

 That appellant has degree of Master of Library and Information Science in his credit, passed in 2nd division. (Copy as annex "A")

- 2. That on 30.05.1994, appellant was appointed as Librarian in BPS-16 at S.No.20 on the recommendation of the then NWFP, Public Service Commission, Peshawar. (Copy as annex "B")
 - 3. That appeal was filed by Bibi Musrat, Shahid Ali, Nasir Khan, etc. before this hon'ble Tribunal for the grant/upgradation of the post of Librarian from BPS-16 to BPS-17 on regular basis from the date having acquired their higher qualifications i.e. Master's Degree in the discipline of Library Science.
 - 4. That after completion of the requisite formalities, the hon'ble Tribunal was pleased to dismiss their appeals vide judgment dated 12.08.2003. Feeling aggrieved of the aforesaid judgment of the hon'ble Tribunal, the aforesaid appellants filed Civil Petition for Leave to Appeal (CPLA) before the August Supreme Court of Pakistan which were allowed vide judgment dated 22.02.2010.

The concluding para reads as under:-

"In view of judgments cited above favoring the present appellants and because of Notification of 1995, if not followed, would discriminate the present appellants. These appeals are, therefore, allowed. The judgment of the NWFP Service Tribunal, Peshawar is set aside and the respondents are directed to grant BPS-17 to the appellants with effect from the date of their Master's Degree acquiring higher qualifications,". (Copy as annex "C")

5. That on smelling of the benefits of co-employees namely Nasir Khan and Shahid Ali at S.No.9 & 11 of the appointment order dated 30.05.1994, appellant also filed

representation before R.No.2 on 20.04.2012 for award of BPS-17 from the date of his appointment which was rejected on 29.06.2012. (Copies as annex "D & E")

Hence this appeal, inter alia, on the following grounds:-

GROUNDS:-

(A)

- a. That admittedly, appellant has Master's Degree in his credit.
- b. That as per the judgment of the apex Supreme Court of Pakistan, appellant is entitled for grant of BPS-17 with effect from acquiring of the Master's Degree or from the date of his appointment, which ever is earlier for all benefits.
- c. That similarly and equally placed employees shall be treated similarly and equally and no discrimination is required for grant of any benefit to any class.
- d. That in the judgments, reported in "1996 SCMR 1185(c), 2009 SCMR 1 and 2010 SCMR 421," it was held that relief given to one class shall be extended to other class, who are in equal footing in order to avoid discrimination because it is the demand of good governance of law and justice.
- e. That in the judgment dated 22.02.2010 of the August Supreme Court of Pakistan benefits of BPS-17 to M/s Nasir Khan and Shahid Ali were given. The aforesaid incumbents are at S.No.9 & 11 of the order of appointment dated 30.05.1994. The name of appellant also figures in the aforesaid order of appointment but he was not benefited.
- f. That decision made in order/letter dated 05.01.2012 is not on legal and sound footing as the Notification mentioned therein is of no avail to the respondents. The viries of the same has been discussed in the

aforesaid judgment. No benefit of the same was extended to the department, rather to appellants.

- g. That by now, appellant has been awarded BPS-17.
- h. That refusal of respondents by not granting benefits of BPS-17 to appellant on acquiring of higher qualifications of Master's Degree is based on malafide and discrimination.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of appeal, order dated 29.06.2012 of the respondents be set aside and appellant be awarded benefits of BPS-17 from the date of appointment or acquiring of the Master Degree which ever is earlier, with such other relief as may be deem proper and just in circumstances of the case.

JUDGMENT

Tariq Parvez J: For the reasons that similar question of law and almost similar facts are involved in three connected appeals, therefore these are disposed of through this single judgment.

2. Short facts of the case are that the appellants herein are serving a librarian in Education Department. In the case of Bibi Mussarat, she was last serving as Librarian in Government Degree College for Women, Mandian,

Abbottabad while the appellant Shahid Ali as Librarian in Government Higher Secondary School, Mardan and so is the case of Nasir Khan appellant.

They claim to be granted grade BPS-17 on regular basis from the date they have acquired higher qualifications i.e. Master's Degree in the discipline of Library Sciences.

- The appellants on their respective ends having approached the departmental hierarchy by making various representations/appeals were finally constrained to knock at the door of the NWFP Service Tribunal, Peshawar but their such approach for seeking relief proved abortive, they, therefore filed three separate petitions before this Court.
- All the three petitions of the appellants were heard on 28.06.2006 and with the leave to appeal granted by the Court, petitions were converted into appeals, inter=alia, on the ground to consider effect of two judgments delivered by this Court, whether they were in conflict with each other, judgments referred to in the leave granting order are **Government of NWFP**etc. v. Muhammad Aslam Khan (C.A. No. 172 of 1998) decided on 16.10.2002 and Government of NWFP etc. v. Gul Aslam and others (C.Ps. No.52-P of 1003) decided on 12.03.2003 and against the above referred judgments another case of **Deputy Director Technical Education**, Peshawar v. Muhammad Ikram and others (CP Nos.395-P to 398-P, 415-P to 419-P of 2001).

In the former two judgments relief of granting grade BPS-17 on the basis of higher qualifications was given to the appellants therein whereas relief were denied in the later judgment.

b. From the perusal of the judgment referred to above as were read out and cited before us, the latter judgment of this Court has referred to notification dated 04.08.1993 of the Finance Department of the Government of NWFP, Peshawar where the provincial Government had held that post of Librarian in grade BPA-16 in junior scale and BPS-17 in senior scale are separate posts under the relevant recruitment rules and the initial recruitment to be made through the Public Service Commission, because there is no provision in the rules for granting higher pay scale on the basis of acquiring higher education i.e. Master's Degree. It was therefore, that this Court refused to grant prayer for upgradation of Librarian from BPS-16 to 17 on the ground of procuring higher qualification.

- 6. The former two judgments, this Court had passed inot the sevice, principle of discrimination on the ground that the Librarian who was working in the Colleges and had acquired higher qualifications were given grad BPS-17 but those who were working in the Schools were denied grant of grade BPS-17 despite having acquired Master's Degree. This court concluded that whether performing functions in a College or in a School but as Librarian and when both the incumbents are having acquired higher Master's Degree they are to be considered at par with each other and refusal on the ground that grade BPS-17 can only be given to Librarian working in the Colleges was an act of discrimination based on no logic and was therefore, unreasonable.
- Today, learned counsel appearing for the appellants als produced before us a copy of notification dated 20.06.1995 of Government of NWFP, Peshawar Education Department, where the Governor of the province was pleased to accord sanction as a special case to the upgradation of 113 posts of Librarian from BPS-16 to BPS-17 to persons whose names appeared in the annexure to the notification of 1995.

There is no bar under the Rules rather there appears to be consistent practice which was applied in fovour of Librarian in the past and they were given the higher grade from BPS-16 to BPS-17 on acquiring Master's Degree in the Library Sciences including notification dated 20.06.1995, but denial by the Government and not accepted by NWFP Service Tribunal, Peshawar, would be against the rules of discrimination amongst equals and similarly placed employees.

8. An impression taken from the leave granting order that the two judgments fo this Court are at variance would be divided of force because in the case of **Government of NWFP vs. Muhammad Ikram and others** (supra) reliance was placed on notification of year 1993 which is itself does not contain any statutory backing but a policy or desire. Subsequently in the year 1995 despite notification of 1993 the Government of NWFP had upgraded 113 posts of Librarian, from BPS-16 to BPS-17 the denial to the present appellants the grant fo grade BPS-17 would be a case of discrimination and therefore, their cases would squarely fall in the category of cases as were decided by this Court in Civil Appeal No.172 of 1998 and Civil Petitions No. 52-P to 58-P of 2003 and not the case of **Deputy Director Technical Education** (supra).

Very recently in Civil Petitions No. 491-P to 500-P of 2006, decided on 3.4.2009 by this Court and relying on the judgment passed in Civil Petitions No. 52-P/2003 etc. (supra) similar view was maintained and in addition, it was ruled that the appellants therein will be entitled to grade BPS-17 not with immediate effect but form the date they acquired higher qualifications.

. In view of judgments cited above fovouring the present appellants and because of notification of 1995, if not followed, would discriminate the present appellants. These appeals are therefore, allowed. The judgments of the NWFP Service Tribunal, Peshawar is set aside and the respondents are directed to grant BPS-17 to the appellants with effect from the dte fo their Master's Degree acquiring higher qualifications. However, there is no order as to costs.

Written reply/ Para wise comments for & on behalf of Respondents.

Respectfully Sheweth, Preliminary Objections:-

- 1. The appellant has no cause of action/ locus standi.
- 2. The instant appeal is badly time barred.
- 3. The appellant has concealed the material facts from this Hon 'able Tribunal, hence liable to be dismissed.
- 4. The appellant has not come to this Hon 'able court with clean hands.
- 5. The appellant has filed the instant appeal just to pressurize the Respondents.
- 6. The present appeal is liable to be dismissed for non joinder / misjoinder of necessary parties.
- 7. The appellant has filed the instant appeal on malafide motives.
- 8. The instant appeal is against the prevailing law and rules.
- 9. The appellant is estopped by his own conduct to file the instant appeal.
- 10. The instant appeal is not maintainable in the present form and also in the present circumstances of the issue.

FACTS.

- 1. This para is related to academic record of the appellant. However, it is pertinent to mention here that the appellant passed the mentioned Master Degree on 23-08-1992 as (Annexure-A of the appeal).
- 2. This para is related to service record of the appellant, while the Annexure-B of the appeal shows that the appellant was appointed against BS-16 post with effect from the date of their taking over charge on 30-05-1994.
- 3. This para also pertains to the record of the Apex Courts. However, it would not be out of place to mention here that the annexed judgment of the Apex Court is not judgment in rem and has no concern to appeal of the instant petitioner.
- 4. Incorrect and not admitted. The minutes of the meeting dated 26-12-2011 (Annexure of the appeal) is very clear according to the prevailing rules. It is pointed out in the said minutes of the meeting that the Finance Department vide civil services pay revision rules 1978, allowed award of BS-17 (Personal) to Librarians on the basis of having master degree in Library Science. The said concession was, however, subsequently with drawn, this concession of BS-17 (Personal) on 04-08-1993, with some reservations/ observations (Annexure-A), while the present appellant was inducted into the Education

Department in year 1994, after withdrawal of the said concession hence the appellant is not eligible/ entitled of award of BS-17. Hence this appeal is liable to be dismissed inter alia on the following grounds.

ON GROUNDS.

- a. This para is related to appellant academic record, hence needs not comments.
- b. Incorrect and not admitted. The appellant misconceived/ misapprehend/ and misconstrued the said judgment.
- The statement of the appellant in this para has no concern to case of the appellant.
- d. The contents of this para is also related to record of the Apex Courts, hence no comments. No injustice committed by the Respondent.
- e. Incorrect. The said judgment of the Apex Court is judgment in personam and thereby mentioned and directed to grant BS-17 to the appellant from the date of degree acquiring higher qualification.
- f. Incorrect and not admitted. The minutes of the meeting held on 26-12-2011 is legal and based on cogent reasons.
- g. No comments.
- h. Incorrect and not admitted. The appointment order of the appellant is very clear. The appellant is appointed against the advertised BS-16 post of Librarian with effect from the date of taking their charge, and the appellant did not raised any objection at that time and accepted the said order by taking over charge. Now at this belated stage the appellant has no right to claim BS-17 against the post advertised as Librarian BS-17.

In view of the above made submissions, it is requested that Honourable Tribunal may very graciously be pleased to dismiss the present appeal in favour of the Respondent Department.
