- 5. That on 28.11.2011, appellant submitted application before Secretary, Transport Department, KP, Peshawar to adjust him in RTA, Bannu as Naib Qasid. (Copy as annex "F")
- 6. That by not resolving the matter, appellant filed Civil Suit before the Court of Senior Civil Judge, Bannu on 20.09.2013 to adjust him as such in RTA, being his parent office. (Copy as annex "G")
- 7. That on 09.10.2013, respondents submitted application to the court under O-7, R-11 for return of the suit to appellant which was accepted vide order dated 30.01.2014. (Copies as annex "H" & "I")

- c. That by posting/adjusting appellant as such in any department/authority does not mean change of his previous position.
- d. That Regional Transport Authority was later on converted into District Transport Authority but subsequently its position was restored to RTA, so the same made no difference.
- e. That appellant was misguided by the then Counsel for invoking jurisdiction of Civil Courts. Yet the same was too in good faith.
- f. That at present, appellant is performing his duties in Union Council, Kala Khel, Bannu as Naib Qasid but this hierarchy bore no rules for further promotion to the next higher grad/post.
- g. That R. No. 4 was appointed on the recommendation of local MPA without advertising the said post and to adhere to legal course, so the same has no legal effect as the subject matter was pending disposal, being disputed post amongst the appellant and the department, so during pendency, order of appointment dated 06.03.2015 was not legally required.
- h. That by not adjusting/posting appellant permanently in RTA, being parent department, the action of respondents is based on erior motive.

PRAYER;

ON ACCEPTANCE OF THIS APPEAL, THE ORDER OF RETURN OF PLAINT UNDER ORDER 7 RULE 10 OF THE CPC DATED 30-1-2014 BY THE LEARNED CIVIL JUDGE-IX, BANNU MAY VERY GRACIOUSLY BE SET ASIDE BEING MIS COCEIVED AND NOT IN ACCORDANCE WITH LAW AS THE CIVIL COURT HAS GOT JURISDICTION TO ENTERTAIN THE APPELLANT'S CASE/PLAINT AND THEREBY DIRECTING THE LEARNED TRIAL COURT TO ADJUDICATE UPON THE APPELLANT'S CASE STRICTLY ON MERIT AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH LAW.

BRIEF FACTS

Respectfully sheweth:

- i) That the appellant instituted a Civil suit No.143/1 on 21-9-2013 in the Court of Senior Civil Judge, Bannu which was entrusted to the court of learned Civil Judge-IX, Bannu, wherein the defendants instead of submitting their written statement straight away moved an application under Order 7 rule 10 of the CPC for return of the plaint whereupon, on 30-01 3014, the learned trial court returned the original plaint appellant/plaintiff with an observation " that the appellant is an employee of the Government of Pakistan and in case of any matter which pertains to the service of a Government official, there is a proper forum constituted for this purpose, i.e the Service tribunal and the jurisdiction of Civil Court is barred. (Copy of order dated 30-01-2014 is annexed herewith).
- 2) Feeling aggrieved of the same, the appellant approaches this Honourable court for indulging in the matter, inter alia on the following grounds:-.

GROUNDS

- I) That the very order of the learned trial court by returning the plaint to the plaintiff/appellant with the direction to knock at the door of Service Tribunal is against law, facts, service tribunal Act, 1974, hence un-tenable.
- II) That the Section-4 of Service Tribunal Act, 1974 is very much clear in this respect, wherein it

is mentioned that if any term and condition of the existing service is violated, then in such case, Service tribunal has got jurisdiction, however, in the instant case, no term and condition pertaining to existing service of appellant, is violated but the same are still intact and he seeks appointment/adjustment on other budgetary post, so Service tribunal cannot step in such like matters.

- III) That the petitioner has been condemned unheard as the matter has not been adjudicated upon by the learned trial court in accordance with law and the order passed by the learned trial court is the result of mis reading and non-reading of factual aspect of the appellant's case.
 - IV) That the learned trial court has not applied its judicial mind while passing the impugned order.
 - V) That the learned trial court has not exercised jurisdiction vested in it under the law, rather the same has been exercised with material irregularity and illegality.
 - VI) That the Appellant seeks permission to rely and advance additional grounds at the time of hearing of instant Civil appeal.

It is, therefore, humbly prayed that on acceptance of the instant Appeal, the order of return of plaint dated 30-1-2014 under Order 7 rule 10 of the CPC by the learned Civil judge-IX, Bannu may very graciously be set aside being mis conceived and not in accordance with law as the Civil court has got jurisdiction to entertain the appellant's case/plaint and thereby directing the learned trial court to adjudicate upon the appellant's case strictly on merit and in accordance with law.

This appeal has been preferred against order dated 30-01-2014, passed by learned Civil Judge-IX, Bannu, vide which plaint of the appellant was returned to him under Order VII, Rule 10 C.P.C.

Brief facts of the case, as per record, are that, on 21-09-2013, the appellant, Minhajuddin, filed a civil suit against the respondents (Government of Kyber Pakhtunkhwa & 3 others) seeking a decree for declaration and permanent prohibitory and mandatory injunction, In his plaint, it was alleged by the appellant/plaintiff with mad his 52.11

office of Commissioner Bannu, and, presently, is performing his

duty as 'Naib-Qadid' in the office of Regional Transport Authority, as per order of the Commission Bannu, dated 20-02-2009 and since posts of 'Naib-Qasid' are vacant in the office of R.T.A, therefore, he is entitled to be appointed on the same but the respondents are bent upon to appoint someone from another district. The respondents/defendants, in response, moved an application under Order VII, Rule 10 C.P.C seeking return of his plaint to the plaintiff for want of jurisdiction. The learned Civil Judge-IX, after hearing both the parties, accepted the said application and returned his plaint to the appellant/plaintiff to present the same before proper forum, i.e. The Service Tribunal. Aggrieved, thereby, the plaintiff has filed the appeal in hand.

- 3. I have already heard arguments of learned Counsel for the parties and, with their valuable assistance, have gone through the record.
 - Perusal of record, particularly the plaint, shows that the same is not only vague but relates to the terms and conditions of a civil servant. In Para 7 of his plaint, the plaintiff says that he is, presently, performing his duty as 'Naib-Qasid' in the office of R.T.A but, on the other hand, seeks appointment on the same post in the office of R.T.A which creates ambiguity regarding the relief sought. Similarly, a bare perusal of his plaint clearly shows that the same is regarding the terms and conditions of service as he,

admittedly, is serving as 'Naib-Qasid' in the office of R.T.A. and, as per provisions of sub-section (2) of section 3 of the North-West Frontier Province Service Tribunal Act (I of 1974), a Tribunal, constituted under the said Act, shall have exclusive jurisdiction in respect of matters relating to the terms and conditions of service of civil servants, therefore, civil courts have got no jurisdiction to entertain any suit relating to the terms and conditions of a civil servant. The learned Trial Court, thus, has rightly returned plaint of the appellant/plaintiff to him for presenting the same before the said forum, vide its order impugned herein.

The impugned order, therefore, needs no interference and is kept maintained by dismissing the appeal in hand. Parties are, however, left to bear their own costs.

The provision of Article 212(2) of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 bars the jurisdiction of other Courts, which read as:

anything hereinbefore contained, where any Administrative Court or Tribunal is established under clause (1) no other Court shall grant an injunction, make any order or entertain any proceedings in respect of any matter to which the jurisdiction of such administrative Court to Tribunal extends and all proceedings in respect of any such matter which may be pending before such other Court

XXXXER

MANUER was High Court, Bannu Bench immediately before the establishment
of the Administrative Court or
Tribunal other than an appeal
pending before the Supreme Court
shall abate on such establishment.

In the sub article ibid express bar has been imposed that all other Courts have no jurisdiction to entertain any proceedings in case of service tribunal established for the purpose, hence, the learned civil Court as well as appellate Court has rightly returned the plaint of petitioner under Order VII Rule 10 CPC, for which no exception can be taken.

5. In view of above, this petition sands dismissed in limine, however, the petitioner is at liberty to seek redressal of his grievances — the competent Court/tribunal.

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


