Respectfully Sheweth:

- 1. That the appellant is the employee of the Provincial Planning Services being recommended by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Public Service Commission, in the year 2008. (Copy of the Appointment Order is annex "A").
- 2. That since 2008, the appellant is working in the Department where he is posted from time to time and have no stigma on him in the whole period of his service career.
- 3. That the appellant's department has its own Service Rules, known as "The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Provincial Planning Services Rules, 2018", wherein the procedure for promotion has been mentioned in Schedule-II, Para-3, which says "ninety percent (90%) by promotion on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness from amongst the officers of Provincial Planning Service (PPS) in BS-17 having at least five (05) years service", as such the appellant was waiting for his promotion on the settled criteria mentioned above. (COPY OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA P&D RULES, 2018 IS ANNEX "B").

- 4. That the appellant has more than eleven (11) years of service in the Department and was at S.No.28 in the seniority list, the appellant was waiting for his turn for promotion, so in the meanwhile the respondents prepared working papers for the Provincial Selection Board for promotion in Planning and Development Department. (Copies of the Seniority List and Working Papers are annex "C" & "D").
- 5. That the Provincial Selection Board hold a meeting on 26th Dec, 2018 for promotion of the employees of the department according to the seniority list, but never intimated it to the appellant about fulfilling/ correcting the deficiencies, if any, and a meeting was held in which 17 officers were recommended for promotion in which the respondents No.4 to 7 who were junior to the appellant was also promoted and the appellant was deferred and observations were given in his recommendation that "His date of birth is <u>01.10.1982. He joined service on 25.02.2008 in BS-17.</u> His PERs for the years 2008 to 2017 are not available. The Board showed concern over the issue of missing

PERs and directed the Department to investigate into the matter and in case, he is found guilty, he may be proceeded against under Efficiency & Discipline Rules, 2011. The Board recommended to defer his promotion." The appellant was deferred and no opportunity was extended to hear him and if found eligible be promoted and was discriminated with malafide intention for their ulterior motives. (Copy of the Minutes of the Meeting is annex "E").

6. That the appellant approached the respondents No.1 to 3 and all the Personal Earned Reports (PERs) were provided in which there was no adverse remarks in any PER. The respondents were also apprised that their juniors (respondents No.4 to 7) have been promoted and it is nothing but to create discontent and biasedness in the employees of the same Department. The respondents showed their sympathy and advised the appellant not to knock the doors of the court having competent jurisdictions, but now their PERs are available and that is the sole ground of deferring him. So they are recommending

his name as per the seniority list, but in the meanwhile the notification for the promotion to BPS-18 of the recommended persons was issued. (COPY OF THE NOTIFICATION IS ANNEX "F").

- 7. That in the meanwhile, another working paper was prepared for the promotion to BS-18 as per the commitment of the respondents No.1 to 3 and again Provincial Selection Board was convened to consider other employees of the department, in which the name of the appellant was at S.No.14. (Copy of THE WORKING PAPER IS ANNEX "G").
- 8. That the Provincial Selection Board hold a meeting on 07.05.2019 and did not recommend the name of the appellant for promotion. (Copy of the MINUTES OF THE MEETING IS ANNEX "H").
- 9. That the Board recommended the names of the two (02) officers at S.N.1 & 2 on regular basis and officers at S.No.4,5,8 & 11 on acting charge basis and did not give any observation or recommendation about the appellant. (Copy of the Notification is annex "I").

- 10. That the appellant submitted departmental appeal to the respondent No.1, but till date no order has been passed. (Copy of the Appeal is Annex "J").
- 11. That the appellant also filed a Writ Petition No.3900-P/2019, which was dismissed on the ground of maintainability with observation to approach the Hon'ble Tribunal, if the appellant wants so. (Copy of Writ Petition Alongwith Order is Annex "K").

Being aggrieved and having no other adequate remedy, the appellant submit the instant Service Appeal in this Honourable Tribunal, on the following grounds, inter alia;

GROUNDS:-

A. That the appellant has been recommended for appointment by the Public Service Commission and since then is performing his duties with full zeal and devotion and with full satisfaction of the seniors and has never been committed any illegalities/irregularities and has also never violated the services rules. The appellant has never been informed about the Provincial Selection Board or for correcting the

deficiencies and the only ground for deferring the appellant of missing PERs is a sheer violation of the fundamental rights of the appellant, which needs correction by this Honourable Tribunal.

- B. That the appellant had a right as per the services laws to be heard in person, if there is any deficiency in his service career which the respondents have never disclosed/conveyed to the appellant, which amounts to discrimination on the part, of the respondents No.1 to 3 as the recommendation is self-explanatory, therefore, the Services Laws of Pakistan and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa give protection to all the employees from any type of discrimination/illegality.
- C. That the appellant fulfill all the conditions mentioned for promotion and is eligible for promotion as such not extending him the opportunity is the violation of the fundamental rights as enshrined in the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 as well as protection given by the Services Laws of the land as well as it also create resentment in the employees of the Department, which is detrimental to the performance of the Department.

D. That the respondents time and again assured the

appellant that his grievances will be addressed/

redressed and took chances to deprive the appellant

from his legal rights.

It is, therefore most humbly prayed that on

acceptance of this Service Appeal, the respondents

may please be directed to recommend the

appellant if in his PERs there is nothing against him

and he fulfills the criteria devised for promotion as

well as is eligible so, he may please be promoted

THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA PROVINCIAL PLANNING SERVICE RULES, 2018.

- 1. Short title application and commencement.— (1) These rules may be called the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Provincial Planning Service Rules, 2018.
- (2) These rules shall apply to the recruitment and promotion to the posts in Provincial Planning Service.
 - (3) These rules shall come into force at once.
- 2. Definitions.— In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say-
 - (a) "appointing authority" means the appointing authority as specified in rule 6 of these rules;
 - (b) "Commission" means the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission;
 - (c) "Government" means the Government of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province;
 - (d) "Department" means the Planning and Development Department;
 - (e) "Departmental Examination" means the prescribed examination to be conducted by the Department for confirmation within probationary period or for promotion to higher post, as the case may be;

- (f) "Departmental Training" means any training prescribed by Government, the successful completion whereof is necessary for promotion to BS-19 and 20 or any change in the training required from time to time;
- (g) "Schedule" means the Schedule appended to these rules;
- (h) "Service" means the Provincial Planning Service; and
- (i) "Secretariat" means the Civil Secretariat as defined in clause (r) of rule 2 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Rules of Business, 1985.
- 3. Constitution of the Service.— The Service shall consist of the posts as specified in Schedule-I and such other posts as may be added to it from time to time.
- 4. Method of recruitment.— (1) The method of recruitment, minimum qualification, age limit and other matters related thereto for the Service shall be such as specified in Schedule-II.
- (2) Initial recruitment to the Service shall be made through an examination conducted by the Commission.
- (3) The standard and syllabus of examination for the Service shall be such as specified in Schedule-III.
- 5. Training.— On appointment to the post borne in the Service in BPS-17 via initial recruitment, every officer so appointed shall successfully complete six months mandatory training at any academy or institute decided by Government as per Module specified in Schedule-IV. The training shall be followed by a Departmental Examination as specified in Schedule-V, to be conducted by the Academy or institute, as the case may be.
- 6. Appointing Authority.— The Chief Secretary, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa shall be the appointing authority for posts borne on the Service in BPS-17.
- 7. Savings.— In all other matters not expressly provided for in these rules, the members of the Service shall be governed by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989, and any other rules pertaining to the terms and conditions of service made or deemed to have been made under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act, 1973.
- 8. Transitional.— The seniority position of various officers appointed in planning cadres of various Departments and brought on the strength of the Service on coming into force of these rules shall be considered from the date of their regular appointment to posts in their present Basic Scales of pay:

Provided that where two or more civil servants have been appointed to their present Basic Scale on the same day, the older in age shall be considered senior.

- 9. Repeal and saving.— (1) On coming into force of these rules, the service rules of the concerned line Departments shall stand repealed to the extent of the posts as given in Schedule-I.
- (2) Any person appointed to a post specified in Schedule-I before the commencement of these rules shall, on commencement of these rules, be deemed for all intents and purposes to have been validly appointed under these rules on the authority of the Planning and Development Department as assigned to it under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Rules of Business, 1985, and his/her affairs shall henceforth be administered by the Planning and Development Department in accordance with these rules and any other rules for the time being in force and made applicable to him/her in accordance with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Rules of Business, 1985.







In another meeting of the Provincial Selection Board was convened on 07.05.2019 in which too, the petitioners were not recommended for promotion.

2. The petitioners having no other efficacious remedy, implored the constitutional jurisdiction of this Court with the perspective prayer:-

"It is, therefore, humbly prayed that on acceptance of instant writ petition, the respondents may pleas be directed to recommend the petitioners if any in their PERs there is nothing against them and they are eligible so, they may please be promoted alongwith their colleagues including the juniors from the date of their promotion, which is 24th Jan, 2019 with cost throughout.

Any other relief, which this Honorable Court deems appropriate, may kindly be awarded to meet the ends of justice."

the petitioners, available record with his valuable assistance gone through.

4. From bare perusal of the record it divulges that in essence the petitioners prayed for promotion, being the employees of Provincial Planning Services but as the matter of their promotion relates to their terms and conditions of service, for which the competent forum is the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal constituted under Service Tribunals Act, 1973. The jurisdiction of all other Courts including the High Court is specifically ousted because of the provision contained in Article 212 (2) of the Constitution. So, the request of petitioners in view of *ibid* Article 212 (2) could not be acceded to, which reads as under: -

"(2) Notwithstanding anything hereinbefore contained where any Administrative Court or Tribunal is established under clause (1), no other court shall grant an injunction, make any order or entertain any proceedings in respect of any matter to which the jurisdiction of such Administrative Court or Tribunal extends and all proceedings in respect of any such matter which may be pending before such other court immediately before the establishment of the Administrative Court or





Tribunal; other than an appeal pending before the Supreme Court, shall abate on such establishment."

- Service Tribunal Act, 1974 provides a complete procedure to the petitioners in such like circumstances. According to the said Section any civil servant aggrieved by any final order upon presentation or departmental appeal, whether original or appellate, made by a departmental authority in respect of any of the terms and conditions of his/her service may, within thirty days of the communication of such order to his/her or within six months of the establishment of the appropriate Tribunal; whichever is later, prefer an appeal before the Tribunal having jurisdiction in the matter.
- As admittedly promotion is one of the terms and conditions of civil servant as defined in Chapter-II section 10 of Civil Servants Act, 1973, therefore, this Court lacks the jurisdiction to entertain the writ petition challenging the promotion order.
