

ORDER

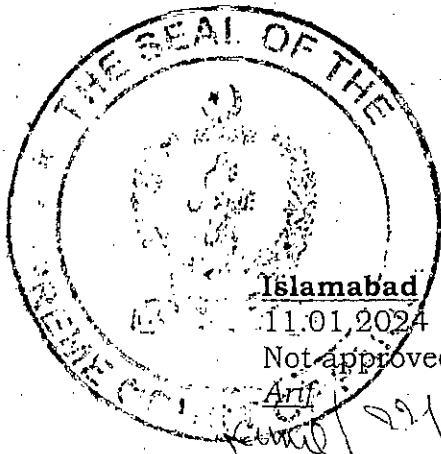
