JUDGMENT

ATIQ-UR-REHMAN WAZIR MEMBER (E):-

Brief facts of the

case are that the appellant while serving as Lecturer in Higher Education Department, was proceeded against on the charges of absence from duty and was ultimately removed from service vide order dated 21-04-2015. Feeling aggrieved, the appellant filed departmental appeal dated 20-05-2015, which was not responded within the statutory period, hence the instant service appeal with prayers that the impugned order dated 21-04-2015 may be set aside and the appellant may be re-instated in service with all back benefits.

02. Learned counsel for the appellant has contended that the impugned order is illegal, unlawful and contrary to the norms of natural justice, therefore, not tenable and liable to be set aside; that the appellant has not been treated in

accordance with law, hence his rights secured under the Constitution has badly been violated; that no proper procedure has been followed before imposition of major penalty of removal from service upon the appellant; that the appellant has not been served with charge sheet/statement of allegation nor any inquiry has been conducted, thus the whole proceedings are nullity in the eye of law; that the appellant has not been provided opportunity of personal hearing before awarding major penalty of removal from service, hence the appellant has been condemned unheard; that absence of the appellant was not willful, rather the appellant properly applied for Ex-Pakistan leave, which was duly considered and the appellant was of the impression that such leave has been granted; that the appellant had gone abroad for higher studies on full bright scholarship and appellant was the only candidate selected from Khyber Pakhtunkhwa; that as per rule-12 of the leave rules, the appellant was entitled to extra ordinary leave without pay for two years at a time, but the respondent refused such leave, which was against law and rule; that the appellant resumed his duty on 27-12-2014 but he was declared absent with effect from 01-09-2014 and was removed from service vide order dated 21-04-2015; that the impugned order is not a speaking order and is in violation of section 24 A of the General Clauses Act; that the appellant has never committed any act or omission which could be termed as misconduct albeit the appellant has been removed from service; that the appellant has long and spotless service at his credit, the penalty so awarded is harsh and liable to be set aside.

03. Learned Additional Advocate General for the respondents has contended that the appellant while serving as Lecturer in the Higher Education Department, applied for full bright scholarship for higher studies, for which the appellant was selected at University of Georgia USA and the appellant applied for Ex-Pakistan leave, but before approval of such leave, the appellant left for USA and sent another application from USA; that the appellant left the country without

obtaining NOC from the department and without seeking permission of the competent authority, therefore, the appellant was proceeded in absentia and absence notices were sent at his home address but he did not turn up, hence such notices were published in newspapers, but the appellant did not respond, hence the penalty of removal from service was imposed upon the appellant due to his willful absence.

- 04. We have heard learned counsel for the parties and have perused the record.
- 05. Record reveals that the appellant was initially appointed as Lecturer on ad-hoc basis in the year 2010 and upon promulgation of regularization Act, 2014, his services were regularized. During the course of his service, the appellant availed the opportunity of getting foreign scholarship for higher studies. In order to join higher studies in USA, the appellant submitted application for leave without pay, which was admissible to the appellant under Rule-12 of Revised Leave Rules, 1981 as the appellant was holding five years service at his credit, but such leave was not granted to the appellant, which however was not warranted as the scholarship was foreign funded with no cost on provincial government and it was beneficial for the respondents that one of their teacher was getting higher qualification, who in return would deliver in a better way. The respondents were supposed to appreciate the intelligence of the appellant, who grabbed Full Bright scholarship, instead they have discouraged him by implicating him in legal jargons under the pretext that as per rule ibid, it was upon discretion of the competent authority either to grant or refuse such leave. The competent authority was supposed to exercise his discretion judiciously as his request for such leave was based on genuine reason to up-grade his qualification, but the competent authority had not done it the way it was required to be done.
- 06. Interestingly, the appellant was proceeded against under Rule-9 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servant (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011

inspite of the fact that the appellant was in regular contact with the respondents. as is evident from record and the respondents were well aware of the fact that the appellant is in USA for higher education. It was funny on part of the respondents knowing the whereabouts of the appellant, still they issued notices in newspapers with warning to the appellant to resume duty. Upon publication of notices in the newspapers, the appellant came back and resumed his duty and again requested for grant of extra-ordinary leave for the purpose of higher study, but his request was not even processed and the respondents continued with the disciplinary proceedings to the extent of fulfillment of formalities, hence ex-parte action was taken against him and he was removed from service without conducting a regular inquiry. The Supreme Court of Pakistan in its judgment reported as 2008 SCMR 1369 has held that in case of imposing major penalty, the principles of natural justice required that a regular inquiry was to be conducted in the matter and opportunity of defense and personal hearing was to be provided to the civil servant proceeded against, otherwise civil servant would be condemned unheard and major penalty of dismissal from service would be imposed upon him without adopting the required mandatory procedure, resulting in manifest iniustice.

O7. The impugned order would suggest that the appellant was proceeded against on the ground of absence for the mentioned period, however the authority has treated the mentioned period as leave without pay, as such the very ground, on the basis of which the appellant was proceeded against, has vanished away and the appellant cannot be penalized for the absence, which was regularized by the respondents themselves and on this score alone, the impugned order is liable to be set aside. Wisdom in this respect derived from the judgment of the august Supreme Court of Pakistan, reported as 2006 SCMR 434 and 2012 TD (Services) 348.

08. The appellant was not guilty of charges of gross misconduct or corruption,

therefore, extreme penalty of dismissal from service for the charge of absence

and that too on genuine reason, which cannot be termed as willful absence and

which does not constitute gross misconduct entailing major penalty of removal

from service. Competent authority had jurisdiction to award any of the

punishments mentioned in law to the government employee but for the purpose

of safe administration of justice such punishment should be awarded which

commensurate with the magnitude of the guilt, Otherwise the law dealing with

the subject would lose its efficacy. Reliance is placed on 2006 SCMR 1120.

09. We are of the considered opinion that the appellant has not been treated

in accordance with law, as the appellant was entitled for extra-ordinary leave

under Rule-12 of Revised Leave Rules 1981, but was not granted, which however

was not warranted. The appellant was not proceeded in accordance with law,

hence was kept deprived of his job in an illegal and mechanical manner. In view

of the foregoing discussion, the instant appeal is accepted. The impugned order

dated 21-04-2015 is set aside and the appellant is re-instated in service with all

back benefits. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to record



Prayer in Appeal: -

On acceptance of this appeal the impugned order dated 21/04/2015 communicated to the appellant on 14/05/2015, whereby the appellant was awarded major penalty of removal from service, against which departmental appeal on dated 20/05/2015 was filed by the appellant of which no order has been passed yet, may kindly be set aside and the appellant be reinstated with all back benefits on his services

RESPECTFULLY SUBMITTED:

- 1. That the appellant was initially appointed as Lecturer on adhoc basis on the year 2010, later on adhoc appointment was extended from time to time. It is pertinent to mention here that on promulgation of Adhoc Appointments Regularization Act 2014 by Provincial Assembly, the service of the undersigned were also regularized in the year 2014.
- 2. That ever since appointment of the appellant performed his duties as assigned with zeal and devotion and there was no complaint whatsoever regarding appellant's performance.
- 3. That during the course of services of the appellant the appellant applied for scholarship of higher studies accordingly the appellant got full bright scholarship of higher studies at University of Georgia in USA. It is pertinent to mention here that the appellant was the only

candidate selected from the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa for the said scholarship.

- 4. That in order to join studies abroad, appellant also submitted applications for Ex-Pakistani leave (Leave without pay), however appellant was not given any response, thereafter I went abroad and joined his studies. It is pertinent to mention that the appellant is in touch with the department and continuously made request for Ex-Pakistan leave vide applications dated 18/08/2014 and 10/10/2014.
- 5. That a notice of assumption of duty was issued, thereafter appellant came back in December 2014, and submitted his arrival report dated 17/12/2014. Thereafter again made requests and submitted application for Ex-Pakistan Leave which was received vide Diary No.980, dated 30/12/2014. Since under the rules appellant was entitled for leave therefore appellant was assured that his leave will be sanctioned. In order to continued his studies appellant left for USA with impression that this time his leave application being properly processed / forwarded will be allowed.
- 6. That the appellant also made correspondence with his department from abroad regarding the sanction or otherwise of his leave, however appellant was given no response. (Copies of application to the principle GSSC Peshawar under the subject leave with or without pay for academic purpose dated 18/08/2014 and other applications dated 10/Oct/2014, application to the secretary Higher



Education Peshawar dated 10 Feb 2015, Arrival application to the principle GSSC, Peshawar dated 27/12/2014 with diary no. 980, dated 30/12/2014 are attached as annexure A, B, C, D, & E)

- 7. That in the meantime appellant came to know that he has been proceeded against in absentia and has been removed from service vide notification dated 21/04/2015. (Copy of the removal from service order dated 21/04/2015 is annexed as annexure F)
- 8. That the appellant thereafter filed a departmental appeal on dated 20/05/2015 and because of having no plausible reply the department has not decided the departmental appeal of the appellant within a span of 90 days and till date, appellant waited for statutory period and when now has became completely disappointed, hence now approaches this Honourable Forum in the instant appeal. (Copy of the departmental appeal etc are attached as annexure G).
- 9. That the order whereby appellant has been removed from service, is illegal, unlawful against the law and fact hence liable to be set aside on the following grounds inter alia: -

Grounds: -

A. That the impugned order of respondents of removal of services of the appellant is illegal, null, void in the eyes of law and against the principle of natural justice, hence liable to be set aside.

(3)

- B. That appellant has not been treated in accordance with law hence rights of the appellant secured and guaranteed under the law are badly violated.
- C. That no properly procedure has been followed before the imposition of penalty of removal from service upon the appellant. Appellant has not been served with any charge sheet or statement of allegations nor any inquiry has been conducted to roper into the charges thus the whole proceedings are nullity in the eyes of law.
- D. That the appellant has not been provided opportunity of personal hearing before awarding the appellant the penalty of removal from service, hence I have been condemned unheard.
- E. That no charge sheet or statement of allegations as prescribed under the law and rules has been served upon me hence I have not been provided fair opportunity to defend himself against the charges leveled.
- F. That the application submitted by the appellant vide diary no.980 dated 30/12/2014 was purposely misplaced. Moreover appellant was never informed about the rejection of the application for leave (if it was so), therefore appellant had the impression that the same is allowed.

- G. That as per rule 12 of the Civil servant Leave revised leave rule, 198, "Extra Ordinary Leave may be granted on any ground up to a maximum period of five years at a time; provided that the Civil Servant to who such leave is granted has been in continuous service for a period of not less than ten years. In case of Civil Servant has not completed ten years of continuous service, Extra Ordinary leave without pay for a maximum period of two years may be granted at the discretion of the leave sanctioning authority. The leave can be granted irrespective of fact whether a Civil servant is a permanent or temporary employee". Since the undersigned had a genuine reason as such leave could not be refused to the appellant.
- H. That the impugned order of removal from service it has been alleged that appellant remained absent from duty w.e.f.01/09/2014 while appellant duly reported for duty on 27/12/2014, however this fact has been ignored.
- I. That the impugned order is not a speaking order and is in violation of the section 24-A of the General Clauses Act.
- J. That appellant has never committed any act or omission which could be termed as misconduct albeit appellant has been removed from his service. Appellant applied for leave and the application was forwarded, since appellant was

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entitled for leave, therefore appellant was hopeful that his leave will be sanctioned.

K. That appellant have a long and spotless service career of about 5 years at appellant's credit, the penalty imposed upon me is harsh and liable to be set aside.

L. That other grounds would be raised at the time of arguments with the permission of this Honourable Forum.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that On acceptance of this appeal the impugned order dated 21/04/2015 communicated to the appellant on 14/05/2015, whereby the appellant was awarded major penalty of removal from service, against which departmental appeal on dated 20/05/2015 was filed by the appellant of which no order has been passed yet, may kindly be set aside and the appellant be reinstated with all back benefits on his services





It is pertinent to mention here that on promulgation of Adhoc Appointments Regularization Act, 2014, by the Provincial Assembly, the services of the service of the undersigned were also regularized in the year 2014.
 - 2. That ever since my appointment I have performed my duties as assigned with zeal and devotion and there was no complaint whatsoever regarding my performance.
 - 3. That during the course of my service the undersigned applied for scholarship for higher studies, accordingly I got full bright scholarship for higher studies at University of Georgia in USA. It is pertinent to mention here that the undersigned was the only





candidate selected from the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa for the said

- 4. That in order to join my studies abroad, I also submitted applications for Ex-Pakistan leave (Leave without pay), however I was not given any response, thereafter I went abroad and join my studies. It is pertinent to mention that I remained in touch with my department and continuously made requests for Ex-Pakistan Leave vide applications dated 18.08.2014 and 10.10.2014.
- 5. That a notice of assumption of duty was issued, thereafter I came back in December, 2014, and submitted my arrival report dated 27.12.2014. I thereafter again made requests and submitted application for Ex-Pakistan Leave which was received vide Diary No.980 dated 30.12.2014. Since under the rules I was entitled for leave therefore I was assured that my leave will be sanctioned. In order to continue my studies I left for USA with impression that this time my leave application being properly processed / forwarded will be allowed.
- 6. That I also made correspondence with my department from abroad regarding the sanction or otherwise of my leave, however I was given no response.

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

PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS:-

Respectfully Sheweth:-

- 1. That the appellant has got no cause of action to file the instant appeal.
- 2. That the appellant has concealed material facts from the Hon'able Tribunal.
- 3. That the Hon'able Tribunal lacks jurisdiction to entertain the instant appeal.
- 4. That the appellant has not come to the Hon'able Tribunal with clean hands.
- 5. That the appeal is bad for mis-joinder and non joinder of unnecessary parties.

REPLY ON FACTS:-

- 1. Correct to the extent that the appellant was appointed as Adhoc Lecturer in the subject of English in the year 2010, but it is pertinent to mention here that, the appellant left for abroad without seeking permission of Competent Authority. Therefore his regularization was not recommended (Annexure-A).
- 2. Correct to the extent that before 01/09/2014 no complaint was lodged against him. However on 01/09/2014, he proceeded abroad and left the College without prior approval of the Competent Authority and violated the rules.
- 3. Pertains to record. Needs no comments.
- 4. Incorrect. The appellant was required to obtain NOC of the Department for scholarship for higher studies abroad as prerequisite but he did not do so. Later on he sent a letter which was signed by his brother (Annexure-B) which clearly show the malafide intention of the appellant and his presence aboard. As far as his application for leave dated 18/08/2014 is concerned, the same is not available in the record
- 5. Incorrect. The appellant was directed by his Principal repeatedly but he always turned a deaf ear to his call as evident from the letter (Annexure-C). On top of that, without taking NOC, which is the pre-requisite for availing Ex-Pakistan leave under Government Servant leave rules, he left for aboard, in total contravention to the rules.
- 6. Incorrect. It is pertinent to mention here, that proper procedure for granting of leave was not fulfilled by the appellant. No arrival report has been filed by the appellant.
- 7. Incorrect. The appellant remained absent without prior approval of the Competent Authority, several absence letters were addressed to him(Annexure-C). Again absence notices were issued against him but he failed to appear and resume his duties (Annexure-D) similar publication in Newspapers was also issued (Annexure-D Supra). Therefore, the appellant was proceeded under KPK Efficiency & Disciplinary Rules, 2011 and the Competent Authority imposed the penalty of Removal from Services upon him due to his wilful absence from duties (Annexure-E).

- 3. Incorrect. Reply of the Departmental appeal was attached as Annexure F.
- 9. Incorrect. The removal order dated 21/4/2015 was issued within four corners of law fully based on the norms of justice.

ON GROUNDS:-

- A. Incorrect. All codal/legal formalities were strictly followed by the Respondent Department.
- B. Incorrect. The appellant has been rightly treated according to rules and regulations.
- C. Incorrect. The appellant is trying to conceal material facts from the Hon'able Tribunal. Several absence notices, as already mentioned above, were issued against him but the appellant neither failed to reply nor appeared in person.
- D. Incorrect. All legal procedure under Rule-9 of E&D Rules-2011, was fully observed.
- E. Incorrect. As explained in Para-C.
- F. Incorrect. The appellant left the country without prior approval of the Competent Authority. His application being Diary No.980 dated 30/12/2014, does not appear to have been received in this office as the record of this office is silent. The version put forwarded by him was not maintainable as no Government servant can take shelter under the shadow of taking plea that his case has already in progress, hence left the situation. The appellant has rightly been penalized for irresponsible attitude.
- G. Correct to the extent that extra ordinary leave for five years is admissible to civil servants, who have ten years and more service in their credit; while extra ordinary leave without pay for two years is admissible to those civil servants, who have less than 10 years service in their credit under the revised leave Rules-1981, however, it is discretion of leave competent authority to grant leave to a civil servant or otherwise. The plea of the appellant is baseless.
- H. Incorrect. The appellant left the country without obtaining NQC from the Competent Authority. As far as arrival report is concerned it is ambiguous and it has not been received by the Principal.
- I. Incorrect. All legal formalities were completed by Respondent Department.
- J. Incorrect. Already explained in preceeding paras above.
- K. No comments.

L. That the respondents also seek permission of the Hon'able Tribunal to raise further grounds at the time of arguments.

PRAYERS:-

It is therefore, humbly prayed that the appeal is not maintainable as it is based on misconception hence the appeal may graciously be dismissed.

Dear Sir,

I am directed to refer to your office letter No. SO (Colleges-II) /2-5/2014/Nadir Shah/ 1170 dated 27.08.2015 on the subject cited above and to resubmit the Para-wise comments after necessary rectification as

FACTS:-

- 1. Correct to the extent that he was appointed as adhoc Lecturer in English in 2010 and his adhoc appointment was extended from time to time. On promulgation of adhoc appointments Regulations Act, 2014 by the Provincial Assembly, the services of some 188 adhoc lecturer (Male & Female) including the appellant were regularized 26.05.2014 vide Provincial Notification dated 15.12.2014 and at that time he left for abroad without seeking approval of the Competent Authority.
- Correct to the extent that before 01.09.2014 no complaint 2, . was lodged against him. However, on 01.09.2014, he proceeded abroad and left the College without prior approval of the Competent Authority and violated the rules.
- Not admitted. He was required to obtain NOC of the Department for Scholarship for higher studies abroad in USA as prerequisite but he didn't bother to do so. Later-on he sent an unsigned application through his Principal & instead of signing the same by himself his brother name was written on it. It shows that he was not available in the country and proceeded abroad at the time.
- 4. The Principal Govt; Superior Science College, Peshawar forwarded an unsigned application dated 10.10.2014 of the Ex-lecturer wherein his brother name was written which transpire that he was not available in the country and submitted his application through his brother to the Principal. So far his application dated 18.08.2014 is concerned, same is not available in the record.

- 5. Not admitted. The Principal directed him time and again through several letters with the direction to resume his duty but he fail to reply as his evident from the report of the Principal vide letter No. 2030 dated 31.03.2015.
- 6. Not admitted.
- 7. He was proceeded under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Efficiency & Discipline Rules, 2011 and the Competent Authority imposed the penalty of Removal from the Service upon him due to his willful absence from duty vide Notification No. SO (Colleges-II)/HED/2-5/2014/3937-40 dated 21.04.2015 duly endorsed by the Directorate of Higher Education Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
- 8. Not admitted. The order dated 21.04.2015 is issued within four corners of law fully based on the norms of justice, hence, not liable to be set aside.

GROUNDS OF DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL

- A. Not admitted.
- В. Not admitted. He applied for Extra Ordinary Leave w.e.f 01.09.2014 to 29.05.2015 and sent an unsigned application through his brother duly forwarded by the Principal and left the College without permission of the Competent Authority. In such cases Rule-09 of Efficiency and Discipline Rules, 2011 "titled procedure in case of willful absence" is very much clear according to which in case of willful absence from duty from Government Servant for seven or more days, a notice shall be issued by the Competent Authority through registered acknowledgment on his home address directing him to resume duty within 15 days of issuance of the notice. If the same is received back as undelivered or no response is received from the absentee within stipulated time, a notice shall be published in at-least two leading newspapers directing him to resume duty within 15 days of the publication of that notice, failing which an ex-parte decision shall be taken against the absentee. On the expiry of the stipulated period given in the notice, major penalty of Removal from service may be imposed upon the Government Servant. The Principal sent several letters under registered cover on home address of the lecturer concerned with the direction to resume duty but he failed to do so. Absence Notice was also served upon him through Newspapers with the similar direction but to no avail.
- C. Not admitted. All legal procedure under Rule-09 of E&D Rules, 2011 was fully observed.
- D. As explained in Para-C.
- E. Not admitted. His application bearing Diary No. 980 dated 30.12.2014 doesn't appear to have been received in this office as the record of this office is silent. The version put forward by him is not maintainable as no Government Servant can take shelter under the shadow of taking the plea that his case had already in progress, hence, left the station. The appellant has rightly been penalized for irresponsible attitude.

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- F. Admitted to the extent that Extra Ordinary Leave for five years is admissible to Civil Servants who have ten years and more service in their credit while Extra Ordinary Leave without pay for two years is admissible to those Civil Servants who have less than ten years service in their credit under the Revised Leave Rules, 1981. However, it is discretion of Leave sanctioning authority to grant leave to a Civil Servant or otherwise. The plea of the lecturer concerned is baseless.
- G. Not admitted. As per report of the Principal, he remained absent from duty w.e.f 01.09.2014 to 29.05.2015 despite the fact that he sent several letters followed by reminders on his home address under registered cover with the direction to report for duty but to no avail.
- H. Not admitted. The order dated 21.04.2015 is issued within four corners of law fully based on the norms of justice, hence, not liable to be set aside.
- I. Not admitted. It is the discretion of leave sanctioning authority to grant leave or not.
- J. As explained in Para-H above.
- K. No comments.
