
APPEALS UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KHYBER TRIBUNAL ACT, **PAKHTUNKHWA** SERVICE AGAINST THE IMPUGNED ORDERS NO.3015-22 AND NO.2899-3006 DATED 10.03.2021 PASSED RESPONDENT NO.3 WHEREBY MAJOR PENALTY OF REMOVAL FROM SERVICE OF APPELLANTS ON THE GROUND OF ALLEGED UNSPECIFIED ABSENCE FROM DUTY WAS IMPOSED WITHOUT ANY INQUIRY AND INTENDING OPPORTUNITY BEING HEARD WITHOUT AND BEYOND TO THE LAW, SUCH CONDUCT OF THE RESPONDENTS IS ILLEGAL AND VOID AB INITIO.

CONSOLIDATED JUDGMENT

KALIM ARSHAD KHAN CHAIRMAN: Through this single judgment the above appeals are going to be decided as both the are similar in nature and almost with the same contentions, therefore, can conveniently be decided together.

- 2. The appellants' cases in brief are that they were serving in the Education Department as PSHT and PST. Show cause notices were issued to them on 07.04.2021 on the allegations of absence. That the notices were replied by them. That vide impugned orders dated 10.06.2021 major penalty of removal from service was imposed upon them. Feeling aggrieved, they filed departmental appeals but the same were not responded, rather the respondents issued a Notification dated 08.07.2021 w.e.f 01.04.2019 for the absenteeism, the mechanism to be observed for penalty of civil servant. Therefore, they filed the instant service appeals.
- 3. On receipt of the appeals and their admission to full hearing, the respondents were summoned, who put appearance and contested the appeal by filing written reply raising therein numerous legal and factual

objections. The defense setup was a total denial of the claim of the appellant.

- 4. We have heard learned counsel for the appellant and learned Assistant Advocate General for the respondents.
- 5. The learned counsel for the appellant reiterated the facts and grounds detailed in the memo and grounds of the appeal while the learned Assistant Advocate General controverted the same by supporting the impugned order(s).
- During the course of arguments, learned AAG produced copy of Notification dated 26.08.2022, according to which on acceptance of appeals, the Director Elementary & Secondary Education Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar reinstated the appellants into service with immediate effect converting the intervening period into extraordinary leave without pay in the best public interest. As part of the relief prayed in these appeals to the extent of reinstatement has otherwise been granted to the appellants by way of the above notification, therefore, the appeal has rendered fruitless to that extent and as regards their prayer for grant of back benefits is concerned, we observe that when once the punishment awarded in lieu of the alleged absence of the appellant was set aside and the appellants were reinstated into service, they become entitled to back benefits they were deprived of, while being out of service for none of their fault. Reinstatement of the appellants was not on humanitarian grounds, rather he should reinstate them on merits. In such view of the matter, reinstatement the appellants are entitled to the back benefits and treating the intervening period as extraordinary leave without pay is not


