1) That the appellant is the bonafide residence of Dir lower was initially appointed as a Sepay in the Dir levies in 1999. The appellant has the qualification of Bachelor, therefore, the respondents was pleased to promote him to the post of Subedar Major BPS-16 on 12/08/2022 after rendering meritorious service in the department. (copy of the Notification is annexure A)

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- 2) That the Provincial Government decided to regulate the service structure of the Levies in PATA therefore, Under Article of 247 of Islamic Republic of Pakistan implemented service structure under PATA Levies Force Regulation.
- 3) That though no elaborative service structure exists therefore, the Provincial Government framed Service Rules for Federal Levies Force in PATA under Section 9 of the PATA (amended Rules 2013) Levies (copy of the Rules is annexure B)
- 4) That on 22/03/2021 the respondents amended the service rules (
 Amended 2013) wherein, specific coloum was introduced for the qualifications of Subedar Major BPS-16 to regulate the force through competent officials, therefore, qualifications of Intermediate was introduced through above Notification s, though, the majority personal of the force consists of illiterate and unqualified persons. (copy of the Notification dated 22/03/2021 is annexure C)
- 5) That on 21/10/2021 the respondents again brought illogical amendment wherein, the coloum of qualification was illegally omitted. (copy of the Notification dated 21/10/2021 is annexure D)
- 6) That the respondents were pleased to appoint all the Subedar Majors on the criteria seniority fitness from amongst subedar having intermediate qualifications in all District of Malakand Division. (copy of the minute is annexure E)
- 7) That appellant submitted representations before the respondent No.1 on 25/09/2023 to insert the relevant coloum of qualification against the post of Subedare Major BPS-16. (copy of the representation is annexure F)

That the appellant approaches this honorable Tribunal inter alia on the following amongst other grounds.

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GROUNDS

- i. That the actions and inaction is not warranted by law.
- ii. That the post of Subedar Major is the highest post of the levies needs to be run and operate through a competent and well qualified person, but, the respondents badly failed to take into consideration qualifications, which is against the rules and discipline.
- iii. That it is the demand of the day that every institution is run and managed by competent and qualified professional because, it involves correspondence especially the levies, but, unfortunately majority of the personals of the levies are illiterate, even don't know the ABC.
- iv. That the post of Subedar Major is sensitive one, because the entire levies of the district is under the control and supervision of the Subedar Major, but ironically no qualification was mentioned against the said post. so it suggests the intention of the respondents. Which is against the development of institutions.
- v. That the said omission of the respondents are against the law and constitution and the services to the society was badly affected being the law enforcing agencies.

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vi. That the amendment brought by the respondents is also take away the confirmed right of the appellant. Therefore, the said omission on the part of the respondents is based on malafidely and ulterior motives which is liable to be corrected.

vii. Those further grounds, with leave of this Honorable Court,
would be raised at the time of arguments before this
Honorable Court.

SERVICE RULES FOR FEDERAL LEVIES FORCE IN PATA

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 9 of the PATA Levies Force Regulation, 2012 the Provincial Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa is pleased to make the following rules, namely:-

- 1. Short title and commencement. (1) These rules may be called Provincially Administered Tribal Areas (PATA) Federal Levies Force Service (Amended) Rules, 2013.
 - (2) They shall come into force at once.
- 2. Definitions.-(1) in these Rules, unless the context otherwise require, the following expressions shall have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them, namely:-
 - (a) "Appointing Authority" means the appointing authority specified in rule-4;
 - (b) "Commandant" means Commandant of the Force, who shall be the Deputy Commissioner in their respective jurisdiction;
 - (c) "Deputy Commandant: (Operation)" means an Assistant Commissioner or any officer of the District designated as such by the provincial government who shall be Deputy Commandant (Operation) of the Force in PATA, to exercise in his respective jurisdiction such powers and perform such functions as may be prescribed; and who shall be responsible to the Commandant for operational matters of the Force in PATA.
 - (d) "Deputy Commandant (Administration)" means Deputy Commandant (Administration) of the Force, who shall be an officer of the provincial government or any officer of the District designated as such by the provincial government to exercise in his respective jurisdiction such powers and perform such functions as may be prescribed and who shall be responsible to the Commandant for administration and establishment matters of the Force in PATA.
 - (e) "Government" means the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa;
 - (f) "Home Department" means Provincial Home & Tribal Affairs Department:
 - (g) "Initial recruitment" means appointment made other than by promotion or by transfer;
 - (h) "Schedule" means the Schedule appended to these rules;

s; ()

- (i) "Selection or Promotion Committee" means a Committee for recruitment or as the case may be, promotion of Force personnel as notified by the Government;
- (j) "Service" means the levies service;



- (2) The expression used but not defined herein shall have the same meanings as are assigned to them under the PATA Levies Force Regulation 2012.
- 3. Composition and eligibility of the Force.- (1) The Force shall comprise of the posts specified ir Schedule-I and such other posts as may be determined by the Government from time to time.
- (2) Recruitment to the Force shall be made in accordance with the requirement specified in Schedule-I. No person shall be appointed unless he fulfills the following conditions:-
 - (a) The candidate shall be a citizen of Pakistan and bonafide resident of the respective district of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
 - (b) The candidate shall be, in good mental and bodily health and free from physic defect, which likely to interfere in the efficient discharge of his duties.
 - (c) Medical Superintendent of the respective district headquarter hospital shall iss a certificate of medical fitness to the candidate.

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- (d) Recruitment to all ranks of the Force shall be made from amongst those personal having a minimum height of bear and chest measurement of specific with age of not less than eighteen years and not more than twenty-five years on the lighteen of submission of application;
- (e) No person (except those who are already in Government Service) shall appointed to the Force unless he produces a certificate of character from Principal of Academic Institution last attended or a certificate of character if two gazetted officers from respective districts, not being his relative and who well acquainted with his character; and
- (f) No person who is married to foreign national shall be eligible for appointme the Force, unless allowed by the Government, in writing.
- 4. Appointing Authority.- (1) Commandant shall be the appointing authority for initial recruitmen promotion up to the rank of Subedar. Whereas promotion to the rank of Subedar Major and above authority shall rests with the provincial government.
- (2) Appointment to the post shall be made in accordance with the provisions contain Schedule-I read with Rule-3 of these rules.
- (3) Appointment either through initial recruitment or by promotion shall be made through constituted Selection/promotion Committees.

Provided that in case of raising of force in a new district, the Commandant shall have the autorecruit ex-servicemen above the rank of sepoy on contract basis for a period of one year extendable further period of one year but not exceeding three years in total, with prior approval of the government

It is further provided that the ex-serviceman so appointed on contract shall not be more that five years of age.

5. Probation.-Persons appointed to posts by initial recruitment, promotion or transfer shall rem probation for a period of one year extendable by a further period of one year. If no order is issued expiry of the first year of probation period, the period of probation shall be deemed to have been exfor further one year. If no order is issued on the completion of extended period, the probation shall be deemed to have been terminated.



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- (i) "Selection or Promotion Committee" means a Committee for recruitment or as the case may be, promotion of Force personnel as notified by the Government;
- (j) "Service" means the levies service:
- (2) The expression used but not defined herein shall have the same meanings as are assigned to them under the PATA Levies Force Regulation 2012.
- 3. Composition and eligibility of the Force. (1) The Force shall comprise of the posts specified in Schedule-I and such other posts as may be determined by the Government from time to time.
- (2) Recruitment to the Force shall be made in accordance with the requirement specified in Schedule-i. No person shall be appointed unless he fulfills the following conditions:-
 - (a) The candidate shall be a citizen of Pakistan and bonafide resident of the respective district of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
 - (b) The candidate shall be, in good mental and bodily health and free from physical defect, which likely to interfere in the efficient discharge of his duties.

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Medical Superintendent of the respective district headquarter hospitel shall issue a certificate of medical-fitness to the candidate.

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- Recruitment to all ranks of the Force shall be made from amongst those persons having a minimum height of [25] and chest measurement of [25] with an age of not less than eighteen years and not more than twenty-five years on the last date of submission of application;
- (e) No person (except those who are already in Government Service) shall be appointed to the Force unless he produces a certificate of character from the Principal of Academic Institution last attended or a certificate of character from two gazetted officers from respective districts, not being his relative and who are well acquainted with his character; and
- (f) No person who is married to foreign national shall be eligible for appointment in the Force, unless allowed by the Government, in writing.
- 4. Appointing Authority.- (1) Commandant shall be the appointing authority for initial recruitment and promotion up to the rank of Subedar. Whereas promotion to the rank of Subedar Major and above, the authority shall rests with the provincial government.
- (2) Appointment to the post shall be made in accordance with the provisions contained in Schedule-I read with Rule-3 of these rules.
- (3) Appointment either through initial recruitment or by promotion shall be made through duly constituted Selection/promotion Committees.

Provided that in case of raising of force in a new district, the Commandant shall have the authority to recruit ex-servicemen above the rank of sepoy on contract basis for a period of one year extendable for a further period of one year but not exceeding three years in total, with prior approval of the government.

It is further provided that the ex-serviceman so appointed on contract shall not be more than forty five years of age.

5. Probation.-Persons appointed to posts by initial recruitment, promotion or transfer shall remain on probation for a period of one year extendable by a further period of one year. If no order is issued on the expiry of the first year of probation period, the period of probation shall be deemed to have been extended for further one year. If no order is issued on the completion of extended period, the probation shall be deemed to have been terminated.

- Training. (1) All newly recruited personnel of the Force shall undergo six months pre-service training before being assigned duties of the rank for which they selected. Initially, the Appointing Authority shall arrange for appropriate training till a proper Levies Training Center is established.
- (2) The pre-service training mentioned in sub-rule (1) may contain training on basic laws investigation techniques, mob control, basic intelligence, arrest and detention procedure, jail duties, driff weapons training, field craft, bomb disposal, counter assault, traffic control, raids, watch & ward etc. Proper training syllabus and modules shall be developed through mutual consultation with local law enforcing agencies by the Home Department.
- 7. Resignation.-No member of the Force shall resign before the expiry of the first three months of the recruitment or he shall deposit an amount equal to his three months pay in lieu of his three months essential service.
- 8. Seniority and promotion.— (1) Promotion shall be strictly on seniority cum fitness basis as me as on the required length of service as specified in Schedule-i.
- (2) The service of a personnel by initial recruitment, promotion or transfer may be dispense with or reverted if, in the opinion of the competent authority his work and conduct is not satisfactory during probation period or due to abolishment of posts, as the case may be.

Provided that in case of dispensing with their service or reversion the concerned authority sha record cogent reasons for such action in writing.

- (3) The seniority list of the Force shall be maintained at district level. Commandant shall responsible for maintaining the seniority list of the force and shall notify annually.
- 9. Transfer during service. Every member of the service shall be liable to serve anywhere within PA: with the prior approval of the Commissioner Malakand Division.
- 10. Punishment. –After satisfying himself regarding punishable acts (as referred in Schedule-through a charge duly framed in writing, necessary punishments specified in Schedule-IV may be award by the respective authority.

Provided that punishment so awarded shall be duly incorporated in service rolls / service doss accordingly.

- 11. Appeal. If any personnel of the force is aggreeved by any order issued under these rules, with thirty days of communication to him of such order, may prefer an appeal to the competent authority.
- Provided that no appeal shall lie against the punishments specified at S.No. (1) and (2) Schedule-IV.
- 12. Awards and commendations. -(1) Force personnel may be given special award and commendation certificate for devotion to duty, demonstration of gallantry and such achievement in the performance duty, in the manners as prescribed by the Commandant, and shall be made part of the service rolls. I service service rolls. I service rolls.
- (2). Force personnel, if embraces martyrdom in the discharge of his duty, will be given pro-Guard of Honour at the time of burlai.
- 13. Service Record. Proper service rolls / service dossiers of all Force Personnel shall be maintain in Levy Office of each district. Annual reports of all Havaldars and Junior Commissioned Officers (ICOs): also be maintained for the purpose of promotion.

- 9. Transfer during service. Every member of the Service shall be liable to serve anywhere within PATA with the prior approval of the Commissioner Malakand Olvision.
- 10. Punishment. -After satisfying himself regarding punishable acts (as referred in Schedule-II) through a charge duly framed in writing, necessary punishments specified in Schedule-IV may be awarded by the respective authority.

Provided that punishment so awarded shall be duly incorporated in service rolls / service dossler accordingly.

11. Appeal. – If any personnel of the force is aggrieved by any order issued under these rules, within thirty days of communication to him of such order, may prefer an appeal to the competent authority.

Provided that no appeal shall lie against the punishments specified at S.No. (1) and (2) of Schedule-IV.

- 12. Awards and commandations.—(1) Force personnel may be given special award and commandation certificate for devotion to duty, demonstration of gallantry and such achievement in the performance of duty, in the manners as prescribed by the Commandant, and shall be made part of the service rolls / service dossier.
- (2). Force personnel, if embraces martyrdom in the discharge of his duty, will be given proper Guard of Honour at the time of burial.
- 13. Service Record. -Proper service rolls / service dossiers of all Force Personnel shall be maintained in Levy Office of each district. Annual reports of all Havalders and Junior Commissioned Officers (JCOs) will also be maintained for the purpose of promotion.
- 14. Uniform.-The levy personal shall attire black shalwar gamees with brown chappil, white socks, black barrette cap and black belt whereas the JCOs will wear brown belt during duty hours.
- 15. Leave. (1) Leave may be granted depending on the exigencies and at the discretion of the Commandant. All leave of ten days or above, will be considered as long leave and shall be granted on the recommendations of Subedar Major by the Commandant.

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Casual leave may be allowed upto three days by Subedar Major. Casual leave up to nin recommendation of the concerned JCO.

- 16. Salary.-The Force personnel shall be entitled to receive pay and allowances as per their pay scale: notified by the Federal Government from time to time.
- 17. Retirement.-All Levy personnel shall retire as per Schedule-III and no extension in service beyond retirement shall be granted.
- 18. Conduct.-The conduct of Force personnel shall be regulated by these rules or instructions issued by Government from time to time.
- 19. Gratuity and pension.-All Force personnel will be entitled to pension as per prevailing Federal
- 20. Compensation.- (1) The family of Force personnel shall be granted death compensation in case the Force Personnel embraces martyrdom during discharge of his duty as per rates prescribed by the Federal Government.
- (2) Force personnel shall be granted compensation in case of sustaining fatal injury or injuries during the discharge of his duty. If he is declared incapacitated for further services due to such fatality, he shall be entitled to gratuity and pension as per Federal Government Rules.
- personnel. 5% quota shall be reserved for sons and wards of martyred in Initial recruitment of Force

Provided that in case of permanently incapacitated personnel of the force during the course of duty, preference shall be given to the sons and wards of such incapacitated Force Personnel in general

In case of establishment of Levies Station within their jurisdiction shall require prior approval of the government.
- (2) There shall be levy line in each district, which shall have all necessary facilities including parade ground, barracks, quarter guards, koth/armoury etc.
- —> (3) Duty Register showing the duties assigned to each individual on day-to-day basis shall be maintained in each levy post /Levy Station/Levy Lines by a levy Muharir.
- (4) Naib Subedar shall be responsible for carrying out the work assigned to Force personnel whose duties shall be entered in advance in the duty register.
- (5) Registers including *roznamchas* as prescribed by the Commandant shall be maintained in every levy post/Station/Lines.
- (6) Commandant, Deputy Commandant or any other officer of the District Administration shall in the course of their tours in their jurisdiction, may inspect duty register and roznamchas of Levy posts/stations and satisfy themselves that Force Personnel are carrying out their assigned cuties. A note regarding absence from the post or from the place of duty of any Force personnel without leave, shall invariably be recorded by inspecting offices in the jurisdiction.

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

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- Casual leave may be allowed upto three days by Subedar Major. Casual leave up to nine days may be granted by the Deputy Commandant (to be notified by the Commandant) on the recommendation of the concerned JCO.

Out of the above, Subedar appear at serial 07 is from provincial levy and serving in Dir Lower since his appointment, i.e. 22/11/1999, as reflected in the working paper. The incumbent DC/ Commandant submitted fresh working paper and excluded serial 07 from the list, as he was transferred vide DC Office letter No.882 dated 06/07/2022. He submitted appeal for cancellation of his transfer in light of letter no. 1780 dated 09/06/2005. Resultantly, the competent authority withdrawn his transfer order.

No eligible candidate found there as per criteria except serial 07. The DC/ Commandant has recommended serial 04 above and his qualification was reflected as FA, however through another letter, he conveyed that he has mistakenly written F.A.

Eligibility criteria for promotion to the post of Subedar Major is provided in PATA Levies Force Service (Amended) Rules, which is to be filled by 100% promotion (F/C) and is reproduced as below:

Cases for promotion of each Subedar were discussed in detail as follows:

- 1. Subedars appears at serial 01-06 (Federal), are all eligible for promotion by keeping in view their service length, but their educational qualification does not fulfill the eligibility criteria, i.e. none of them have intermediate as educational qualification which is required under the rules.
- 2. The Committee, therefore, found serial 07 Subedar Shahab Ud Din of Provincial Levies eligible for promotion to the post of Subedar Major as per laid down criteria mentioned above, as his transfer order is already withdrawn by this department and he has B.A as educational qualification and serving in Dir Lower since his appointment as reflected in the working paper provided by the Deputy Commissioner/ Commandant Levies Dir Lower.

Decision:

The Departmental Promotion Committee recommends Subedar Shahab Ud Din at serial 07 above for promotion to the rank of Subedar Major Dir Lower Levies.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks from and to the Chair.
