HAMID FAROOO DURRANI, CHAIRMAN:-

Instant appeal contains the following prayer:-

"That on acceptance of this appeal the respondents may kindly be directed to accept/allow the appellant to submit his arrival report and the respondents may further be directed to release the monthly salaries of the appellant w.e.f. 28.08.2013 till date. Any other remedy which this august Tribunal deems fit that may also be awarded in favour of the appellant."

- 2. Learned counsel heard and the available record gone through.
- 3. It is laid in the memorandum of appeal that the appellant was initially appointed as Physical Education Teacher by respondent No. 2 on 28.08.2013. Pursuant to the appointment order the appellant submitted arrival report and started performing his duty, however on 21.09.2013, the appointment was declared null & void on the ground that his degree/certificate was fake. The order dated 21.09.2013 was questioned by the appellant alongwith other colleagues before the Honourable Peshawar High Court. The Honourable Court allowed the



Writ Petition through a single judgment on 10.09.2015, whereby, the respondents

were directed to make recommendations for appointment of the petitioners after

verification of their educational testimonials. Subsequently, the name of appellant

was placed in a tentative revised short list of Male PETs for Tehsil Data Khel,

however, the appellant could not find any mention in the final merit list dated

10.08.2016. It is the claim of appellant that his exclusion from the short list was

unlawful as he had duly acquired Physical and Health Diploma and in the light of

a judgment by the Apex Court he was entitled to be reinstated against the post of

PET.

Admittedly, the appellant was not issued any appointment/adjustment 4.

order by the respondents after the decision of Writ Petition No. 330-B/2015. It

was noted in the order dated 10.09.2015, as relied upon by the appellant, that

formal appointment order of petitioners in compliance with the recommendations

of the competent authority, were to be issued. The requisite recommendations

were required to be made within 30 days in accordance with law, merit and after

due verification of educational testimonials.

It is a fact that release of monthly salary of appellant and submission of

arrival report, as prayed for in the appeal in hand, are ancillary to his appointment

which was never made after 21.09.2013, the date when prior appointment of

appellant and others was declared null & void.

In view of the above noted facts, the appeal in hand does not merit

admission for regular hearing, hence is dismissed in limine.

APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974 AGAINST THE INACTION OF THE RESPONDENTS BY NOT ACCEPTING/ALLOWING THE ARRIVAL REPORT OF THE APPELLANT AND NOT RELEASING MONTHLY SALARIES OF THE APPELLANT W.E.F. 28.8.2013 TILL DATE AND AGAINST NOT TAKING ACTION ON THE DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL OF THE APPELLANT WITHIN THE STATUTORY PERIOD OF NINETY DAYS

PRAYER:

That on acceptance of this appeal the respondents may kindly be directed to accept/allow the appellant to submit his arrival report and the respondents may further be directed to release the monthly salaries of the appellant w.e.f. 28.8.2013 till date. Any other remedy which this august Tribunal deems fit that may also be awarded in favor of the appellant.

R/SHEWETH: ON FACTS:

- 3- That later on another order bearing NO.3911-99/S dated 21-09-2013 was issued by respondent No. 3 whereby the appointment orders of appellant and his other colleagues recruited on different posts—were declared null and void on the ground that their degrees/certificates were fake.
- 4- That feeling aggrieved the appellant along with other colleagues challenged the said order before the Honorable Peshawar High Court, Peshawar and the Honorable Court allowed all writ petitions through a single judgment dated 10/09/2015 whereby the respondent were directed to make recommendation for appointment of the petitioners after due verification of their educational testimonials by the concerned boards/universities/institutions. Copy of the judgment dated 10.09.2015 is attached as annexure.
- 6- That disqualification of appellant on the basis of Skill Development Council diploma was in utter violation of the august Supreme Court Judgment dated 28/04/2016 whereby the Honorable bench holds that let them continue, if they besides the certificates or diplomas issued by the council, posses the requisite qualifications. Those who could not improve their qualification up till now should improve it within a period of one year, which would be reckoned from the date of commencement of the next available academic session of the respective program. Copy of judgment dated 28-04-2016 is annexed as annexure.
- 8- That after acquiring the said Diploma the appellant visited the concerned quarter for arrival report against the post of PET but the respondent Department is not willing to do so. That appellant feeling from the inaction of the respondent Department by not allowing the appellant to submit his arrival report preferred Departmental appeal before the appellate authority but the same is un-responded. Copy of the Departmental appeal is attached as annexure.

9- That appellant feeling aggrieved and having no other remedy filed the instant service appeal before this august Tribunal on the following grounds amongst the others.

GROUNDS:

- A- That the inaction of the respondent Department by not allowing/accepting the arrival report of the appellant and not releasing monthly salaries of the appellant w.e.f. 28.8.2013 till date is against the law, facts and norms of natural justice.
- B- That the appellant has not been treated by the respondent Department in accordance with law and rules on the subject noted above and as such the respondents violated Article-4 and 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan-1973.
- C- That the respondent Department acted in arbitrary and malafide manner by not allowing/accepting the arrival report of the appellant and not releasing monthly salaries of the appellant w.e.f. 28.8.2013 till date.
- D-That the inaction of the respondents by not allowing/accepting the arrival report of the appellant and not releasing monthly salaries of the appellant w.e.f. 28.8.2013 till date inspite of acquiring the requisite diploma is discriminatory.
- E- That the not allowing/accepting the arrival report of the appellant and not releasing monthly salaries of the appellant w.e.f. 28.8.2013 till date is the violation of natural justice.
- F- That the inaction of the respondents by not allowing/accepting the arrival report of the appellant and not releasing monthly salaries of the appellant w.e.f. 28.8.2013 till date is the utter violation of the judgment dated 28/04/2016 passed by the Honorable Supreme Court of Pakistan.
- G- That appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is therefore, most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may be accepted as prayed for.



EJAZ AFZAL KHAN, J:- These appeal with the leave of the Court have arisen out of the judgments dated 23.04.2012, 29.5.2012, 12.06.2012, 15.5.2012, 25.4.2013, 30.05.2013, 11.9.2013, 16.9.2013, 27.6.2013, 14.5.2014, 10.6.2014, 15.5.2014, 3.6.2014 and 02.04.2014 of the Lahore High Court, Lahore, Lahore High Court, Rawalpindi Bench, Rawalpindi and Peshawar High Court, Peshawar whereby they dismissed the intra Court appeals and Writ Petitions filed by the appellants. Civil Petition No. 3774 of 2015 has arisen out of the judgment dated 23.09.2015 of the High Court of Baluchistan, Quetta whereby the petition filed by the petitioner was dismissed in limine.

- 2. As the points urged in these appeals as well as petitions are identical, we dispose them of by this single judgment.
- 3. The learned AAG, Punjab appearing on behalf of the appellants contended that Skill Development Council was established under the National Training Ordinance, 1980 and the rules made thereunder, for awarding any certificate or diploma in the fields of art, craft, education or physics education; and that the Skill Development Council overstepped its limits by offering courses in the fields mentioned above and issuing certificates or diplomas therein. He next contended that since the certificates or diplomas issued by the skill development council do not conform to the course, curriculum or training required for art, craft, education or physical education, any appointment made on the basis of such certificate or diploma being against the provisions of the ordinance and rules made thereunder is liable to be annulled. Even the national training board the learned AAG maintained constituted under the ordinance cannot issue any directive to protect any such diploma or certificate when its role in the whole affairs is recommendatory. The learned AAG to support his contention also placed reliance on the letter No: SO(SE-IV)4-461/09 dated 16.08.2010 issued by the Secretary Schools Education Department, Govt: of Punjab.
- 4. The learned Additional A.G. KPK endorsed the arguments of learned AAG, Punjab.
- 5. Learned ASC appearing on behalf of respondents contended that where respondents have qualified diplomas or certificates under the aegis of Skill Development Council in the fields of art, craft, education or physical education, their appointments were rightly made on the basis of such diplomas and certificates in various department of Government, therefore, no exception could be taken to their appointments at this stage. Such appointments, the learned ASC contended, cannot be undone even under the doctrine of locus poenetentia, when not only decisive steps have been taken, but valuable rights have also accrued to the respondents. Learned ASC went on to argue that many respondents whose appointments have been made on the basis of diploma or certificates issued by the Skill Development Council, also possessed requisite qualifications at the time of their appointments, thereto, their appointments cannot be undone, even if it is assumed that the diplomas or certificates issued by the Council have no statutory sanction.

National Training Board, the learned A-AG maintained, constituted under the Ordinance cannot issue any directive to protect any such diplorna or certificate when its role in the whole affair is recommendatory. The learned AAG to support his contention also placed reliance on the letter No: SO(SE-IV)4-461/09 dated 16.08.2010 issued by the Secretary Schools Education Department, Govt. of Punjab.

- 4. The learned Additional A.G. KPK endorsed the arguments of learned AAG, Punjab.
