admitted, needs no rejoinder.
- 2. In rejoinder to para 2 it is submitted that taking of charge and successfully completion of probation period has been admitted by the respondent and so far the question of absence is concerned it was not willful and deliberate but was due to mentioned reasons already explained in reply to the show cause notice.

- 3. Incorrect, the appellant was unable to continue his duties for the period w.e.f. 08-10-2015 to 17-10-2015 due to the reason of some social dispute in his family, which is/was explained in reply to show-cause notice, while passing the impugned order dated 27-10-2015 the said period has been shown as w.e.f. 08-10-2015 to 26-10-2015.
- 4. In reply to para 4 it is submitted that reply given to the show cause is/was quite satisfactory and its non acceptance is out of imagination without giving any prudent reasons for the same.
- 5. Needs no rejoinder.
- 6. Incorrect, the appellant preferred a departmental appeal before Respondent No.1 on 25-11-2015, but the same is/was still not disposed of despite the lapse of statutory period.
- 7. Needs no rejoinder.
- 8. Rejoinder to the grounds of the para wise comments is as under;

Rejoinder to the GROUNDS

- A. Incorrect, the appellant has not been treated in accordance with law nor has equal protection of law been extended to him.
- B. Incorrect, the absence of the appellant was neither willful nor deliberate but was due to unavoidable circumstances and was only for few days for which he has been awarded a major penalty in shape of Removal from Service. The appellant informed the competent authority about his need for leave before leaving the duty.
- C. Incorrect, the appellant properly submitted an application for leave before the concerned authority, and then left the station.

On 18-10-2015 he was on duty but the appellant during the time which was spent in departmental proceedings was also considered as absent.

- D. Incorrect, the appellant has been awarded two penalties for remaining few days away from duty which is in the violation of Article 13 of the constitution and the Hon`ble apex courts in their so many precedents have declared such type of orders nullity in the eyes of law and treated the absence period as leave any kind due to him.
- E. Incorrect, the period w.e.f. 08-10-2015 to 26-10-2015 has already been treated as leave without pay, and then there is/was no justification for removal from service.
- F. Incorrect, that while awarding major penalty of removal from service no proper procedure was adopted.
- G. That any other ground can also be taken during the course of arguments with permission of this Hon`ble Tribunal.

It is therefore most humbly prayed that on acceptance of the instant rejoinder the impugned order dated 27/10/2015 passed by respondent no. 2 may very graciously be set aside and the appellant may kindly be re-instated on the post with all back benefits.

Any other relief which has not specifically asked for and deems fit in the circumstances of the case may also be awarded to the appellant.
