1. Learned counsel for the appellant present.

According to learned counsel, the appellant is aggrieved of the seniority list, which is neither signed nor having any date on it but is annexed with the appeal as "Annexure-D" at Page-20 and allegedly received by the appellant on 01.12.2023, against which he filed departmental appeal on 03.12.2023 that was not responded within stipulated period of ninety days, where-after, the appellant filed the instant service appeal. Admitted to full hearing subject to all just and legal objections by the other side. The appellant is directed to deposit security fees within 10 days. The respondents be summoned through TCS, the expenses of which be deposited by the appellant within three days. Learned counsel for the appellant is, however, put on notice to assist the Tribunal whether the tentative seniority list is to be objected first and on issuance of final list, the appeal before the Tribunal, would be competent or representation has also to be filed against final seniority list before coming to the Tribunal in appeal, secondly, appellant is directed to place on file duly signed seniority list, which shall also bear the date and in case he could not procure, he shall make application to the Tribunal so that it could be requisitioned from the other side.
