JUDGMENT

NIAZ MUIHAMMAD KHAN, CHAIRMAN.- Arguments of the
learned counsel for the parties heard and record perused.

FACTS

2. The appellant was transferred from the office of DHO, Hangu to Bannu
Medical College, Bannu on 29.06.2015. Against this order, he filed departmental
appeal (which is undated) which was not responded to and thereafter, the present
service appeal on 24.11.2015.

ARGUMENTS.

3. The learned counsel for the appellant argued that the impugned transfer
order was made on political interference and in this respect he referred to a letter of

MPA dated 16.06.2015 addressed to the Director General, Health Services, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar. He further argued that the appellant was Office Bearer of APCA and could not be transferred during his tenure as Office Bearer in view of notification dated 25.03.1986 and 7.7.1992.

4. On the other hand, the learned Deputy District Attorney argued that the transfer orders were made in public interest. That it was a general transfer order of 42 civil servants. That the grounds taken today by the learned counsel for the appellant were not taken in departmental appeal.

CONCLUSION.

5. The very letter of MPA as referred to by the learned counsel for the appellant is political interference and it is settled position of law that order passed on political interference cannot be sustained. The notifications of the Provincial Government regarding prohibition of transfer during holding of office in Association is another valid ground put forth by the learned counsel for the appellant.

6. Consequently, this appeal is accepted. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.

R/SHEWETH:

ON FACTS:

That appellant is belongs to ministerial staff and is serving the respondent Department as Office Assistant (BPS-16) at District Health Office Hangu. That right from appointment till date the appellant has served the respondent Department quite efficiently and up to the entire satisfaction of his superiors.

- 2- That appellant while serving as Office Assistant (BPS-16) at DHO Office Hangu an order dated 29.6.2015 was issued due to which the appellant was transferred from DHO Office Hangu to Bannu Medical College. Copy of the impugned order dated 29.6.2015 is attached as annexure **A.**
- 3- That appellant feeling aggrieved prefer Departmental appeal on 28.7.2015 against the order dated 29.6.2015 but no reply has been received so far. Copy of the Departmental appeal is attached as annexure **B.**
- 4- That it is pertinent to mention that appellant is the senior vice president of APCA, District Hangu and as such under the rules the appellant can not be transfer/ posted out of Hangu. That due to transfer of the appellant the children of the appellant who are studying in Kohat is going to be suffered badly. Copies of the Notification and certificates are attached as annexure **C and D.**
- 5- That feeling aggrieved and having no other remedy the appellant prefer the instant appeal on the following grounds amongst the others.

GROUND:

- A- That the impugned order dated 29-6-2015 issued by the respondent Department is against the law, facts, norms of natural justice and materials on the record hence not tenable and liable to be set aside.
- B- That appellant has not been treated by the respondents in accordance with law and Rules on the subject noted above and as such respondents violated Article 4 and 25 of the Constitution of Pakistan 1973.
- C- That the impugned order dated 29-6-2015 is against the Clause I, and II of the transfer/posting policy of the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. Copy of the policy is attached as annexure **E.**
- D- That the appellant has been transferred by the respondent No.2 on the recommendation of MPA, therefore the impugned order dated 29-6-2015 is not tenable in the eyes of law and prevailing rules. Copy of the letter is attached as annexure **F.**
- E- That the impugned order dated 29.6.2015 has not been issued by the respondents in the public interest nor exigencies of service.

F- That the respondent Department acted in arbitrary and malafide manner while issuing the impugned order dated 29-6-2015.

G- That the District Health Officer Hangu has not been relieved the appellant till date and has requested the respondent No.2 that not to relieve the appellant till the arrival of his substitute. Copy of the letter is attached as annexure G.

H- That the appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is therefore most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may be accepted as prayed for.

POSTING / TRANSFER POLICY OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT.

- i) All the posting/transfers shall be strictly in public interest and shall not be abused/misused to victimize the Government servants
 - ii) All Government servants are prohibited to exert political, Administrative or any other pressures upon the posting/transfer authorities for seeking posing/transfers of their choice and against the public interest.
 - iii) All contract Government employees appointed against specific posts, can not be posted against any other post.
 - iv) The normal tenure of posting shall be three years subject to the condition that for the officers/officials posted in unattractive areas the tenure shall be two years and for the hard areas the tenure shall be one year. The unattractive and hard areas will be notified by the Government.
 - v) ¹{ }
 - vi) While making postings/transfer from settled areas to FATA and vice-versa, specific approval of Governor, NWFP needs to be obtained
- ²While making postings/transfers of officers/officials up to BS-17, from settled areas to FATA and vice-versa approval of the Chief Secretary NWFP needs to be obtained. Whereas, in case of posting/transfer of officers in BS-18 and above, from settled areas to FATA and vice versa, specific approval of the Governor NWFP shall be obtained
- vi (a) All Officers/officials selected against Zone-I/FATA quota in the Provincial Services should compulsorily serve in FATA for atleast eighteen months in each grade. This should start from senior most scales/grades downwards in each scale/grade of each cadre.
 - vii) Officers may be posted on executive/administrative posts in the Districts of their domicile except District Coordination Officers (D.C.Os) and DPOs/Superintendent of Police (SP). Similarly Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) shall not be posted at a place where the Police Station (Thaana) of his area/residence is situated.
 - viii) No posting/transfers of the officer's/officials on detailment basis shall be made.
 - ix) Regarding the posting of husband/wife, both in Provincial services, efforts where possible would be made to post such persons at one station subject to the public interest.
 - x) All the posting/transferring authorities may facilitate the posting/transfer of the unmarried female government Servants at the station of the residence of their parents.

- b) Tenure on present post shall also be taken into consideration and the posting/transfers shall be in the best public interest.

xiv) Government servants including District Govt. employees feeling aggrieved due to the orders of posting/transfer authorities may seek remedy from the next higher authority / the appointing authority as the case may be through an appeal to be submitted within seven days of the receipt of such orders. Such appeal shall be disposed of within fifteen days. The option of appeal against posting/ transfer orders could be exercised only in the following cases

- i) Pre-mature posing/transfer or posting transfer in violation of the provisions of this policy.
- ii) Serious and grave personal (humanitarian) grounds.

To streamline the postings/transfers in the District Government and to remove any irritant/confusions in this regard the provision of Rule 25 of the North West Frontier Province District Government Rules of Business 2001 read with schedule – IV thereof is referred. As per schedule-IV the posting/transferring authorities for the officers/officials shown against each are as under:-





All the objections raised by the respondents are in correct and baseless and not in accordance with law and rules rather the respondent is estopped due to their own conduct to raise any objection at this stage of the appeal.

ON FACTS:

- 1- Admitted correct hence denied.
- 2- Admitted correct to the extent of the place of posting of the appellant. Moreover the transfer order of the appellant has been transferred to Bannu Medical College from District Health Office Hangu on the recommendations of the Local MPA Mr. Shah Faisal Khan.
- 3- Incorrect and not replied accordingly. That the transfer order of the appellant has not been passed in the public interest which is a clear violation of the Clause-I & II of Transfer/Posting Policy promulgated by the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
- 4- Admitted correct hence denied. That according to the rules appellant cannot be transfer from District Hangu and that in case of transfer of the appellant the affairs of the Association cannot easily be carried out the existing cabinet.
- 5- Admitted correct hence need not comments.

GROUND:

All the grounds of main appeal are correct and in accordance with law and prevailing rules and that of the respondent are incorrect and baseless hence denied. That the impugned order 29.6.2015 issued by the respondent Department is against the law, facts and norms of natural justice. That the transfer of the appellant is the clear violation of the Clause-I & II of the transfer/posting policy promulgated by the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and more that the appellant is also the vice president of APCA due to which the appellant cannot be transfer from District Hangu.

It is therefore most humbly prayed that on acceptance of this rejoinder the appeal of the appellant may be accepted as prayed for.

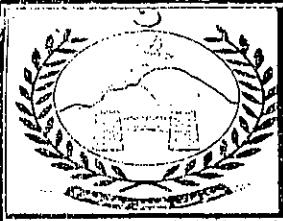

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject noted above and to state that the Supreme Court of Pakistan vide the subject cited judgment has enunciated the following principles of Law with regard to protection and conduct of civil servants.

- (i) **Appointments, Removals and Promotions:** Appointments, removals and promotions must be made in accordance with the law and the rules made thereunder, where no such law or rule exists and the matter has been left to discretion, such discretion must be exercised in a structured, transparent and reasonable manner and in the public interest.
- (ii) **Tenure, Posting and Transfer:** When the ordinary tenure for a posting has been specified in the law or rules made thereunder, such tenure must be respected and cannot be varied, except for compelling reasons, which should be recorded in writing and are judicially reviewable.

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- (iii) **Illegal Orders:** Civil Servants owe their first and foremost allegiance to the law and the constitution. They are not bound to obey orders from superiors which are illegal or are not in accordance with accepted practices and rule based norms; instead, in such situations, they must record their opinion and, if necessary, dissent.
- (iv) **OSD:** Officers should not be posted as OSD except for compelling reasons, which must be recorded in writing. If at all an officer is to be posted as OSD, such posting should not exceed 03 months. If there is a disciplinary inquiry going on against him/her such inquiry must be completed at the earliest. The officer on special duty may be posted against a post of his/her equivalent pay scale/grade within 03 months of his/her order as OSD.

2. I am, therefore, directed to request you to note the above principles of law for strict compliance.


