Preliminary objections:

- i. That the appellant has no cause of action to file the instant services appear. $\frac{10-1-24}{2}$
- ii. The appeal in hand is not maintainable in its present form.
- iii. That the appeal is a mis-joinder/non-joinder of unnecessary and necessary parties.

 - v. That the appeal is based on misrepresentation of facts, the appellant is estopped by his conduct to file the appeal.
- vi. That the appellant has availed all his back benefits, increments, salaries, etc.
- vii. That the appellant has not come to the court with clean hands.

- The appellant is not an aggrieved party under Section 8 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Tourism Act 2019, under which the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Culture and Tourism Authority has been established. The Directorate of Culture and Directorate of Tourists Services are no longer in existence and their functions were merged into the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Culture and Tourism Authority.

According to the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Tourism Act 2019, the Secretary Tourism Department issued a certificate that the Authority has developed the requisite capacity to take over the functions of the Directorate of Tourists Services vide Notification dated 25th July 2022 (Annex-B). The functions of the Directorate of Tourists Services were transferred to the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Culture and Tourism Authority vide notification dated 17th November 2022 (Annex-C). The Provincial Cabinet in its meeting held on 09.08.2023 approved the creation of a surplus pool for the employees of the Directorate of Tourist Services and Directorate of Culture (Annex-D).

Subsequently, a surplus pool was created and all the employees of the directorate of Tourists services were placed in the surplus pool (Annex-E). Therefore for all intents and purposes, the employees of the erstwhile directorate of tourist services and directorates of culture are no longer the employees of the Culture, Tourism, Archaeology and Museum department. Hence, the respondents are not legally in a position to convene a meeting of DPC for the promotion of the appellant.

- 6. Incorrect. The appellant was an employee of the directorate of tourist services which is no longer in existence after the approval of the provincial cabinet in its meeting held on 24.06.2023. All of the posts in the directorate of Tourist services were abolished by the finance department on 07.09.2023(Annex-F). All the employees of the Directorate of Culture and Directorate of Tourist Services were declared as surplus for further adjustment under the surplus pool policy, 2001 by the establishment department notification dated 24.10.2023 (Annex-G).
- 7. Incorrect. The appellant was appointed as sub-inspector on 27.01.2020. The departmental Promotion Committee meeting was held on 07.11.2022, the promotion case of the appellant was not on the agenda as the appellant had not completed the required length of three years of service. (Annex-H).
- 8. No comments. Pertains to the record.
- Incorrect. Peshawar High Court dismissed the writ petition No.2772-P/2022 on the 9. ground that on 30-09-2019, the Provincial Assembly of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa passed the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Tourism Act, 2019. The aim and purpose of the act is to provide a legal framework to promote Tourism and Culture in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. The Act provides for the establishment of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Culture and Tourism Authority under section 06 of the Act and under section 08 sub-section (i) (b) the Directorates shall cease to be the attached Directorates of the department and shall be merged into the authority. Section 08(iv) of the act has provided for the creation of a Surplus pool for the employees of DTS. The honorable court in its judgment has further stated that" now the brief question as to whether a department which is no more in existence and merged into an authority while its employees are kept in the surplus pool who would be in the surplus pool, and their fate either absorption, retention or utilization has not so far decided, how come the respondents would convene a meeting of the departmental Selection or promotion committee for their promotion for the simple reason that on which post and in which department they will be given promotion". The honourable Court has further decided that their right of promotion shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations and terms and conditions of the cadres into which they are absorbed (Annex-I).

- The appellant endorses his non-promotion on the grounds of the non-completion of the length of service on the date of DPC and narrates that he has now completed the required length of service and is eligible to be promoted to BS-16.

These employees shall continue to enjoy all the benefits currently admissible to them and shall be entitled to receive their salaries and other benefits as if they had continued work against the existing cadre or post. The services of such employees shall either"
 - Be utilized by the government in such offices as controlled by the government (i) under such terms and conditions as decided by the government.
 - (ii) Absorb the services of the employees of the directorates at the discretion of government in various government departments, and in such case, the right of promotion shall be in accordance with rules and regulations and terms and conditions of the cadres into which they are absorbed.

- (a) Where an appeal, review or representation to a departmental authority is provided under the [Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] Civil Servants Act, 1973, or any rules against any such order, no appeal shall lie to a Tribunal unless the aggrieved civil servant has preferred an appeal or application for review or representation to such departmental authority and a period of ninety days has elapsed from the date on which such appeal, application or representation was preferred;²
- (b) no appeal shall lie to a Tribunal against an order or decision of a departmental authority determining-
 - (i) the fitness or otherwise of a person to be appointed to or hold a particular post or to be promoted to a higher post or grade :or
 - (ii) the quantum of departmental punishment or penalty imposed on a civil servant as a result of a departmental inquiry, except where the penalty imposed is dismissal from service, removal from service or compulsory retirement ³[; and].

Explanation.—In this section, "departmental authority" means any authority other than a Tribunal which is competent to make an order in respect of any of the terms and conditions of service of civil servants.
