PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS: -

1. That the instant Appeal as before the court is not entertainable on the grounds that neither any reference to his seniority position in the then seniority as notified on 12/12/2000 has been expressed on which the other Appellant were granted BS-16, Senior Scale nor annexed that one with the Appeal, he failed to give any reference of his juniors who are placed/granted the Senior Scale BS-16.
2. That the Appellant has never challenged any orders in which his right had been ignored at any time in the past.
3. That the Appeal is also time barred.
4. That the Appellant has got no cause of action or locus standi.
5. That the Appellant is estopped by his own conduct to file the instant appeal.
6. That the Appeal is liable to rejection on the grounds of non-joinder and mis-joinder of necessary parties. The grant of Senior Scale rests with the

Departmental Upgradation Committee according to the Government rules, which he has not made parties.

INTRODUCTORY: -

There is no objection so far the question of law, Apex Supreme Court orders and the rules governing to this affect, grant of Senior Scale Selection Grade BPS-16 to those Diploma holders Sub Engineers who passed "B" Grade Examination and having 10-Years' Service as such are/were entitled to the BPS-16 on the share of 25% of the total Post of Diploma Sub Engineers as per the Finance Department Circular letter No.FD(SR-I)2-25/72-vol-II, dated 19/12/1975 (**Annexed-I**) and in sequence thereof the C&W Department notified amendments in the existing Appointment/Recruitment Rules, 1979 at Sl.No.5 in column-2 and column-6 vide Notification No. SOE/C&W/23-5/73/592, dated 28-01-1979 (**Annexed-II**).

ON FACTS: -

3. The same as expressed in paras, above.

5. Correct to the extent that some 51-52 numbers of Sub Engineers filed the case before the Service Tribunal. Those who were fulfilling the criteria of 10-years service as such (Sub Engineers) and passed the Departmental "B" Grade Examination were allowed Senior Scale BPS-16, while approximately 07 Nos of the litigants who though by length of their service completed 10-years Service, having not passed the ibid "B" Grade Examination have not been allowed the Senior Scale BPS-16, which's detail is (**Annexed-III**).
6. Correct to the extent that those who were fulfilling the requisite conditions as per the rules and as held by the Service Tribunal in his Judgment dated 02/03/2016, passed in Service Appeal No.1330/2010 along with connected appeal (51- in Nos) have been awarded the Senior Scale

Selection Grade-BPS-16, vide Notification No. SOE/C&WD/4-2/2018, dated 30/04/2018. Since placed with the appeal.

7. There was no force in the Departmental Appeal, hence filed because the Appellant had not persuaded his case in any forum or Court of Law in the past.

8. No Comments.

ON GROUNDS: -

A. Actually those who litigated their cases in the Service Tribunal and fulfilling the criteria, had been granted Senior Scale BPS-16 w.e.f. 04/09/2003, the date their juniors have been allowed the BPS-16 by virtue of shares i.e. 25% of the Posts of diploma holders Sub Engineers.

B. As expressed in above paras of reply, the appellant has not been allowed BPS-16 Senior Scale due to non-litigation of his case in the Court of Law.

C. The same as in Para-A & B, above.

D. No doubt the appellant has passed "B" Grade Exam in 1996 and Professional Examination in 2006 which made him eligible to the Post of Sub Divisional Officer BPS-17 and he is now enjoying the requisite privileges of the Post of Sub Divisional Officer, copy of his promotion as Sub Divisional Officer BPS-17 as **(Annexed-IV)**.

the prayed Senior Scale Selection Grade BPS-16 w.e.f. 04/09/2003, therefore the present Service Appeal may please be dismissed with cost.



 - iii. 25% of the total posts of Diploma Engineers shall be placed in Grade-16. These posts shall be filled on the basis of seniority-own fitness and ~~seniority-own-fitness~~ subject to 10 years' service and passing of the prescribed departmental examinations.

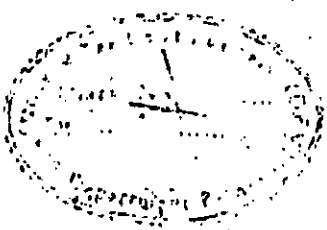
