2. During the pendency of appeal, the appellant attained the

age of superannuation of 60 years rendering this appeal fruitless.

However, learned counsel for the appellant complains that after

making application for retirement on medical grounds, the appellant

was not paid any salaries nor his pension case was being processed

by the respondents.

3. Therefore, while disposing of this appeal, we direct that in

case the appellant is not paid any salaries or his due emoluments for

the period he performed duty after making application for retirement

on medical grounds, the respondents shall make payment of the

same within a month. Similarly, the respondents shall also process

the case of pension within a month, if that has not already been

done. Consign.
