#### **PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS:**

- 1. That the Appellant has got no locus standai for filing this Service Appeal.
- 2. That the Appeal is wrong and based on illegal and unlawful presumptions.
- 3. That the Appellant has got no cause of action to file the present Appeal.
- 4. That the Appeal is not maintainable in this present form.
- 5. That the Appeal is bad for mis-joinder and non-joinder of parties.
- 6. That this honorable tribunal has got no jurisdiction to entertain the present appeal.
- 7. That the appeal is barred by law and limitation.

#### **FACTS**

- 1. Correct to the extent that the appeliant was appointed as Field Cattle Attendant purely on contract basis dated 01/06/2001. (Annexure-A).
- 2. Pertains to record.
- 3. Correct to the extent that the services of all the project employees (including the petitioner) of Erstwhile FATA were regularized by the Government through Notification No. SO (LFC) / AD /1-29/2022 dated 01/08/2022 in light of the Regularization of Services of Employees of Erstwhile FATA, Act 2021/2022 (Annexure-B).
- 4. Incorrect. The Services of the Appellant along with others were regularized from the dated of commencement of the Regularization of Services of Employees of Erstwhile FATA Act 2021/2022 as per terms and conditions mentioned in the said Act, Moreover as per official record no Departmental Appeal has been filed by the Appellant. It is pertinent to mention here that the appellant was working in a developmental project before his service regularization; therefore, his pay cannot be fixed from initial appointment as per rules. (Annexure-C).
- 5. Incorrect.

#### **Grounds**

- A. Incorrect. The action of respondents is based on facts and law and the appellant was regularized under the ibid Act. His previous services were temporary against developmental scheme.
- B. Incorrect. The respondents have acted in accordance with law and rules and have not violated Article 4 and 25 of the Constitution of Islamia Republic of Pakistan 1973.
- C. Incorrect. As stated in fact No. 04.

D. Incorrect. The respondents have acted as per the ibid Act, and no discriminatory actions have been omitted by the respondents as they are bound to obey the norms of natural justice.

- E. Incorrect. As stated above, the petitioner has been dealt with in accordance with the ibid Act, which is effective from the date of its enactment i.e. 13/01/2022. The question of disparity in this case does not arise as all the project employees regularized have been treated equally and no one has been given Project benefits towards regular service.
- F. Incorrect. The petitioner cannot be granted pay fixation from the date of his initial appointment as he was not a regular employee at that time.
- G. The respondents seek permission to raise additional grounds at the times of arguments.

In view of the above, it is, therefore, most humbly prayed that the instant Appeal may kindly be dismissed in favor of the respondents with cost.





THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA (REGULARIZATION OF SERVICES OF EMPLOYEES OF ERSTWHILE FEDERALLY ADMINISTERED TRIBAL AREAS) ACT, 2021. (KHYBER PAKHTUNKIIWA ACT NO. 1 OF 2072)





to provide for the appointment and regularization of services of certain employees appointed on contract basis against project posts in the erstwhile Federally Administered Tribal Asses.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the appointment and regularization of services of certain employees appointed on contract basis against project posts in the erstwhile Federally Administered Tribal Areas;

It is hereby enacted by the Provincial Assembly of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa as follows:

- 1. Short title, application and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Regularization of Services of Employees of Erstwhile Federally Administered Tribal Areas) Act, 2021.
- (2) It shall apply to all the employees as defined in clause (d) of subsection (1) of section 2 of this Ast.
  - (3) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Definitions.— (1) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,-
  - (a) "Commission" means the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission;
  - (b) "Departmental Selection Committee" means a
    Departmental Selection Committee, constituted for the
    purpose of making selection for appointment to project post
    under a Department or office in the erstwhile Federally
    Administered Tribal Areas;
  - (c) "Government" means the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa:
  - (d) "employees" means a person, who was appointed on contract basis, as per project policy, to a project post, in the erstwhile Federally Administered Tribal Areas, and such post was duly reflected in PC-I of that project, and who possess the prescribed qualification, training and experience for the said post at the time of such appointment;
  - (e) "Department" means a Government Department, as defined in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Rules of Business, 1985;
  - (f) "law or rules" means the law or rules, for the time being in force, governing the selection and appointment of civil servants;
  - (g) "project" means a perpetual nature project in the entwhile Pederally Administered Tribal Areas, the continuation of which and conversion to regular budget is essential for service delivery, duly identified by the Departments and reflected in the Schedule;

- (h) "project post" means a post in the project; and .
- (i) "Rehedule" means a Schodule appended to this Act.
- (2) The expression "contract appointment" shall have the same meaning as respectively assigned to them in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act, 1973 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XVIII of 1973).
- 3. Appointment and regularization of services of employees.— (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in any law or rules, the employees, appointed on contract basis, against project posts, in the erstwhile Federally Administered Tribal Areas, and holding such project posts till the commencement of this Act, shall be deemed to have been validly appointed, on regular basis, from the commencement of this Act, subject to verification of their qualifications and other credentials by the concerned Department.
- (2) All such employees, after the commencement of this, Act, shall, in lieu of pension and gratuity, be entitled to receive such amount contributed by them towards the Contributory Provident Fund, slong with the contributions made by Government to their account in the said Fund, in the prescribed manner.
- (3) A Committee, headed by the Secretary of the Department concerned, with the following membership, shall scrutinize all the credentials of the employees, before issuant z of the regularization orders:
  - (a) head of the Attached Department concerned;
  - (b) representative of the Establishment and Administration Department of Government;
  - (c) representative of the Finance Department of Government;
  - (d) representative of the Planning and Development Department of Government; and
  - (e) Deputy Secretary of the Department concerned.
- 4. General conditions for regularization.— For the purpose of regularization of the employees under this Act, the following general conditions shall be observed:
  - (a) the service promotion quota of all service cadres shall not be affected:
  - (b) the employees shall possess the same qualification and experience as required for a regular post;
  - (c) the employees have not resigned from their services or terminated from service on account of misconduct, inefficiency or any other grounds before the commencement of this Act; and
  - (d) the services of such employees shall be deemed to have been regularized only on the publication of their names in the official Gazette.
- 5. Determination of seniority.—(1) All employees, whose services are regularized under this Act, shall rank junior to all civil servants belonging to the same service or cadre, as the case may be, who are in service on regular basis on the commencement of this Act, and shall also rank junior to such other persons, if any, who, in pursuance of the recommendation of the Commission or Departmental Selection Committee, as the case may be, made before the commencement of this

Act, are to be appointed to the respective service or cadre, irrespective of their actual date of appointment.

(2) The seniority inter-se of the employees, whose services are regularized under this Act within the same service or cadre, shall be determined as per provisions of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act, 1973 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XVIII of 1973) and rules made thereunder.

6. Removal of difficulties...-If any difficulty arises in giving effect to any of the provisions of this Act, the Chief Minister of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa may make such order, not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, as may appear to it to be necessary for the purpose of removing such difficulty.

Overriding effect.—Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any other law or rules, the provisions of this Act shall have an overriding effect and the provisions of any such law or rules to the extent of inconsistency to this Act shall cease to have effect.




