1. Learned counsel for the appellant and Mr. Asif Masood Ali Shah, Deputy District Attorney alongwith Miss. Parkha Aziz Khan, Advocate, Legal Advisor for the respondents present.

2. Before filing of this appeal, another appeal No.500/2022 was filed by the appellant which was decided in the following manner:

*"In the reply it is stated, in Para-05, that the application of the appellant had been sent to the Grievances Redressal Committee (GRC) and the same was to be decided by the competent forum on merit. When confronted with the situation, learned counsel submitted that the matter was lingering on before the GRC to which the representative of the respondents assured that the GRC would decide the matter within 45 days from today. We thus dispose of this appeal with the direction to the Finance Department to get decision from the GRC within 45 days from today and in case the grievances of the appellant are not redressed, he may fil fresh appeal. Consign."*

Whereafter, this appeal was filed by the appellant and in the reply in Para-05, the respondents have stated that the case was accordingly placed at the Agenda of Grievance Redressal Committee Meeting held on 02.08.2023 under the Chairmanship of the Secretary Finance. The minutes of the meeting were submitted for approval of the competent authority but Miss. Parkha Aziz, Advocate, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents stated that the minutes were postponed because of Interim Government as it was deemed appropriate that let the matter be decided by the Elected Government.
