

**ON ACCEPTANCE OF THIS APPEAL, THE
IMPUGNED ORDER DATED 28/8/2023 MAY
BE SET ASIDE/ MODIFIED TO THE EXTENT**

THAT THE APPELLANT MAY KINDLY BE HELD ENTITLED TO ALL BACK BENEFIT FOR THE OUT OF SERVICE PERIOD AND ABSENCE PERIOD.

Respectfully Sheweth.

1. That the appellant joined the police force as Constable on 1.1.2008 and from day one of his service, he performed his statutory duties to the entire satisfaction of his superiors and about 15 years of service is at his credit.
2. That the stroke of misfortune hit appellant when he was dismissed from service on 18/1/2023 based on pretext of absence from duty, the appellant preferred his departmental appeal which was rejected vide impugned final order dated 20/4/2023 by Respondent No.2.
(Dismissal Order & Final Order are annexed as "A & B")
3. That feeling aggrieved the appellant filed his revision petition before Respondent No.1 which was accepted on 28/8/2023. Respondent No.1 was pleased to set aside the impugned order and directed the department to reinstate the appellant but without granting back benefits to the appellant. **(Revision petition is annexed as "C")**
4. That feeling distressed, the appellant submitted his departmental appeal for granting of his back benefits keeping in view _____ that his appeal was accepted and

his dismissal order was withdrawn on 28/08/2023 by Respondent No.1 (Order is attached as Annexure "D").

5. That after the reinstatement of the applicant, departmental appeal for granting of his back benefits, keeping in view the probability that his appeal was accepted by appellate authority.
6. That the appellant's departmental appeal regarding granting of back benefits was submitted on 05-10-2023 and was placed on file on 16/10/23 but no response from the appellate authorities whatsoever, till this day. (Appeal is annexure "E").
7. That feeling badly aggrieved, the appellant knocks the door of this Hon'ble Tribunal on the following grounds inter-alia:-

Grounds:

- A. That since, the appellant has been reinstated by the Respondent No.1, holding back his back benefits is illegal and unlawful.
- B. That the departmental appeal qua dismissal from service has been accepted by the competent authority i.e., the Respondent No.1 being the appellate authority, so, the appellant resumed his duties with a lawful order, hence he is entitled of all the arrears in shape of back benefits since his illegal dismissal from service ie. 18-01-23.

C. That a simple glance over the Order dated:18-10-2023 makes it crystalline that the seniority of the appellant has been kept intact, which is, an un-skeptical endorsement of the probity that his service is absolutely continuous and without any break.

D. That by pouring a momentary look at the relevant statute regarding granting of pay/ salary and arrears of pay/ back benefits, it is advantageous to reproduce Section 17 of the KP Civil Servants Act, 1973 ad-verbatim;

17. Pay. ----***A Civil Servant appointed shall be entitled, in accordance with the rules, to the pay sanction for such post:***

Provided that when the appointment is made on current charge basis or by way of additional charge, his pay shall be fixed in the prescribed manner:

Provided further that when a Civil Servant has, under an order, which is later set aside, been dismissed or removed from service or reduced in rank, he shall on setting aside of such order, be entitled to such arrears of pay as the authority setting aside such order may determine.

Hence, keeping in view the aforesaid proviso of Section 17 of the KP CSA Act, 1973, it is settled that on setting-aside any order of dismissal or removal as well as

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reduction in rank, the employee is entitled of arrears to pay. In the case in hand, the Appellant's departmental appeal has been accepted by the competent authority and his dismissal from service order has been withdrawn, so, the appellant is entitled of his arrear of pay. It would further be pertinent to submit that acceptance of departmental appeal means setting-aside of the impugned dismissal order while the term "withdraw" as per the Black's Law Dictionary means to take back or to retract. Thus, the appellant is entitle to all his arrears of pay from the date when he was dismissed from service.

- E. That it is also rudimentary to submit before this Hon'ble Tribunal. The appellant, if didn't, serve the department during such period, such fault cannot be laden on his shoulder because it was due to unlawful step taken by the respondents which curtailed him from performance of his duties. Thus, the appellant is entitled to all the arrears of pay.
- F. That during the period he was abstained from service via the dismissal from service, he didn't serve any other place or department and also didn't receive any perks and privilege from any other source or entity. His entitlement to the arrears of pay cannot be ignored.
- G. That any other ground not raised here may graciously be allowed to be raised at the time of arguments.



Any other relief may also be extended in favor of the appellant against the respondents.

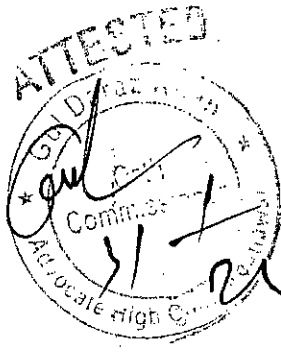



This order will dispose of departmental appeal, preferred by Ex-Cook constable Haq Nawaz Khan No.157 of District Bannu, wherein he has prayed for setting aside the order of major punishment of "Dismissal from service", imposed upon him by DPO Bannu vide OB No.58 dated 18.01.2023 for committing the following misconduct:-

- That as reported by SDPO Rural-I, Bannu, the appellant was found absent without any sanctioned leave or prior permission from the competent authority. The appellant did not perform his duty efficiently. He did not pay attention to the directions issued by the DPO Bannu and did not mend his way. He is habitual absentee.

Comments, service record and other relevant papers were received from DPO Bannu vide his office letter No.972/SRC, dated 21.02.2023 and perused in detail. The DPO Bannu has reported that the appellant was issued Show Cause Notice vide No.25/SRC dated 19.01.2023 but his reply was found unsatisfactory. The appellant being habitual absentee, his further retention in service would be detrimental and burden over the shoulder of the department. In the current situation of terrorism his absence has put other officials of the concerned Police Post at risk. Therefore, the competent authority (DPO Bannu) has awarded the appellant major punishment of "Dismissal from Service" vide OB No. 58 dated 18.01.2023. The appellant was heard in person in orderly room held in RPO Office Bannu on 06.04.2023. His plea was not found convincing. He had recruited an "Iwazi" at a rate of Rs:10,000/- per month to perform duties at his place while he himself was doing private business. The introduction of this dirty culture is extremely dangerous in police department and cannot be allowed to go unchecked.

Therefore, I, Syed Ashfaq Anwar, PSP, Regional Police Officer, Bannu Region Bannu, in exercise of the powers vested in me under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police Rules, 1975 (amended in 2014) hereby reject his appeal and endorse the punishment awarded to him by DPO Bannu vide OB No. 58 dated 18.01.2023.

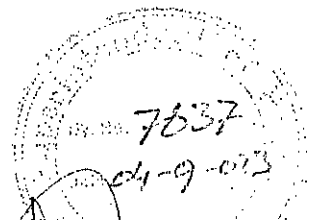

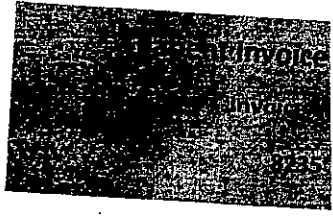
