01. Nemo for the petitioner. Mr. Muhammad Jan, District Attorney alongwith Yousaf Jamal, Focal Person for the respondents present.

02. Representative of the respondents submitted objection petitioner which is placed on file. Through the said petition, notification dated 27.03.2023 has been produced which indicates that the waiting for posting period of the petitioner w.e.f August 2015 to 05.09.2022 has been regularized for the purpose of pay, without Health Professional Allowance. Non-payment of HPA came under discussion on 29.11.2023 also and through the order sheet of that date, both the petitioner as well as respondents were directed to produce arrival report of the petitioner in order to ascertain that on which date she submitted arrival so that the matter of payment of HPA can be resolved. Order sheet dated 20.12.2023 shows that on that date, the petitioner submitted copy of her arrival report, to the Director Health Services, FATA on 31.08.2014. Copy of the same be provided to the departmental representative to process the case of payment of HPA.
