- 1) That the instant appeal in not maintainable.
- 2) That the appellant has got no cause of action.
- 3) That the appellant is estopped to file instant appeal.
- 4) That the appellant is bad for misjoinder and non-Joinder of parties.

5) That the appellant has not come to this Honorable Tribunal with clean hands.

ON FACTS.

Para-1. It pertains to record.

- Para-2. Incorrect. Joint seniority list of Revenue Inspectors and Head Vernacular. Clerks as it stood on 31/12/2022, was issued according to the Service Rules / policy of the Irrigation Department, notified vide Notification No.SO (E) IRR:/23-5/73 dated 17th February, 2011(Annexure-A) according to the seniority. Revenue Inspectors are also employees of the Irrigation Department and they are senior to the Head Vernacular Clerks.
- Para-3 Incorrect. The existing Service Rules / policy of the Irrigation Department, notified with the prior approval of the competent authority in the year 2011. Now, after lapse of about twelve years, the Appellant who is Head Vernacular Clerk, in Irrigation Department, has challenged the instant rule / policy of the irrigation Department which is time barred.
- Para-4. Incorrect. Prior to the challenged joint Seniority List of Revenue Inspectors and Head Vernacular Clerks, Joint seniority lists as it stood on 31/12/2021 and 31/12/2022 were also issued by the competent authority which was circulated amongst all the concerned officials including Appellant. But the Appellant did not challenge those joint seniority list at that time.
- Para-5. Appellant has not come to this Honourable Tribunal with clean hands and also the instant Appeal is time barred. Hence the instant Appeal is not maintainable and in-competent. Moreover, the present Appellant is estopped due to his own conduct to bring the present Appeal and also concealed material facts from the Hon'ble Court. The Appellant has no legal grounds in support of his instant Appeal.

ON GROUNDS.

- Para-1. Incorrect. As stated above the existing Service Rules / policy of the Irrigation Department, notified with the prior approval of the competent authority in the year 2011. No one had challenged these rules at that time. Now, after lapse of about twelve years, the Appellant who is Head Vernacular Clerk, in Irrigation Department, has challenged the instant rule / policy of the Irrigation Department which is time barred.
- Incorrect. As stated above. Joint seniority list of Revenue Inspectors and Para-2. Head Vernacular Clerks as it stood on 31/12/2023, was issued according to the Service Rules / policy of the Irrigation Department, notified vide Notification No.SO (E) IRR:/23-5/73 dated 17th February, 2011, according to the seniority. Revenue Inspectors are also employees of the Irrigation Department and they are senior to the Head Vernacular Clerks.

Incorrect. Revenue Inspectors were appointed for the supervision of Patwaris of Irrigation Department towards recovery of Abiana Dues. Moreover, they themselves also visit in the field for the recovery of Abiana Dues and achieved best results in this regard. Revenue Inspectors are well experience, well conversant with the record of Patwaris and deserve for promotion as Zilladar on their own turn according to the seniority-cumfitness, under the existing Service Rules of the Irrigation Department.

Para-4. Incorrect. The facts have been explained above.

Para-5.

According to the decision of the competent authority, the task of recovery of Abiana Dues was assigned to the Revenue Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and services of Revenue Inspectors along with some Patwaris of the Irrigation Department were placed at the disposal of concerned Deputy Commissioners of the District for the purpose of recovery of Abiana Dues. However, task of recovery of Abiana Dues was once again assigned to the Irrigation Department. vide Revenue & Estate Department Notification No. Recovery-of-Abiana/2020-21/19500-547, dated 29/08/2023 and in compliance of the decision of competent authority, Revenue Inspectors and Patwaris were relieved by Revenue Department and they were directed to report to concerned authorities of the Irrigation Department. Now, Revenue Inspectors are performing their duties under the supervision of authorities of Irrigation Department.

Para-6.

Appellant has not come to this Honourable Tribunal with clean hands and also the instant Appeal is time barred. Hence the instant Appeal is not maintainable and in-competent. Moreover, the present Appellant has estopped due to his own conduct to bring the present Appeal and also concealed material facts from the Hon'ble Court. The Appellant has no legal grounds in support of his instant Appeal.

In view of above, it is prayed that the instant Appeal, which is not maintainable

and time barred, may please be dismissed with cost.
